Annexure – II

Subject : 75 Nos. Digital Plain Paper Copier (B&W) Machines on Rental Basis.

Scope of Work:-

1. **Function:** 75 Nos. Digital Plain Paper Copier (B&W) Machines shall be used for printing of drawing and documents of size up to A3 size in various departments. **The machines shall be multi-user-password (Minimum 10 Users) protected with non-programmable metering, capable of giving user wise monthly report.**
2. **Period of Contract:** The contract will commence on the date of installation machine.i.e. **installation of last machine of lot of 75 machines** and will remain valid for a period of 05 (Five) Years from date of commencement.**In case ,Total number of copies as per contract are not printed during the contract period of 60 months ,BHEL can retain the machines for an additional period of three (3) months without payment of any rent.**
3. PO will be placed on two suppliers in the ratio **45 Machines: 30 Machines** at L1 rate, between L1 & L2 Vendors. In case of L2 vendor does not agree for the L1 rate the 100% order shall be placed on L1 vendor.
4. **Supply of Machines:** 75 Nos. New Machines shall be installed and documentary evidence viz. E.D. Gate pass, Custom clearance, etc. to this effect shall be furnished.
5. **Upkeep of Machine :** The Supplier has to maintain the machines to ensure that the machines are giving quality print for minimum 97% of the available time (To be calculated on the basis of 8 Hrs shift per day).
6. **Deduction towards the excessive down time during any month, will be made from machine rent of the supplier as follows:**
Deduction toward down time: Down up to 3% in a month- **No deduction.**
Down time above 3% and up to 6%: - Basic monthly machine rent will be deducted-**One Month**
Down time above 6% and up to 10% - Basic monthly machine rent will be deducted- **Two Months**
Down time above 10% - **Basic machine rent for the quarter will not be payable.**
7. **Preventive Maintenance:** Regular Preventive Maintenance shall be undertaken.
8. **Special Preventive Maintenance:** **The machine shall be provided with extended preventive maintenance after crossing 2 lakh copies and complete overhaul (refurbishment) after 4 lakh copies. After a machine crosses 4 lakh copies it can be rotated with another machine of lower reading at another location with the prior permission of Engineer-In-Charge.**
9. **Breakdown:** **In case of breakdown of any machine for more than 10% continuously for 3 months, the supplier shall replace the machine with new one.**
10. **Replacement:** After 6 lakh copies have been made on a particular machine, the machine shall be replaced by a new one by supplier.
11. **Resite:** If required the machines shall be re-sited inside the plant without any charge by the supplier.
12. **Complaints:** All the complaints must be attended within 2 hours of registration. For this supplier has to ensure that **sufficient numbers of service personnel are available at his Bhopal Office.** This shall be provided beyond BHEL office hours and on holidays also, in case need arises.
13. **Consumables & Spares:** **Supplier shall maintain adequate stock of cartridges and other consumables to avoid any hold up of work. Electricity, Print media & Paper shall be provided by BHEL.**

14. **Training:** Operators of the machines shall be given on the job /classroom Training. These training sessions shall be held at BHEL every six months as per the directions of Engineer- in- charge.

Important Commercial Terms & Conditions for Installation

1. Tenderer should submit their offer in double cover containing two separate sealed envelopes i.e.

Part A "**Technical Cum Commercial Offer**" and part B -"**Price Bid**". Both the envelopes to be superscribed with "**Digital Plain Paper Copier (B&W) Machines on rental Basis in. BHEL Bhopal "** and contents of envelope with date of opening.

Initially Part A " Technical Cum Commercial Offer " shall be opened and shall accompany with it an EMD of **Rs. 159090/- (One Lakh fifty Nine Thousand Ninety rupees) only in form of online payment in favour of BHEL, Bhopal and Receipt of Tender Cost of Rs. 1000 +GST shall be extra. or online payment in favour of BHEL Bhopal, if downloaded from BHEL Web site.**

The Part B- "**Price Bid**" offer will be opened only for the technically cum commercially accepted offers after technical scrutiny. The price bid shall contain - The rental charges quoted in two parts i.e. (i) Monthly Basic machine lease/rent and Tax, if any, shall be clearly indicated. (ii) Per Copy Basic charges, separately indicating GST and other applicable tax.

- **Rates shall be quoted both in figures and words.**
- Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd. Reserves the right to accept or reject any tender at its discretion.
- In the event of any tenderer withdraws the tender after it is opened but before the order is placed the earnest money will be forfeited.

Enclosed Schedule 'A' shall be used for price Bid.

