2.0 The offer shall be submitted as per the instructions of tender document and as detailed in this NIT. Bidders to note specifically that all pages of tender document, including these NIT pages of this particular tender together with subsequent correspondences shall be submitted by them, **Rates/Price including discounts/rebates, if any, mentioned anywhere/in any form other than the Price Bid, shall not be entertained.**

3.0 Unless specifically stated otherwise, bidder shall remit cost of tender and courier charges if applicable, in the form of Demand Draft drawn in favour of **Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd**, payable at Hyderabad issuing the Tender, along with techno-

commercial offer. Bidder may also choose to deposit the Tender document cost by cash at the Cash Office at PE&SD, BHEL, R.C. Puram, Hyderabad, on any working day; and in such case copy of Cash receipt is to be enclosed with the Techno Commercial offer. Sale of tender Documents shall not take place on Sundays, National Holidays, holidays declared by Central or State Governments and BHEL at Hyderabad.

- 4.0 Unless specifically stated otherwise, bidder shall deposit EMD/Tender Fee through Demand Draft/Pay Order in favour of Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd, payable at Hyderabad. **Hard copy of the Demand Draft should reach BHEL Hyderabad before the due date and time of bid submission.** BHEL shall not be responsible for postal or any other delays in this regards. Unless specifically stated otherwise, bidder shall deposit EMD through Cash Deposit (as permissible under the extant Income Tax Act) (before tender opening), Electronic Fund Transfer credited in BHEL account (before Tender Opening) or Banker's Cheque/ Demand Draft/ Pay Order in favour of Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd, payable at Hyderabad (along with offer). The EMD can also be accepted in form of FDR from scheduled Banks /Public Financial Institutions as defined in company's act (FDR should be in the name of contractor a/c BHEL)

EMD amount upto Rs. 2.0 Lacs can be submitted in the manner described in the above para and amount in excess of Rs. 2.0 lakh may be accepted in the form of Bank Guarantee from scheduled bank. The Bank Guarantee in such cases shall be valid for at least six months.

'One Time EMD' will not be considered for this tender. All the bidders who have 'One Time EMD' with BHEL and want to participate in this tender, would also submit the requisite amount of EMD as mentioned in Clause No. 1, Salient Features of NIT, Sl. No. (vii) above.

- 5.0 **Procedure for Submission of Tenders:** Bidders to submit their offer in TWO PART BID on or before the due date and time only to e-mail ids given below (without marking the mail to any other email id of BHEL).
1. TECHNO-COMMERCIAL OFFER (i.e. PART-1 Bid – including signed and stamped copies of GCC, SCC, Technical specification, integrity Pact and “Unpriced” Price Offer) should be submitted to TECHNICALBID_HYD@BHEL.IN

2. PRICE OFFER (i.e. PART-2 Bid) should be submitted to PRICEBID_HYD@BHEL.IN.

Offers are invited in two-parts only.

Documents Comprising the e-Tender

The tender shall be submitted online ONLY EXCEPT TENDER FEE & EMD (in physical form) as mentioned below:

a) **Technical Tender (Unpriced Tender)**

All Technical details (e.g. Eligibility Criteria requested (as mentioned below)) should be attached in e-tendering module, failing which the tender stands invalid & may be REJECTED. Bidders shall furnish the following information along with technical tender (preferably in pdf format):

- i. Tender Cost and Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) furnished in accordance with NIT Clause 3.0 & 4.0. Alternatively, documentary evidence for claiming exemption as per clause 29 of NIT
- ii Technical Bid (without indicating any price)

