SCOPE OF WORK AND GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- 1. The Scope of work involves ferrying BHEL ESD employees from various parts of Bangalore to BHEL-ESD Factory at Electronics City, Hosur Road & from factory to their respective pick-up and dropping points. (It is subject to change based on our requirement). In case we need any additional vehicle within slab for ferrying employees, the same should be provided on the same terms & conditions. The No of Vehicles may be decreased or increased based on our requirements after giving one month notice to the vendor.
- 2. BHEL ESD reserves the right of changing the routes of the various vehicles.
- 3. ONE TT/Force traveler with the Driver will be retained at ESD for official use for local trips and inter-state (short distance) after the morning trip to factory within the daily working time of BHEL-ESD and that vehicle should have all India Permit and all the toll charges and permit charges will be borne by BHEL. Driver bata to be observed by the Transporter.
- **4.** Remaining Five vehicles will leave the premises and report back at 3.30 PM (11.30 AM on Saturday) for the evening trip. Choice of which vehicles to be retained at ESD will be the discretion of BHEL ESD. Without authorized permission of BHEL-ESD HR, the designated vehicle should not leave ESD premises.
- 5. The vehicles provided must be of 2014 model or later.
- **6.** The vehicles are required to report at the designated place of first pick-up point of all routes 15 minutes before the commencement time.
- 7. The present factory timings are from 07.30 hrs to 16.36 hrs (Monday to Friday) and 0730 hrs to 1230 hrs (Saturday). The vehicle should arrive at BHEL ESD front gate at 7.25 AM in the morning and should leave BHEL ESD Gate at 16.45 hours. On Saturday the vehicles should leave BHEL ESD gate at 12.40 hours. In case of any change in timings, the same will be informed to the vendor within ten days' notice.
- 8. Bidders must directly own all the Six (6) vehicles of 12+1 seater. Proof of direct ownership (as per clause No. 11 of page no. 13 of Technical Bid) must be enclosed along with the bid.
- 9. ONE vehicle to be retained for BHEL premises for use. BHEL ESD reserves the right to use the vehicle at its discretion. In case the same vehicle is required by the Contractor, it will be released only against arrival of the suitable alternate [good running condition] vehicle at our premises irrespective of the reasons.
- 10. The copies of valid records/documents like RC Book, Vehicle permit, Insurance, Driving Licenses of Drivers, Emission certificate etc., should be produced at the time of award of contract and whenever required by us for verification. Vehicle should be in good running condition of 2014 model or later & all statutory requirements of RTO/Police, etc., should be fully complied with.
- 11. The Bidder shall be responsible for providing vehicle Drivers with License. The drivers

must possess valid driving license and have at least five years' experience driving similar vehicles. The drivers' license document is to be produced for verification by BHEL, whenever demanded

- 12. Contractor will also be responsible for their courteous behavior towards the BHEL Staff, Executives, customers and passengers in the vehicles. Drivers will strictly adhere to instruction and directions issued by BHEL when the vehicles are on duty and at our command. Strict discipline shall be ensured by contractor. The contractor shall be responsible for behavior of his driver at company premises.
- 13. The names of the successful bidder's staff/representatives along with their office address/contact numbers have to be furnished by the contractor who have to be contacted, during exigencies or for necessary clarification.
- 14. The vehicles in this tender are for carrying adults. Vehicles of the same seating capacity used as school vehicles with lesser leg space are not acceptable. Short roof vehicles are not allowed.
- 15. BHEL ESD reserves the right to terminate the contract with one month's notice if the performance is not satisfactory.
- 16. BHEL ESD also reserves the right to short closure the contract with Two months' notice due to administrative reasons.
- 17. Bidder shall be responsible for covering contractor's/ drivers'/supervisors against all statutory regulations including personal accident insurance etc. BHEL-ESD shall not be responsible for any consequences arising on account of any violation of any statutory provisions, rules/regulations by the Bidder.
- 18. Average annual financial turnover during the last three years ending 31st March of 2017, should not be less than 26 Lakhs.
- 19. Copy of completion/performance certificate indicating the value of the work or copy of the Work Order/Purchase Order indicating the value of the work order along with the satisfactory completion certificates of service from previous employers. If the Bidders have provided services to other BHEL Units, their performance will be taken into account while evaluating their technical capability.
- 20. The rate quoted should include the charges towards fuel, wages, permit, insurance, service taxes and maintenance of vehicle, statutory payments etc., and the rate shall be subjected to price variation clause on increase/decrease of fuel prices during the contractual period.
- 21. Service Tax rate is as per extant rules & Regulations under the relevant law
- 22. Bidder should have successfully completed similar works during the last seven (7) years as per details hereunder (Copy of work order/Agreement and completion certificate to be enclosed along with bid. In case of ongoing contracts, the works order/Agreement and performance certificates are to be provided)
 - a) Three similar completed works (each not less than Rs.34.25 lakhs / -), or
 - b) Two similar completed works (each not less than Rs.42.78 lakhs -), or

