Framework Agreement (Rate Contract) for testing of construction material, including design mix approval and allied test for various project sites of BHEL across India.

5.	Duration of Rate Contract	24 Months. However, this rate contract may further be extended for a maximum period of another 3 months at the same rate, terms and conditions at the discretion of BHEL. Refer Chapter III of TCC.

12.	Modality of Award	1. Bidders shall submit their price bids for entire scope of work i.e. 100% quantity of BOQ cum rate schedule of Frame Work Agreement. 2. Total quantity shall be split into Three (03) packages in the Ratio of 50%: 30%: 20% of total Qty in 3 Packages. Each package constitutes independent rate contract and shall be awarded as mentioned below: i. Package I (50% of total quantity): Package I shall be awarded to Lowest Evaluated (L-1) Bidder, subject to the L-1 rates being acceptable to BHEL. ii. Package II (30% of total quantity): The derived price for Package II, based on

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		the finalized L-1 rates, shall be offered to the remaining bidders in ascending order of price competitiveness (i.e., L-2, L-3, L-4, and so on) for acceptance. The first bidder accepting the offered price in writing within the stipulated period, shall be considered for award of Package II. In case, no bidder accepts the offered price for Package II, the awarded bidder of Package I (L-1 bidder) shall be awarded with Package II and the bidder shall be obligated to accept the award. iii. Package III (20% of total quantity): The derived price for Package III, based on the finalized L-1 rates, shall be offered to the next bidders (bidder next to whom Package II is awarded) in ascending order of price competitiveness (i.e., L-2, L-3, L-4, and so on) for acceptance, excluding the bidders already awarded Packages I and II. The first bidder accepting the offered price in writing within the stipulated period, shall be considered for award of Package III. In case, no bidders agree to match the finalized L-1 rates for Package III, the awarded bidder of Package I (L-1 bidder) shall be awarded with Package III and the bidder shall be obligated to accept the award. 3. In case, the rate contract is entered between with two agencies only due to smaller number of qualified bidders or bidders not accepting finalized L-1 rates then, BHEL will award the quantities of Package III equally between those two agencies and both bidders shall be obligated to accept the award. Thus, the ratio

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		shall become 60%:40% between Package I and Package II. 4. Letter of Award (LOA) of Framework Agreement (Rate Contract) shall be issued by BHEL CPC however, Work Orders for specific project shall be issued by respective PS-Regions of BHEL.