b) **Price Bid:**

- i. Prices are to be quoted in the attached Price Bid format sent through e-mail.
- ii. The price should be quoted for the accounting unit indicated in the e-tender document.
- iii. Note: It is the responsibility of tenderer to go through the Tender document to ensure furnishing all required documents in addition to above, if any. Any deviation would result in REJECTION of tender and would not be considered at a later stage at any cost by BHEL.
- iv. A person signing (manually or digitally) the tender form or any documents forming part of the contract on behalf of another shall be deemed to warrantee that he has authority to bind such other persons and if, on enquiry, it appears that the persons so signing had no authority to do so, the purchaser may, without prejudice to other civil and criminal remedies, cancel the contract and hold the signatory liable for all cost and damages.
- v. A tender, which does not fulfil any of the above requirements and/or gives evasive information/reply against any such requirement, shall be liable to be ignored and rejected.
- vi. In case offer is sent through hard copy/fax/telex/cable/electronically in place of e-tender, same shall not be considered.

DO NOTS

Bidders are requested NOT to submit the hard copy of the Bid. In case offer is sent through hard copy/fax/telex/cable/electronically in place of e-tender, the same shall not be considered. **Also, uploading of the price bid in prequalification bid or technical bid may RESULT IN REJECTION of the tender.**

7.0 Deviation with respect to tender clauses and additional clauses/suggestions in Techno-commercial bid / Price bid shall NOT be considered by BHEL. Bidders are requested to positively comply with the same.

8.0 BHEL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all Offers without assigning any reasons thereof. BHEL also reserves the right to cancel the Tender wholly or partly without assigning any reason thereof. Also BHEL shall not entertain any correspondence from bidders in this matter (except for the refund of EMD).

9.0 Assessment of Capacity of Bidders: NOT APPLICABLE

11.0 For any clarification on the tender document, the bidder may seek the same over phone/e-mail, within the scheduled date for seeking clarification, from the office of the undersigned. BHEL shall not be responsible for receipt of queries after due date of seeking clarification due to postal delay or any other delays. Any clarification / query received after last date for seeking clarification may not be normally entertained by BHEL and no time extension will be given.

12.0 BHEL may decide holding of pre-bid discussion [PBD] with all intending bidders as per date indicated in the NIT. The bidder shall ensure participation for the same at the appointed time, date and place as may be decided by BHEL. Bidders shall plan their visit accordingly. The outcome of pre-bid discussion (PBD) shall also form part of tender.

13.0 In the event of any conflict between requirement of any clause of this specification/ documents/drawings/data sheets etc. or requirements of different codes/standards specified, the same to be brought to the knowledge of BHEL in writing for clarification before due date of seeking clarification (whichever is applicable), otherwise, interpretation by BHEL shall prevail. Any typing error/missing pages/ other clerical errors in the tender documents, noticed must be pointed out before pre-bid meeting/submission of offer, else BHEL's interpretation shall prevail.

14.0 Unless specifically mentioned otherwise, bidder's quoted price shall deemed to be in compliance with tender including PBD.

18.0 Validity of the offer shall be for Ninety (90) days from the latest due date of offer submission (including extension, if any) unless specified otherwise.

19.0 Price Bids of shortlisted bidders shall only be opened either through the conventional price bid opening.

20.0 On submission of offer, further consideration will be subject to compliance to tender & qualifying requirement and customer's acceptance, as applicable.

21.0 In case the bidder is an "Indian Agent of Foreign Principals", 'Agency agreement has to be submitted along with Bid, detailing the role of the agent along with the terms of payment for agency commission in INR, along with supporting documents.

22.0 The bidders shall not enter into any undisclosed MoU or any understanding amongst themselves with respect to tender.

23.0 Consortium Bidding (or Technical Tie up) – NOT APPLICABLE

24.0 The bidder shall submit documents in support of possession of 'tender requirements' duly self-certified and stamped by the authorized signatory, indexed and properly linked in the format. In case BHEL requires any other documents/proofs, these shall be submitted immediately.

25.0 The bidder may have to produce original document for verification if so decided by BHEL.

- 26.0 The offers of the bidders who are on the banned list as also the offer of the bidders, who engage the services of the banned firms, shall be rejected. The list of banned firms is available on BHEL web site www.bhel.com.

- 31.0 **Make in India**
