1. BHEL invites offers from reputed Vendors (refer Pre-Qualification Requirement and other requirements given with enquiry letter uploaded on our websites) as per Clause-2.0 of GCC Rev- 6 of the enclosed instructions to bidders via **E –procurement** (<https://bhel.abcpocure.com>) for Total price for Design, Engineering, Manufacture, Assembly, Inspection, Testing at vendor's and/or his sub-vendor's works, painting, Proper Packing for Transportation and Delivery to site of auxiliary steam pressure reducing and desuperheating stations complete with controls valves and all accessories including commissioning spares and Mandatory Spares as specified and necessary as per technical specification PE-TS-419-142-N101 for 1X800 MW APGENCO VIJAYWADA UNIT-8. Detailed scope of work and equipment details shall be as per technical specification and other details hosted on BHEL / BHEL-PEM websites.

2. Your best offer should be submitted in two parts strictly as per Clause-2.0 of the “**Instructions to Bidders**” of GCC Rev 06, for the under mentioned equipment/system.

3. Offers should be submitted ONLINE via e-Procurement System separately in two parts as follows:
Part-I: Online TECHNO-COMMERCIAL BID Part-II: Online PRICE BID
(For detailed instructions, please see clause no. 2.0 of “Instructions to Bidders” of GCC (Rev. 06).

4. It shall be the responsibility of the bidder to ensure that the tender is submitted online on or before the **due date by 02:00 PM**. Part-I bids shall be opened at **03:00 PM**. on the due date.

Bidders may go through the Sellers’ manual & Help documents provided on E-Procurement Portal website (<https://bhel.abcpocure.com>) & obtain required Digital Signature Certificate for participating in the subject Tender. For Bidders’ convenience.

5. The offers of the bidders who are on the banned list & also the offers of the bidders who engage the services of the banned firms, shall be rejected. The list of banned firms is available on BHEL website www.bhel.com.
6. **TERMS AND CONDITIONS:** - Please refer GCC Rev-06 also corrigendum to GCC Rev. 06 which is available on www.bhelpem.com. Bidders are requested to kindly download the same. Bidders are advised to go through the same while submitting the offers.
7. **Variation in overall contract values (due to changes in scope) shall be $\pm 5\%$.**

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8. Offers should be submitted in two parts separately as follows:
- **Part-I: Techno-Commercial Bid:** Comprising of technical offer, Annexure-I, Commercial terms and conditions, unpriced copy of price bid and Annexure-II of GCC Rev.06 for DEVIATION SHEET (cost of withdrawal), PQR documents in (02) sets.
 - **Part-II: Price Bid:** Containing prices, cost of withdrawal of deviation as per Annexure-II, to be submitted in original, strictly, as per price schedule of BHEL for complete scope of Tender enquiry.

Tenders shall be submitted strictly in accordance with the requirements of the above tender documents. Deviations (Technical as well as Commercial), if any, shall be listed out separately as per **Annexure II of GCC Rev 06**.

9. Standard pre-printed terms & conditions of the tenderers shall not be considered valid.
10. Unsolicited fresh/revised Price Bids shall not be entertained.
11. Purchaser shall be under no obligation to accept the lowest or any other tender and shall be entitled to accept or reject any/all tender(s) in part or full without assigning any reason whatsoever.
12. Tenderers must enclose the Quality Plan in the prescribed format, for approval. Equipment will be despatched only after Purchaser's/Owner's inspection at the hold points specified in the approved Quality Plan and issue of Material Despatch Clearance Certificate (MDCC).

14. **BHEL reserves the right to finalize Prices by conducting RA or by conventional way of price bid opening, which will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation.** In view of this, Bidder is requested to quote their most competitive prices as **no negative price impact** shall be applicable on account of non-conduction of RA. Detailed terms and conditions for RA are available in "information section" of www.bhelpem.com. Further, Bidders has to quote the Single Price (i.e. Total Cost to BHEL, excluding GST) in Reverse Auction. Price are to be inclusive of Packing & Forwarding charges, all the routine & type tests as per tender scope, Freight as applicable, including loading (if any). De-loading (if any) shall be done in line with NIT terms. **GST shall not be inclusive as evaluation is to be done excluding GST.**

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15. Pre-Qualifying Requirement

Bidders who fulfil PRE-QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT (PQR) criteria are eligible to participate in this tender. Bidders are requested to provide the details as per PQR. Bids of only those bidders shall be evaluated who shall meet the PQR.

16. Bidder to provide 2 Years of Extended warranty over and above as mentioned in GCC Rev06 clause no. 12 as per 'Technical specification' clause no. 1.8 (highlighted) in the 'Scope of Enquiry'

Delivery: Following is the delivery schedule for this package:

For Main Supply (along with commissioning spares) - Six (06) months from the date of drgs./docs. approval in CAT-I issued by BHEL/CUSTOMER. This is subject to bidder's 1st submission of drawing/docs within 3 weeks from the date of P.O. Vendor to re-submit documents within 10 days only, taking care of all the comments of BHEL.

Drawings submitted shall be complete in all respects with revised drawing submitted incorporating all comments. Any incomplete drawing submitted shall be treated as non-submission with delays to bidder's account. For any clarification/ discussion required to complete the drawings, the bidder shall himself depute his personal to BHEL for across the table discussions/ finalization / submissions of drawings. Drawing submission schedules are to be adhered by the bidders and any delay in the same from bidder's end shall be deducted from delivery period indicated from CAT I approval.

For Mandatory spares:- Delivery shall be 03 months from the date of manufacturing clearance. Separate dispatch/manufacturing clearance will be issued for mandatory spares as per SCC Rev00.

