Specifications for Auto Darkening Welding Shield with Supplied Air Respiratory System and Vortex Cooling Assembly.

The assembly shall comprise of the following.

I, Auto Darkening Welding Shield

II. Vortex Air Cooling Assembly

III. High Pressure Supplied Air Hose

IV. Filter Panel

I. Auto Darkening Welding Face Shield:

1. The shield shall have a clear visor combined with auto darkening filters with breathable forced ventilation which shall be connected to the air turbo with help of breathing tube connection.
2. The shield shall help user to have 360 viewing via shades, peripheral lenses and polycarbonate lens.
3. The Filter lens shall be suitable for precision weld preparation under low light conditions.
4. The lens assembly of the shield shall be spring mounted such that the spring holds the auto-darkening lens securely on top of the helmet, giving the welder a big, clear view behind the protection lens.
5. Clear lens shall allow viewing for precision grinding and cleaning, the careful alignment of electrodes and the inspection of newly-completed welds, all with constant eye and face protection, even in the darkest / low light conditions.
6. The Lenses and shades shall meet the IS/ EN or any other international industrial eye and face protection standards.
7. The lenses and shades shall meet the requirements of mechanical resistant to high speed particles.
8. Auto darkening filters shall be 100% compatible to variable shades of 5, 8, 9-15.
9. Breathing tube shall be attached to the headband instead of the shield so that there is less pulling on the shield from the tube.

10. There shall be reduced inward leakage for better breathing air quality for the users and also more flexibility to weld with a wider range of materials.

11. A spark- and spatter-resistant fabric head covers shall be supplied with all the welding Shields.

12. The complete system shall be approved and in compliance with EN/ IS.

II. Vortex Air Cooling Assembly

1. The Vortex Cooling Assembly shall be used with the head gears to provide a continuous airflow ranging between 6- 15 CFM (1 7 0 - 4 2 5 L P M) .

2. The Air control device shall provide the ability to cool the compressed air supply by as much as 50° F (28° C).

3. The device shall cool the air as supplied by the compressed air source and not the ambient air.

4. A manual control knob to adjust between upper and lower limits shall be provisioned to suit the cooling comfort requirements of the user.

5. The connecting plug shall be an industrial interchange standard fitting MPT used for high pressure air control valves.

6. The weight shall not exceed 600 Gms.

7. A Protective pad shall be attached to the control device to prevent the radiant heat and for comfort.

8. Muffler clip is provided for maintenance

9. Range of temperature for use shall be from -50C to +550C.

III. High Pressure Supplied Air Hose

1. The Hose shall be made up of polypropylene, Poly vinyl chloride, Polyethylene steel and brass and shall have non kinkable properties.

2. It shall allow 90% of the air to flow even if a section of the hose is bent in a form of loop.

2. The hose shall be of approximately 50 Feet in length.

3. It shall be non permeable to gasoline and resistant to other chemicals which may come into its contact.
4. The hose shall be abrasion resistant, durable and shall not be subjected to wear and tear easily.
5. The plug shall be an industrial interchange one with an internal diameter to allow easy flow of air at recommended p r e s s u r e s .
6. There shall be a system of twist lock for attachment of hose and shall not be disengaged by accidental axial pull.
7. The hose shall be tested for use in supplied air systems for non-Kinkability and non-collapsibility.

I V . F i l t e r P a n e l

1. The filter panel shall consist of an absorbent filter to enable remove water, oil, particulates, nuisance odours and vapours.
 2. It shall have a pressure regulator with a pressure ranging from 10 to 105 PSI.
 3. It shall have a filtering efficiency of 99% and above against particles size of 0.4 to 0.6 microns.
 4. The weight shall not exceed 4 kg.
 5. The filter panel shall be provisioned with a Safety pressure relief valve to limit a maximum air pressure of 125 PSI.
 6. The panel shall be equipped with industrial interchange quick disconnect sockets.
 7. The equipment (Panel and Hose) shall be tested and approved by EN/ IS/ NIOSH.
- Note: Complete assembly shall be approved and complied by EN/IS/ NIOSH or any other international standards. Relevant pamphlets, Test and approval certificates shall be submitted along with the offer for evaluation.