2. The Contract will be for five years after the date of start of contract. Rental period will start from date of installation of machines. **The date of start of contract shall be date of installation of last machine of the lot of 75 machines with respect to all the terms & conditions and prices. In case, Total numbers of copies as per contract are not printed during the contract period of period of 60 months, BHEL can retain the machines for an additional period of three (3) months without payment of any rent.**

All Seventy five (75) machines shall be installed within 15 days of award of LOI/contract whichever is earlier. Any delay in installation this shall attract penalty in form of non-payment of **one month rent for machines are not installed within 15 days up to one month. There after one month rental for every part or full month of delay GST on the penalty amount shall be extra.** The locations for installations of machines shall be informed to successful vendor.

3. **No Security deposit is required during the Contract Period.**
4. All Digital Plain Paper Copier (B&W) Machines shall be insured by the vendor at his cost.
5. **The vendor shall be the manufacturer or its authorized dealer of the machine.**
6. **The vendor shall submit a list of customers/users with same machine/model in India along with performance certificates from at least two customers.**
7. **The vendor shall sign on all the pages of the tender documents and shall show agreement/disagreement to all the clauses of tender in annexure I to V.**

Annexure – IV

Subject : 75 Nos. Digital Plain Paper Copier (B&W) Machines on Rental Basis

Payment Terms

Payment shall be released on quarterly basis upon receipt of bill from the contractor of actual reading of number of copies, Monthly rent & deduction if any and duly certified by the in-charge of Reprographic Centre, TSD.

Bill shall contain following details.

- i)
 - A). Basic machine rent on quarterly basis.
 - B). Lease rent tax if any.

- A) Copy Charges indicating separately - material and labour part, for prints taken out in the Quarter on the basis of monthly machine readings
 - B) GST as applicable.
- ii) Deduction towards following
 - i) Deduction of payment for downtime of m/c shall be, as per **annexure-II (clause 5.0)**.
- iii) **GST Compliances**
 - 1) Whenever bidders are required to supply services at project site Party has to submit GST registration No. of the State in which project site is located along with copy of registration certificate at the time of submission of Bid. In case the same is not available at the time of submission of bid, the contractor has to give an undertaking that the same will be arranged before award of Work Order.
 2. HSN Code/SAC, rate of tax under GST and applicable GST (IGST, CGST/SGST/UTGST) and GSTIN shall be clearly mentioned by the bidder.
 - 3. GST portion of the invoice shall be released only upon:-**
 - 3.1 All invoices raised by contractors/vendors must be GST complaint Tax invoice as per GST invoice rules.
 - 3.2 Contractor declaring such invoices in his GSTR-1 or any modified returned as notified by government.
 - 3.3 Receipt of goods/services and tax invoice by BHEL and
 - 3.4 Confirmation of payment of GST thereon by contractor on GSTN portal.
 - 3.5 Alternatively, contractor has to submit BG of appropriate value which shall be valid at least one month after the confirmation of date of payment of GST by contractor on GST portal and receipt of tax invoice and receipt of services, whichever is later. Contractor has to give an undertaking in this regard.
 - 3.6 Contractor has to give an undertaking to BHEL that they have declared invoice in his return and paying GST within time line prescribed for availing ITC by BHEL.

Payment to contractor for GST portion will be released only after completion of above activity and on availment of ITC by BHEL.

4. In case GST credit is delayed/denied to BHEL due to **non/delayed receipt of services/goods and /or tax invoice** or expiry of the time line prescribed in GST law for availing such ITC, or any other reason not attributable to BHEL, GST amount shall be recoverable form the contractor along with the interest levied/leviable on BHEL.

Reverse Charge under GST

- 5A. In respect of services, reserve charge liability shall arise at the earliest of date of payment to services provider or 60 days from the date of issue of invoice by service provide. Contractor has to submit bill for payment within 30 days from the date of invoice. Any interest or penalty implications attributable to the contractor shall be recovered from them.
- 5B. Any GST liability arising on BHEL under reverse charge before actual receipt of goods and/or invoice thereof would be subject to recovery of interest leviable for the period between the date of such liability and actual date of eligibility of ITC based on receipt of goods, receipt of invoices and other condition specified in GST law.

Liquidated Damage/Penalty

6. Liquidated Damage (LD) or penalty if chargeable from suppliers/contractors as per NIT, applicable GST will be charged in addition to the same.

Tax deduction at source

7. TDS as per extent provisions of the GST law shall be deducted from supplier/contractor bill

Annexure – V

Subject : 75 Nos. Digital Plain Paper Copier (B&W) Machines on Rental Basis

General Terms and Conditions of the contract

Contractor's Labour/Worker while working inside:

The contractor shall engage sufficient staff to ensure the Workmanship quality to the degree specified in the contract.

1.0 Nuisance: The contractor shall not any time do, cause or permit any nuisance on the work site or do anything shall cause unnecessary disturbance or inconvenience to other workers.

2.0 Work Insurance: Contractor shall insure their men as per the workman's compensation act.

3.0 Work to be carried out:

3.1 The work to be carried out under the contract shall except as otherwise provided in these conditions, include all labour ,replacement of parts and supply of consumables except paper which may be required for full and entire execution and completion of the work.

