Bidders shall not misunderstand that the measures to control the ply of materials is meant only for controlled blasting. Control of ply of materials shall be taken care even for uncontrolled blasting also to ensure safety of surroundings. Both blasting works (Item No. 2605 & 2506 of BOQ) are similar in execution except for time delay in usage of detonators for blasting activity, which is leading to difference in the weightage provided in BOQ/Price bids. The same was explained during the pre-bid meeting.