- c) One similar completed works (each not less than Rs.68.45 Lakhs /-).
- If any bidder is not fulfilling any of above conditions from 'a 'to 'c 'will be summarily rejected.
- 23. In case of any breakdown of running vehicle, alternate arrangement of same seating capacity and in good running condition should be made within half-an-hour to fulfill the contractual terms. Failure to make alternate arrangement will result in levying of appropriate penalty as given below.
- 24. Failure to make alternate arrangements will result on levying of Penalty as under
 - a. If the vehicle is not reported [Breakdown while reaching the first point] at first Pick-Up Point and reaches the factory as required, the penalty is 50% of the daily rate.
 - b. If the vehicle is not available at our disposal for half-a-day and less i.e. half of the specified slab hours & less [tolerance of 15 minutes] the penalty is 75% of the daily rate.
 - c. If the above failure [half-a-day] occurs more than once in a calendar month then the penalty will be 25% of the daily rate in addition to the above penalty, for the second and subsequent failures.
 - d. If the vehicle is not available at our disposal for more than half of slab hours it will be treated as full day and the penalty is 125% of the daily rate, if the above failure [full day] occurs more than once in a calendar month then penalty will be 50 % of the daily rate in addition to the above penalty for the second and subsequent failures.
 - e. If the vehicle is not available after doing part of work during first or second half and no alternate arrangement is made within half-an-hour then penalty will be as per "b & c".
 - f. The vehicle at ESD premises without Driver will attract the above said penalty [b to e].
- 25. After dropping the employees/evening trip, Drivers/Supervisors of the Contractor will not be allowed entry inside the factory.
- 26. The drivers of the TT/Force traveler should be wearing Uniform during driving for BHEL, as per RTO guidelines
- 27. **PRICE VARIATION (PVC):** The rates finalized will be firm during the contract period. However, in case of change in fuel prices, a change in the rate will be allowed in the following pattern subject to documentary evidence regarding such change. Rates as per PVC will be given effect from 1st day of subsequent month only. (For e.g. if price change has taken place say in the month of July, then PVC rates (based on the latest fuel rate) will be given effect from August month only). The fuel price at the date of NIT will be the base price for PVC clause. The fuel price variation clause is also applicable for extra running KMs. Price variation clause will be applicable only when there is increase/decrease in fuel price (regular diesel price) per Litre to the tune of one rupee or more compared to previously considered rate.

- 28. The company reserves the right to use the vehicle at its discretion, denial of performing any trip would be viewed seriously and attracts penalty as per clause- 24 irrespective of the reasons. Trip sheet should be maintained by properly recording time, kilometers on daily basis and obtain the signature from the authorized person identified/nominated by us. Contractor will also be responsible for their courteous behavior towards the BHEL Staff in the vehicles. Drivers will strictly adhere to instruction and directions issued by BHEL when the vehicles are on duty and at our command. Strict discipline shall be ensured by contractor. The contractor shall be responsible for behavior of his driver at company premises.
- 29. The contractor shall execute an agreement within a month of issue of work order, as per BHEL format containing all the terms and conditions, on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs 200/-. The cost of stamp paper to be borne by the contractor.
- 30. Trip sheet should be maintained properly by recording time, kilometers on daily basis and obtain the signature from the first pick-up/last drop-employee on same day.
- 31. It may please be noted that all information along with enclosures those are required under tender document, should be clearly filled-in, if any column is left blank then the bid will be rejected summarily. Any information, wherever the bidder feels important and necessary, the same can be furnished as enclosures only. The Trip sheet Book will be provided by BHEL-ESD and the same has to be submitted on monthly basis (calendar month) along with the bills. Payment shall be settled in on or after thirty (30) days from the date of submitting the bill.
- b) Payment will be made only once in a month. Bidder will submit the bills on monthly basis(Calendar month), which will be duly verified, checked and passed by ESD HR department and forwarded to Finance Department of BHEL EDN Bangalore for releasing payment to the contractor.
- c) If any discrepancies in the trip sheets/bill will be returned immediately for resubmission after correction by the contractor within 1 month. All payments will be made by Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT) for which bidders shall fill in the EFT format giving their Bank A/c details. EFT will take place after thirty (30) days of submission of clear bills. Electronic fund transfer form is enclosed herewith.

EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT(EMD):

EMD is to be paid by tenderers for securing fulfilment of any obligations in terms of the NIT. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) Rs.1, 71,132/- is required to be furnished along with the Tender Document.

Modes of deposit:

The EMD may be accepted only in the following forms:

- i. Cash deposit as permissible under the extant Income Tax Act (before tender opening)
- ii. Electronic Fund Transfer credited in BHEL account (before tender opening)
- iii. Banker's cheque / Pay order / Demand draft, in favour of BHEL(along with offer)

Forfeiture of EMD:

EMD by the Tenderer will be forfeited as per NIT conditions, if:

- i. After opening the tender and within the offer validity period, the tenderer revokes his tender or makes any modification in his tender which is not acceptable to BHEL.

Security Deposit:

Security Deposit means the security provided by the Contractor towards fulfillment of any obligations in terms of the provisions of the contract

The total amount of Security Deposit will be 5% of the contract value. EMD of the successful tenderer shall be converted and adjusted towards the required amount of Security Deposit.

Modes of deposit:

The balance amount to make up the required Security Deposit of 5% of the contract value may be accepted in the following forms:

- i. Cash (as permissible under the extant Income Tax Act)
- ii. Local cheques of Scheduled Banks(subject to realization) / Pay Order / Demand Draft / Electronic Fund Transfer in favour of BHEL
- iii. Bank Guarantee from Scheduled Banks / Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act. The Bank Guarantee format should have the approval of BHEL
- iv. Fixed Deposit Receipt issued by Scheduled Banks / Public Financial Institions as defined in the Companies Act (FDR should be in the name of the contractor, a/c BHEL)
- v. Securities available from indian Post Offices such as National Saving Certificate, Kisan Vikas Patras etc. (held in the name of Contractor furnishing the Sacurity and duly endorsed / hypothecated / pledged, as applicable, in favour of BHEL)

(The requirement of Security Deposit or otherwise, as the case may be, shall be clearly specified in the tender conditions).

Collection of Security:

At least 50% of the required Security Deposit, including the EMD, should be collected before start of the work. Balance of the Security Deposit can be collected by deducting 10% of the gross amount progressively from each of the running bills of the Contractor till the amount of the required Security Deposit is collected.

If the value of work done at any time exceeds the contract value, the amount of Security Deposit shall be correspondingly enhanced and the additional Security Deposit Shall be immediately deposited by the Contractor or recovered from payment/s due to the Contractor.

The recoveries made from running bills (cash deduction towards balance SD amount) can be released against submission of equivalent Bank Guarantee in acceptable form, but only once, before completion of work, with the approval of the authority competent to award the work.

(Note: In case of (a) small value contracts not exceeding Rs. 20lakhs or (B) SAS job jobs, work can be released only after collection / recovery of initial 50% Security Deposit).

Security Deposit shall be released in the Contractor upon fulfilment of contractual obligations as per terms of the contract.

The Security Deposit shall not carry any interest.

<u>Note:</u> Acceptance of Security Deposit against SI. No. (iv) and (v) above will be subject to hypothecation or endorsement on the documents in favour of BHEL. However, BHEL will not be liable or responsible in any manner for the collection of interest or renewal of the documents or in any other matter connected therewith).

Security Deposit will be refunded to the contractor after completion of the contract period subject to satisfactory completion of work and compliances to statutory obligations as per this NIT.