Ex-works offers will be summarily rejected without further clarification.
 - b. No charges shall be indicated as "Lumpsum" or "Approximate" in absolute value. All charges like taxes and duties should be clearly specified as "percentage" of the quoted rates.
 - c. Manufacturer's name, trademark or patent no. if any should be specified. Illustrative leaflets giving technical particulars are required along with quotation wherever necessary.
 - d. Products with I.S.I. certification marks will be preferred.
 - e. The Purchaser shall be under no obligation to accept the lowest or any other tender and shall be entitled to accept in Part or full without assigning any reason whatsoever.

4. Ranking L-1, L-2 etc. shall be done for individual items for the techno-commercially acceptable offers on landed cost to BHEL, Trichy basis and BHEL reserves the right to place order for individual items with different vendors. In the event of more than one vendor becoming L1 for the item, the enquiry quantity will be shared equally among all the L1 vendors.

5. BHEL reserves the right to negotiate with L1 vendor or re-float the tender for items where, L1 price is not the lowest acceptable price; BHEL reserves the right to increase or decrease the tender quantity.

6. TERMS OF PAYMENT: (Indigenous)

Payment term is 100% direct payment after 45 days from the date of receipt and acceptance of materials.

Any deviation in the above payment term will attract loading as mentioned below.

“SBI MCLR Rate (as applicable on the date of bid opening. Techno-commercial bid opening in case of two part bids) + 6% shall be considered for loading for the period of relaxation sought by bidders.

NOTE: 100% payment against dispatch document through bank / 90% payment against through document through bank + 10% payment after acceptance of materials / Cheque payment / payment against proforma invoice / advance payment / current cheque or post-dated cheque along with purchase order will not be accepted and those offers will not be considered.

7. LD clause & Risk purchase clause are applicable.

(Any deviations in the LD shall attract loading to the extent of relaxation sought to which it is not agreed by the bidder at offered value).

Single delivery schedule:

If the Supplier fails to deliver the P.O quantity within the period specified in the contract, then the Purchaser shall deduct liquidated damages, 0.5% of the total order value per week of delay or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% of the total order value.

8. **GST:** For supplies after implementation of GST i.e. after 30.06.2017, the following conditions will apply and supplier shall fully comply to the below points.

Indigenous suppliers:

a. Response to Tenders for Indigenous supplier will be entertained only if the vendor has a valid GST registration no which should clearly mentioned in the offer. If any specific exemption is available, a declaration with due supporting documents need to be furnished for considering the offer.

b. Supplier shall mention their GSTN registration number in all their invoices and invoices shall be in the format as specified/prescribed under GST laws. e. For all consignments received within the calendar month, input credit will be availed within that month in line with monthly returns filing cycle. f. In case of discrepancy in the data uploaded by supplier in the GSTN portal or in case of any shortages or rejection in the supply, then BHEL will not be able to avail the tax credit and will notify the supplier of the same. Supplier has to rectify the data discrepancy in the GSTN portal or issue credit note (details to be uploaded in GSTN portal) for the shortages or rejections in the suppliers, within the calendar month notified by BHEL.

g. For any such delay in availing of tax credit for reasons attributable to supplier (as mentioned above), interest (calculated @ SBI MCLR Rate + 6%) alongwith penalty if any will be deducted for the delayed period i.e. from the month of receipt till the month tax credit is availed, from the running bills.

h. Under GST regime, BHEL has to discharge GST liability on LD recovered from suppliers / contractors. Hence applicable GST shall also be recoverable from suppliers/contractors on LD amount. For this Debit note will be issued by BHEL indicating the respective supply invoice number.

9. PACKING AND MARKING: The supplier shall arrange for securely protecting and packing the stores to avoid loss or damages during transit.

10. Conditional offers are likely to be rejected.

11. The correspondences between the bidder and BHEL through email are considered as valid document legally though not signed.
