
01.00.00 TECHNICAL CRITERIA:

- 01.01.00 Bidder should have supplied minimum 90 MT of fabricated structural steel items in industry/ power plant/ cement plant/ steel plant/ mineral exploration plant/ any bulk material handling plant in any one financial year during the last 7 years as on the date of Part-I bid opening.
- 01.02.00 Bidder should have manufacturing capacity of at least 130MT per annum for fabricated structural steel items. Bidder to submit CA certificate w.r.t. the annual manufacturing capacity. Such CA certificate should not be older than 6 months as on the date of Part-I bid opening.
