Terms & Conditions	: 1. Material shall be supplied to BHEL Rudrapur, rates shall be quoted FOR BHEL RUDRAPUR basis including transit insurance and freight charges. (Address: CFP-BHEL Rudrapur, Kichha Bye Pass Road, Near FCI Godown, U.S. Nagar, Uttarakhand-263153). 2. Firm Rates shall be quoted for entering into framework agreement (FA) for 01-year. Rates quoted shall be valid for 15 months from bid opening date. Multiples Orders may be placed during validity / tenure of this framework agreement 3. Quantity indicated in NIT is envisaged for one-year requirement. BHEL will place several purchase orders in LOTs (01 Lot- 1000 no.) periodically against framework agreement finalized against this NIT. 4. Bidders may note that after finalization of this tender, BHEL shall enter into Framework Agreement with successful bidder. Framework Agreement shall be valid for the quantity mentioned in NIT and for one-year period. BHEL may extend the Framework Agreement period/quantity by further maximum 12 months & totaling to 02 years for the entire Framework Agreement with mutual consent. However, finalization & signing of Framework agreement does not entitle any bidder to any firm order. BHEL shall place purchase orders periodically in line with Framework Agreement as per BHEL's requirement. 5. Tender shall be awarded to techno-commercially qualified bidder who quotes lowest landed rate. Method of finalization i.e. Reverse Auction or Price bids opening shall be decided by BHEL later on based on the number of techno-commercially qualified bidders. 6. <u>Supplier shall collect the Al. Cut-off/Scrap from BHEL Rudrapur and deliver back the finished material. To and Fro transportation charges shall be in the scope of vendor.</u> 7. Taxes & Duties etc. shall be payable extra at actuals. 8. Bidders to submit signed and sealed copy of all attached drawing and Standard as a proof of acceptance 9. Payment term: 100% payment after receipt of material within 45 days' subject to receipt and acceptance of material. Any deviation in payment terms will be loaded @ (SBI Prime lending rate at the time of payment loading +6) % annual interest for comparing standing. 10. Raw Material in the form of Al. Cut-Off/Scrap will be provided by BHEL Rudrapur under GST norms and Job Work, which has to comply the vendors any liability on account of this shall be recoverable from attributable vendor. 11. Chemical composition of finished item shall be as per Grade 4635 of IS617 as attached. Test Certificate/Guarantee Certificate shall be in conformance to the mentioned Grade. 12. Extra 5% Burning & Machining Allowance on drawing weight shall be admissible.		

13. Casting shall be as per attached drawing 31001000220 Rev 03. Casting Items are required for assembly of Bus-Duct.

14. Delivery of 1000 Pieces within 01 Month (from the date of receipt of Al. scrap by vendor) progressively till the completion of PO.

15. Supplier shall be required to submit a Security Deposit of a value of Rs.150/Kg as guarantee of scrap provided by BHEL. Security Deposit shall be provided before lift/collection of scrap from BHEL and must be valid until the completion of Purchase Order. Security Deposit does not carry any interest.

16. Liquidated Damages (LD):

In case of delay in delivery, a penalty of 0.5% per week, maximum up to 10% of total order value on delayed portion shall be applicable. In case of quoting any deviation from the above LD clause, the offer shall be loaded in comparison statement for un-accepted portion of LD, maximum up to 10% of basic value.

17. Risk Purchase Clause:

If the supplier fails to deliver the whole or any part of the goods or services within the stipulated delivery period mentioned in the Purchase order, BHEL shall be entitled to terminate the contract and to purchase the same or the best and the nearest available substitute from elsewhere at the risk and cost of the seller either the whole or any part of the goods/Services.

In case of deviation or non-acceptance of Risk Purchase clause, offer shall be liable for rejection.

18. Facilitation of MSE bidder:

MSE bidders are encouraged by BHEL and shall be facilitated. MSE suppliers can avail the intended benefits only if they submit along with the offer, attested copies of valid MSE certificate like EM-II certificate or NSIC certificate or Udyog Aadhar Memorandum or any other relevant certificate provided by any other body specified by Ministry of MSME, Govt under Public Procurement Policy along with attested copy of a Chartered Accountants certificate not older than one financial year. Non-submission of such documents will lead to consideration of their bid at par with other bidders. No benefit shall be applicable for this enquiry if any deficiency in the above required documents are not submitted before price bid opening/reverse auction. If the tender is to be submitted through e-procurement portal, then the above required documents are to be uploaded on the portal. Documents should be notarized or attested by a Gazetted officer.

19. Suspension of Business Dealings:
