11. Bidder is requested to quote their best competitive prices. "BHEL reserves the right to go for Reverse Auction (RA) (Guidelines as available on www.bhel.com) instead of opening the sealed envelope price bid, submitted by the bidder. This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. Bidders to give their acceptance with the offer for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA.

Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit 'Process compliance form' (to the designated service provider) as well as 'Online sealed bid' in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of 'Process compliance form' or 'Online sealed bid' by the agreed bidder(s) will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com).

The bidders have to necessarily submit online sealed bid less than or equal to their envelope sealed price bid already submitted to BHEL along with the offer. The envelope sealed price bid of successful L1 bidder in RA, if conducted, shall also be opened after RA and the order will be placed on lower of the two bids (RA closing price & envelope sealed price) thus obtained. The bidder having submitted this offer specifically agrees to this condition and undertakes to execute the contract on thus awarded rates.

If it is found that L1 bidder has quoted higher in online sealed bid in comparison to envelope sealed bid for any item(s), the bidder will be issued a warning letter to this effect. However, if the same bidder again defaults on this count in any subsequent tender in the unit, it will be considered as fraud and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors (as available on www.bhel.com)."

Important Instructions for RA:

The Bidders has to quote the Single Price (i.e. Total Cost to BHEL) in Reverse Auction. Price are to be inclusive of Packing & Forwarding charges, all the routine & type tests as per tender scope, ED + cess, CST against C-form/VAT, Freight, insurance charges as applicable, etc. including loading (if any). De-loading (if any) shall be done in line with SCC of the project.

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After successful completion of reverse auction L1 bidder shall be asked to submit break up in line with taxes & duties, freight quoted in their price bid.

After declaring L1 upon completion of RA, the envelope containing sealed price bid of L1 bidder shall also be opened for placement of order on lower of the two bids (RA closing price & envelope sealed price). The following case may emerge while dealing with cases through Reverse Auction:

CASE-I - Identical taxes & duties and freight in Reverse Auction & Conventional Price Bid.

Resolution- Ordering shall be done on lower of the two bids (RA closing price & envelope sealed price).

Case-II - Bidder has quoted 'CST' in Conventional Price Bid and applicable Tax is 'VAT'.

Resolution-Total Cost to BHEL shall be maintained by reducing proportion amount in Ex-works quoted by Bidder.

CASE-III - Bidder has quoted 'VAT' in Conventional Price Bid and applicable Tax is 'CST'.

Resolution- Conventional Bid/RA Prices shall be reduced and CST will be allowed.

Statutory variation shall be applicable. Any new tax structure (like Goods & Services Tax) as and when implemented by the Government shall become applicable in addition to or in lieu of existing tax structure.

NOTE- APPLICABLE TAXES & DUTIES SHALL BE DETERMINED AS PER LOCATION OF WORKS OF BIDDER.

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13. Pre-Qualifying Requirement:

Bidders who fulfil TECHNICAL & FINANCIAL PRE-QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT CRITERIA are eligible to participate in this tender.

Bidders are requested to provide the details as per "TECHNICAL AND FINANCIAL PRE-QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS". Bids of only those bidders shall be evaluated who meet the Technical as well as Financial Pre-Qualifying requirements.

14. Foreign and indigenous bidders participating in subject tender will necessarily have to buy class III DSCs (Digital Signature Certificate) issued by the certifying authorities in India for participation in future tender enquiries through e-procurement. Basic procedure /checklist are uploaded on www.bhel.com for participating in future tender enquires through e-procurement.
15. Prices shall be firm till complete execution of the contract.
16. Deviations (Commercial as well as Technical) from NIT are generally not acceptable. In case of deviations from NIT, the tenderer shall give cost of withdrawal of such deviation in Sealed Cover as per **Annexure-II** Deviation Sheet (Cost of Withdrawal) as per GCC Rev-06 (copy enclosed).
17. Total erection & commissioning charges including service tax should be minimum 20% of the total quoted package (excluding mandatory spares but including all taxes & freight), falling which the break-up of price shall be adjusted accordingly for ordering.
18. **The total CIF content available for this tender enquiry is Rs. 2.99 crores.** Bidders (Indian and foreigner both) to indicate the list of items and CIF value for which they wish to avail concessional custom duty in price format annexure-III. The total CIF content quoted in foreign currency shall be converted in equivalent INR. Essentiality certificate shall be issued by TSGENCO through BHEL for the items to be imported by the bidder, limited to CIF content of Rs. 2.99 crores, for availing concessional custom duty.

Also be informed that clause no. 18.A of SCC regarding CIF content is also applicable to foreign bidders.

19. Bidder(s) to note that this is a conditional Open Tender enquiry and the price bid (Part-II) opening/RA participation shall be subject to following condition:
 - A) Approval of bidder by End Customer. Approval shall be taken up by BHEL with customer based on the credentials/reference list. Hence Bidders are requested to submit the following (as part of their credentials) on or before Part-I opening/due date: -

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20. Bidders who are not registered with BHEL-PEM will have to apply for registration in BHEL-PEM through Registration Portal available at www.bhelpem.com-->vendor section-->online supplier registration. All credentials and/or documents duly signed & stamped related to registration has to be uploaded on the website & submit the application for registration through online portal for registration. One set of hard copy filled-up SRF downloaded from Online Registration Portal duly signed & stamped has to be submitted.

21. Integrity Pact (IP)-

- (a) IP is a tool to ensure that activities and transactions between the Company and its Bidders/ Contractors are handled in a fair, transparent and corruption free manner. A panel of Independent External Monitors (IEMs) have been appointed to oversee implementation of IP in BHEL. The IP as enclosed with the tender (Refer Annexure-IX, as per GCC Rev-06) is to be submitted (duly signed by authorized signatory who signs in the offer) along with techno-commercial bid. **Only those bidders who have entered into such an IP with BHEL would be competent to participate in the bidding. In other words, entering into this Pact would be a preliminary qualification.**

25. Indian bidders/Foreign Bidders for Indigenous Items have to quote freight charges in percentage of their quoted Total Ex-works prices.
26. Evaluation will be done on overall L1 (Total cost to BHEL) basis with necessary loadings as applicable. Bidders have to refer SCC & GCC.
