GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS OF TENDER

Your offer should be compliant to following terms and conditions:

1.0 SUBMISSION OF OFFER

Your offer should be complete in all respects (refer Annexure VII).

Offer should be <u>either</u> typed or written legibly in English. Alterations/ over-writings, if any, in the tender should be attested by the person signing the tender. Tenders with alterations etc. not authenticated as above may be rejected by BHEL.

2.0 PRICE

- a) Price quoted should be firm during the entire duration of contract.
- b) Price quoted shall be all inclusive except GST (as applicable), which should be indicated separately in the column provided in the Price Bid enclosed as Annexure-III.
- c) Price to be filled-in strictly as per the Price Bid enclosed as Annexure- III. Change in Performa is not allowed.
- d) The bidders are required to quote essentially for the entire scope of work.
- e) Offers not fulfilling any of the above conditions are liable for rejection.

3.0 BID VALIDITY - 60 days

4.0 CORRECTION OF ARITHMETIC ERRORS:

Provided that the bid is substantially responsive, BHEL shall correct arithmetical errors on the following basis:

- a) If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price shall prevail and the total price shall be corrected, unless in the opinion of the BHEL there is an obvious misplacement of the decimal point in the unit price, in which case the total price as quoted shall govern and the unit price shall be corrected.
- b) If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected.
- c) If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject to (a) and (b) above.
- d) If any bidder does not accept the correction of errors, their bids are liable to be disqualified.

5.0 TAXES & DUTIES

- a) It is mandatory to comply with all taxes applicable for the required services. Your price should be all inclusive, except GST. The amount towards GST should be indicated separately in the specified place in Price Bid enclosed as Annexure- III.
- b) To enable BHEL to avail GST Input tax credit, party shall submit invoice containing all the particulars as stipulated under Invoice Rules of GST Law. Such invoice shall be submitted within prescribed time limit in the name of BHEL Corporate Office, BHEL House, Siri Fort, New Delhi. Payment shall be made to the party only after submission of GST complaint tax invoice as mentioned above and other relevant documents.
- c) In case of any loss incurred by BHEL on account of non-compliance of GST laws by vendor/service provider, the same shall be to party's account and the same shall be withheld/recovered from party.
- d) Any statutory changes as and when made applicable by the Government shall become applicable against documentary evidence.

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e) Payment to the party be subjected to TDS as per rules in force from time to time. The Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) shall be done as per the provisions of Income Tax Act & GST, as amended from time to time and a certificate to this effect to be provided to party.

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f) Applicable GST shall also be recoverable from the contractor/bidder in case of LD recovery/penalty on account of breach of terms of contract.

6.0 GENERAL

a) All information in the Tender Document is meant for your consumption only and not for sharing, unless and otherwise, authorized by BHEL in writing.

7.0 PENALTY

- a) In the event of complete failure of webcast on internet, BHEL is not liable to make any payments.
- b) The live feed provided by the agency shall be without any interruptions, failure or glitches in the transmission, any partial failure exceeding 60 seconds in the live transmission will attract penalty on the bidder @ 2% per minute of the work order value. Sufficient opportunity to present the case shall be provided to the bidder before imposition of the penalty.

8.0 PRICE ESCALATION CLAUSE

8.1 All the prices quoted by the bidders shall be in Indian Rupees and shall be final and binding and not subject to any price escalation.

9.0 TERMS OF PAYMENT

- 9.1 100% payment shall be made within 30 days from the receipt of GST-Compliant invoice. No other payment term shall be acceptable to BHEL.
- 9.2 No interest shall be payable for delay in making the payment. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any interest with respect to any money which may be due to him from BHEL.
- 9.3 While making the payment, statutory deductions as applicable, shall be made by BHEL.

10.0 CONTRACT LAW, NOTICE AND ARBITRATION

10.1 **ARBITRATION**

a) In the event of any dispute or difference arising out of the execution of the Order/Contract or the respective rights and liabilities of the parties or in relation to interpretation of any provision between BHEL & Service Provider in any manner touching upon the Order/Contract, such dispute or difference shall (except as to any matters, the decision of which is specifically provided for therein) be referred to the arbitration of the person appointed by the competent authority of BHEL. Subject as aforesaid, the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (India) or statutory modifications or re-enactments thereof and the rules made thereunder and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause. The venue of arbitration shall be at New Delhi.

b) In case of order/contract on Public Sector Enterprises (PSE) or a Govt. Deptt., the following clause shall be applicable: -

In the event of any dispute or difference relating to the interpretation and application of the provisions of the Order/Contract, such dispute or difference shall be referred to by either party to the arbitration of one of the arbitrators in the department of public enterprises. The award of the arbitrator shall be binding upon the parties to the dispute, provided, however, any party aggrieved by such award may make a further reference for setting aside or revision of the award to the Law secretary, Deptt. of Legal Affairs, Ministry of Law & Justice, Government of India. Upon such reference the dispute shall be decided by the Law Secretary or the Special Secretary or Additional Secretary when so authorized by the Law Secretary, whose decision shall bind the parties hereto finally and conclusively. The parties in the dispute will bear equally the cost of arbitration as intimated by the arbitrator.