Note: - Keeping in view the above delivery schedule, Essentiality Certificate (if required) shall be issued within 08 weeks from the date of furnishing of "Formal Request/ Application from vendor giving full details of items to be imported, their quantities, values & source of procurement.

18. If any bidder has mentioned the term **Not Applicable / Not required / Not Quoted** in BHEL price format. The bidder needs to substantiate the same. If the same item will be required in future for the system same will be supplied free of cost by bidder.
19. Deviations (Commercial as well as Technical) from NIT are generally not acceptable. In case there are deviations from NIT, the tenderer shall give cost of withdrawal of such deviations as per annexure-II of GCC Rev 06. [Deviation Sheet (Cost of withdrawal)] in the link provided in eprocurement website.
20. Bidder to note that this is a conditional Open Tender enquiry and the price bid (Part-II) opening/ RA participation shall be subjected to following criterion:
- Techno-commercial qualification / recommendation of bidder by the BHEL-PEM.
 - Approval of bidder by customer**
Approval shall be taken up by BHEL with customer based on the credentials / reference list. Hence, bidders are requested to submit the following (a part of their credentials) on or before Part-1 opening / due date in two CD's :-
 - Company Profile
 - List of projects executed/ on hand for power sectors / Govt. organizations for the subject package.

- iv) Copies of major supply order executed by the vendor.
21. Note: Non-registered Vendors who wish to apply for registration in BHEL-PEM through Online Registration Portal available at www.bhelpem.com → Vendor section + Online Supplier Registration. All credentials and / or documents duly signed and stamped related to registration has to be uploaded on the website and submit the application for registration. One set of hard copy of the filled-up SRF downloaded from Online Registration Portal duly signed and stamped has to be submitted.
22. Any other taxes & Duties applicable on the date of bid but not quoted by the bidders shall be to bidder account.
23. **Evaluation shall be done on overall L-1 Basis (Total cost to BHEL excluding GST).**
24. The Bidder along with its associate/ collaborators/ sub-contractors/ sub-vendors/ consultants/ service providers shall strictly adhere to BHEL Fraud Prevention Policy displayed on BHEL website <http://www.bhel.com> and shall immediately bring to the notice of BHEL Management about any fraud or suspected fraud as soon as it comes to their notice.
25. Foreign and indigenous bidders participating through future open tender tender will necessarily have to buy class III DSCs (Digital Signature Certificate) issued by the certifying authorities in India. Basic procedure /checklist shall be upload on www.bhel.com for participating in future tender enquires through e procurement.
27. In case of foreign bidders, bidders have to quote the prices on C & F Basis instead of FOB Basis. Further, foreign bidder to please note the following points:-
- Shipped on board* date mentioned on the clean Bill of Lading or Air way Bill, shall be treated as the date of shipment/ Dispatch for calculation of LD.
 - Usance period (90 days) of the L/C shall start from the date of Bill of lading/Air Way Bill.
 - Bill of Lading shall be considered as equivalent document (refer clause 9.7.1 b OF GCC Rev-06) for recognition of dispatch.
 - For claiming payment under clause 9.1.1 and 9.2.1 Bill of lading shall be considered instead of receipted LR (refer clause 9.7.2 b of GCC rev-06)
 - Freight is to be quoted as inclusive in basic price by bidder and is not to be quoted separately.
 - Insurance for evaluation purposes shall be @ 0.1 % of quoted C&F price.
 - There will be no change in MRC payment.
28. Payment terms shall be as per GCC Rev-06 & corrigendum to GCC Rev. 06
29. Terms & Condition as per corrigendum to GCC Rev. 06 are also applicable for this enquiry.
30. All corrigenda, addenda, amendments, time extensions, clarifications, etc to the tender are hosted on BHEL website (www.bhel.com), BHEL-PEM website (www.bhelpem.com) & CPP Portal. Bidders should regularly visit websites to keep themselves updated.
31. All the tender documents shall automatically become a part of the Order/Contract after its finalization.
32. **Inspection Agency:-**
For Domestic supplier:- Vendor shall give inspection call on BHEL-CQS website to applicable inspection agency with a copy of inspection call to BHEL-PEM for arranging customer participation (If applicable) in inspection/Joint inspection on the proposed date with the advance notice of 15 working days. Inspection charges shall be paid by BHEL-PEM.

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For International supplier:-

In case of imported supplies, advance notice of 30 days for participation in inspection (if applicable, in line with approved QAP / Customer hold point) shall be given by vendor. Third party inspection agency shall be informed to vendor by BHEL-PEM.

Test certificates/Inspection report (as applicable) duly accepted by the inspection agency in line with approved QAP/Customer hold point shall be submitted to BHEL/PEM Noida. The above inspection report/Test certificate shall be reviewed by PEM/Engg. In line with technical specification and approved data sheets and then sent to Customer for their clearance. The material dispatch clearance certificate (MDCC) shall be given to the foreign supplier (or their representative in India) through BHEL/PEM after acceptance of above test certificate by customer. Inspection charges shall be borne by vendor and same shall be included in their offer to BHEL/PEM.

33. Bank Guarantee Format as enclosed in NIT as per Annexure – A to be followed.
34. If any bidder uploads price bid in the unpriced section (techno-commercial attachment page) of the tender in e-procurement, in that case bidder(s) shall only be responsible for such mistake and any consequences thereof. Hence all bidders are requested to be more careful at the time of uploading the Unpriced and Price Bid for Part-I and Part-II respectively to avoid mismatch.
35. **CIF is available for subject package. Vendor to indicate same in BOQ.**
36. **For Foreign bidders, port of discharge in India shall be Chennai port.**
