Remarks-

- 1. Quantity tolerance $\pm 10\%$ is acceptable in view of dimensional tolerances.
- 2. Plates thickness 140mm are to be supplied in size 1600x3200 mm or its multiples.
- **3.** Delivery period mentioned in enquiry is indicative, bidders to quote their best possible delivery.
- **4. Risk Purchase**: In case of abnormal delays (beyond the maximum late delivery period as per LD clause in supplies / defective supplies or nonfulfillment of any other terms and conditions given in Purchase Order, BHEL may cancel the Purchase Order in full or part thereof, and may also make the purchase of such material from elsewhere / alternative source at the risk and cost of the supplier. BHEL will take all reasonable steps to get the material from alternate source at optimum cost. If bidder does not agree to the above Risk Purchase Clause, BHEL reserves the right to reject the offer.

In case for compelling reasons BHEL accepts the offer without acceptance of this clause by the bidder and in the eventuality of Risk Purchase, appropriate action will be taken as per BHEL extant rules. This will be without prejudice to any other right of BHEL under the contract or under General Law.

Action against Bidders / vendor / supplier / contractor in case of default:

In order to protect the commercial interests of BHEL, BHEL shall take action against supplies / contractors by way of suspension of business dealings, who either fail to perform or are in default without any reasonable cause, cause loss of business/ money/ reputation, indulge in malpractices, cheating, bribery, fraud or any other misconduct or formation of cartels so as to influence the bidding process or influence the price etc.