10.2 JURISDICTION:

Notwithstanding any other court or courts having jurisdiction to decide the question(s) forming the subject matter of the reference if the same had been the subject matter of a suit, any and all actions and proceedings arising out of or relative to the contract shall lie only in the court of competent civil jurisdiction in this behalf at **DELHI** (where this Contract has been signed on behalf of the CONTRACTOR) and only the said Court(s) shall have jurisdiction to entertain and try any such action(s) and/or proceeding(s) to the exclusion of all other Courts.

11.0 INTEGRITY CLAUSE

Commitment by BHEL:

BHEL commits to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption in connection with the tender process and execution of the contract. BHEL will during the tender process treat the Bidder in a transparent and fair manner, and with equity.

Commitment by Bidder/ Supplier/ Contractor:

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The bidder/ supplier/ contractor commit to take all measures to prevent corruption and will not directly or indirectly influence any decision or benefit which he is not legally entitled to nor will act or omit in any manner which tantamount to an offence punishable under any provision of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or any other law in force in India. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, and is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract and shall adhere to relevant guidelines issued from time to time by Govt. of India/ BHEL. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will perform/ execute the contract as per the contract terms & conditions and will not default without any reasonable cause, which causes loss of business/ money/ reputation, to BHEL. If any bidder/ supplier/ contractor during pre-tendering/ tendering/ post tendering/ award/ execution/ post-execution stage indulges in mal-practices, cheating, bribery, fraud or and other misconduct or formation of cartel so as to influence the bidding process or influence the price or acts or omits in any manner which tantamount to an offence punishable under any provision of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or any other law in force in India, then, action may be taken against such bidder/supplier/ contractor as per extant guidelines of the company available on www.bhel.com and/or under applicable legal provisions".

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12.0 CONFIDENTIALITY

- 12.1 Webcast content/AV recordings of the event shall be treated as confidential and should not be disclosed in any manner to any unauthorized person under any circumstances, which includes sharing link to our webcast as demo to any other party.
- 13.0 FORCE MAJEURE: The conditions of Force Majeure shall means the events beyond control of the parties effected such as act of God, Earthquake, Flood, Devastating fire, War, Civil Commotion, Cyclone, Industrial Lockout and Statutory Act of the Government having bearing on the performance of the Contract. The party affected by Force Majeure shall be obliged to notify the other party within 48 hours, by fax/cable, of the commencement and the end of the Force Majeure circumstances preventing its performance of all or any of its obligations under this order. If performance of obligations under this order is delayed for more than one months due to a continuous Force Majeure, the party not affected by Force Majeure may at any time thereafter while such Force Majeure continues, by notice in writing forth with terminate all or any part of the unperformed portion this order. If this order or any portion thereof is terminated under Force Majeure conditions, the Contractor shall be liable to the COMPANY for any damages, losses or liabilities as result thereof.

14.0 CANCEL/SCRAP OF TENDER

BHEL also reserves the right to cancel/ scrap the tender without assigning any reason whatsoever.

15.0 DEFAULT/ BREACH OF CONTRACT, INSOLVENCY AND RISK PURCHASE

a) If the Service Provider / Contractor fails to provide the required services as per the Contract / fails to deliver the services thereof within the period(s) fixed for such delivery of the contracted quality and failing to adhere to the contract specifications or at any time repudiates or otherwise abandons the contract before expiry of such period or refuses or is unable to supply services covered by the Order/Contract either in whole or in part or otherwise fails to perform the Order/Contract or commits any breach of the Order/Contract not herein specifically provided for or in the event of the death or insanity or if the Seller/Contractor being an individual or if a firm on a partnership thereof, shall at any time, be adjudged insolvent or shall have a receiving order for administration of his estate made against him or shall take any proceeding for composition under any Insolvency Act for the time being in force or make any assignment of the Order /Contract or enter into any arrangement or composition with his creditors or suspend payment or if the firm dissolved under the Partnership Act or if the Seller/Contractor (Service Provider) being a company is wound up voluntarily or by order of a Court or a Receiver, Liquidator or Manager on behalf of the debenture holders and creditors is appointed or circumstances shall have arisen which