3.2 The contractor shall have his own tools & tackles, Instruments, consumables etc. required for the execution of work.

3.3 **Successful vendor will ensure to stock all the spares, and other consumables at Bhopal local office and also post suitable numbers of well trained service engineers for giving regular service call with in 2 (two) hours of the complain made.**

4.0 Work during the Night, Weekly off and Holidays:

The normal working shift hours of the plant is **7.00 AM to 4.00 PM**, but the contractor's person may be required to work beyond the normal working shift. Work may be carried out during night, factory weekly off and public holidays, with the prior written permission of Engineer-in-charge.

5.0 Security Deposit: No Security deposit is required during the Contract Period.

6.0 Cancellation/Termination of contract in full or part :

If the contractor;

6.1 Any Time make default in proceeding with the work with diligence and continues to do so after a notice in writing of 7(seven) days from Engineer-In-Charge, or

6.2 Commits default in complying with any of the terms conditions of the contract and does not remedy it or take effective steps to remedy it within 7(seven) days after a notice in writing is given by Engineer-in-charge in that behalf, or

6.3 Shall after or give or agree to give to any person in M/s. BHEL, Bhopal services or to any other person on his behalf any gift or consideration of any kind as on inducement or reward for doing or for bearing to do or for having done or for borne to do any act in relation to the obtaining or execution of this or any other contract for the Company/Corporation.

6.4 Without prejudice to the aforesaid clause, BHEL can terminate the contract by **assigning no reason thereof** by giving 30 days notice in writing in advance.

6.5 BHEL reserves the right to revoke the contract at any time and at any stage, if it is found that the complaints are not properly attended or there is deliberate negligence from contractor's part or any other reasons whatsoever.

6.6 **Safety Liability:** The Contractor shall arrange safety provisions at his own expense. All safety measures shall be observed while carrying the job assigned. Contractor shall supply all the required personal protective equipments. In case of non-compliance of safety rules, while executing the work, the work order will be cancelled.

6.7 The cancellation of contract may be either for whole or part of the contract at BHEL's option. In the event of termination of contract in whole or part BHEL may procure upon such terms and in such manner as deemed appropriate, supplies or services similar to those so terminated and the contractor shall be liable to BHEL for any excess costs for such similar supplies or services provided that the contractor shall continue the performance of this contract to the extent not terminated under the provisions of this clause.

7.0 **Statutory Liability**

7.1 All statutory requirements under Minimum Wages Act, 1948, Payment of Wages Act, 1936, Workmen Compensation Act, 1923, EPF & MP Act, 1952, Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, ESI Act, 1948, The Contract Labour (R&A) Act, 1970, Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, Income Tax Act, Service Tax Act and all other applicable Acts shall be complied with by the contractor.

7.2 Contractor shall comply with all statutory requirements, rules, regulations, notifications in relation to employment of his employees issued from time to time by the concerned authorities.

7.3 Contractor to provide PF pass book to his employees and ensure payment of PF, EDLI, pension dues under EPF & MP Act, 1952 to the RPFC.

7.4 Contractor shall ensure payment of ESI contribution under ESI Act, 1948 and provide ESI membership No./card of each employee.

7.5 Contractor shall produce proof of deductions as well as remittances of PF, EDLI, Pension, ESI contribution, administrative charges etc. wherever applicable and shall maintain proper records. Contractor to issue wage slips to his employees.

7.6 Contractor shall furnish proper returns to the concerned statutory authorities and provide a copy of the same to BHEL.

7.7 Contractor shall indemnify BHEL against all claims and losses under various Labour Laws, statutes or any civil or criminal law in connection with employees deployed by him.

7.8 The liability for any compensation on account of injury sustained by an employee of the contractor will be exclusively that of the contractor.

7.9 Contractor to obtain insurance cover for his employees / equipment / tools and tackles etc and take third party risk insurance coverage at his own cost. BHEL shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, pilferage of his property and / or his employees.

7.10 Contractor should have independent code numbers/ exemptions under EPF & MP Act, 1952 and ESI Act, 1948 and shall cover his employees under the said codes.

8.0 **Arbitration and Law:**

All disputes arising in connection with the contract shall be settled by mutual consultation. If no agreement is reached the dispute shall be settled in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and the rules made there under. The dispute shall be referred for arbitration to any arbitrator to be appointed by the Head of the Unit. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the Parties. The venue of the Arbitration shall be Bhopal in India. The Award to be given by the Arbitration shall be a speaking award. All questions, disputes, differences arising under, out of or in connection with this contract shall be to the exclusive jurisdiction of Bhopal Courts.

9.0 **Jurisdiction** : The jurisdiction in all cases shall be at Bhopal alone.
