1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. 3. Generic

6. Generic

2. **GUARANTEE:** The performance of the equipment shall be guaranteed for a period of minimum 12 months from the date of commissioning or 18 months from the date of supply whichever is earlier.

3. **COMMISSIONING:** Erection, Commissioning and performance prove-out of the equipment at BHEL works shall be done by the supplier.

4. If required bidders can visit BHEL works to study the site conditions before submitting the offer for the tender.

5. Delivery term shall be FOR BHEL stores Trichy inclusive of packing, forwarding, freight and insurance charges.

6. Dehumidifier shall be supplied with three sets of O&M manual. The manual shall contain the following details :

- a) Dehumidifier circuit diagrams
- b) Complete wiring diagram with Ferrule No.
- c) Operation manual and maintenance details.

7. All the documents required as in Bid Specific Additional Scope of Work (PQC / Performance certificate, Technical Specification, Self declaration format for local content) shall be filled , signed

and affixed with company stamp shall be attached during submission of Bid document.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specification and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid. Further any reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents / clauses shall also be null and void. If any seller has any objection / grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
