These bidders can avail EMD Waiver benefits only if they submit in EMD cover along with the offer, attested copies of either valid EM-II Certificate (five years from the date of issue of acknowledgement in EM-II or else, with attested copy of a CA Certificate in Enclosed Format) or MSE (UAN- along with CA certificate in attached format)/ valid NSIC / SSI certificate.

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- 3.Required assistance for removal and rebuilding of refractory materials will be provided by BHEL free of cost.
- 4.All consumables like welding electrode, oxygen, acetylene Gas, Aluminium paint, Red oxide, enamel paint, grease, grinding wheel, wire brush, paint brush, compressed air, Electricity, etc. will be provided by BHEL free of cost.
- 5.Contractor should bring Cutting set, welding holder, Tools & Tackles required for this work with proper gate entry. Welding set will be provided by BHEL free of cost.
- 6. Hand trolley for material movement will be provided by BHEL free of cost.
- 7.Contractor should engage sufficient & skilled manpower so that the work shall be completed in a short duration as per the plan of MMO Supervisor.
- 8.All the movement of raw materials to be done by the contractor.
- 9. The scraps and debris formed during execution of work should be moved to respective waste bins and the execution area near the furnace should be cleaned before handing over the furnace.
- 10. Contractor should adhere to all the Safety precautions.

Safety belt will be provided by BHEL free of cost on returnable basis for working at height. Work permit should be obtained from safety dept for height works.

11.Contractor should be able to carry out the work immediately within a short notice of one day.

Contractor must deploy manpower in suitable shifts (Both day and night shifts) so that the work should be carried out on 24 hrs basis.

12. Contractor may visit the Furnace through executive / Supervisor /MMO B1 & B50 before quoting to assess the quantum of work.

NOTE:

- 1) The contract will be given for item 20 to 50 together to one contractor as the works are interrelated for which combined L1 will be taken in to consideration.
- 2)Other activities will be given to respective L1 Offerers.



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GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR M&S MECHANICAL CONTRACTS

1) SAFETY:

- a) Safety precautions have to be ensured by the Contractor Depending on the work. Necessary work permit system and personal protective equipment's (PPE) such as electrical resistance rubber gloves, helmet, spectacle goggles, safety shoes, safety belt, etc. as applicable to Mechanical works should be adhered while carrying out the work.
- b) PPES for appropriate trade job has to be ensured by the contractor at the job site at all times.
- c) The work nature may demand working at heights and/or at depth areas. Hence all staff members must be of sound Physical and Mental Health who can complete the job without harming himself and others.
- d) In case any employee found incompetent to carry out the work as stated above/ misbehaving others/ consumed alcohol, he shall be sent out of the factory and the contractor has to arrange alternate manpower immediately. Else the day shall be marked absent.
- 2) Before quoting the bidders may inspect the site of work and its environments and be well acquainted with the actual working and other relevant conditions, position of materials and labour. Tenderers are also requested to go through General -Terms & conditions, Special -Terms & conditions of Contract, Scope of work, Technical Terms & Conditions, drawings and specifications and all other documents which form part of the agreement to be entered into.

3) TENDERING CONDITIONS:

- a) The Bidders shall submit the offer in TWO PART BID SYSTEM (Part -I & II) along with EMD as indicated below which shall be sealed in ONE OUTER ENVELOPE.
- b) Envelope I- This sealed envelope should contain all the copies of technical bid together with un-priced commercial bid. This envelope should be clearly marked "Part I - Technical and commercial bid", indicating Enquiry No., Due Date and Address & Reference of the Bidder. The Contractor shall at his own expense reinstate and make good to the satisfaction of the respective area HOD and pay compensation for any injury, loss or damage occurred to any property or rights whatever including property and rights of BHEL (or agents) servants or employee of BHEL, the injury loss or damage arising out of or in any way in connection with the execution or purported execution of the contract and further the contractor shall indemnify BHEL against all claims enforceable against BHEL (or any agent, servant or employee of BHEL) or which would be so enforceable against BHEL, in respect of any such injury (including injury resulting in death) loss or damage to any person whomsoever or property including all claims which may arise under the Employees Compensation Act or

"BHEL shall recover the amount of compensation paid to victim(s) by BHEL towards loss of life / permanent disability due to an accident which is attributable to the negligence of contractor, agency or firm or any of its employees as detailed below.

- (b) The Arbitrator shall pass a reasoned award and the award of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding upon the
- (c)Subject as aforesaid, the provision of Arbitration & Conciliation Act 1996 (India) or statutory modification or reenactment thereof and the rules made thereunder and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceeding under this clause. The seat of arbitration shall be Trichy, Tamil Nadu.
- (d)The cost of arbitration shall be borne as per the award of the Arbitrator.

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(e)Subject to arbitration in terms of clause 28 above, the Courts at Trichy Tamil Nadu shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any matter arising out of or in connection with this Agreement.

(f)Notwithstanding the existence or any dispute or difference and/or reference for the arbitration, the Contractor shall proceed with and continue without hindrance the performance of its obligation under this Contract with due diligence and expedition in a professional manner except where the Contract has been terminated by either Party in terms of this Contract.

In case of contract with Public Sector Enterprises (PSE) or a Government Department, the following shall be applicable

In the event of any dispute or difference relating to the interpretation and application of the provisions of the Contract, such dispute or difference shall be referred by either Party for arbitration to the sole arbitrator in the Department of Public Enterprises to be nominated by the Secretary to the Government of India in-charge of the Department of Public Enterprises. The Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 shall not be applicable to arbitration under this clause. The award of the arbitrator shall be binding upon the Parties to the dispute, provided, however, any Party aggrieved by such award may make further reference for setting aside or revision of the award to the Law Secretary, Department of Legal Affairs, Ministry of Law and Justice, Government of India. Upon such reference the dispute shall be decided by the Law Secretary or the Special Secretary or Additional Secretary when so authorized by the Law Secretary, whose decision shall bind the Parties hereto finally and conclusively. The Parties to the dispute will share equally the cost of arbitration as intimated by the Arbitrator.

15.PAYMENT THROUGH BANK:-

17. Force Majeure Clause:

If, at any time during the continuance of this Contract the performance in whole or in part by either party of any obligations under this Contract shall be prevented or delayed by reason of any War, Hostile acts of the public enemy Civil Commotion, Epidemics, or Acts of God (Floods, Storm/Cyclone, Hurricane, Earthquake etc.) then provided notice of happening of any such event is given by either party to other within 7 days from the date of occurrence thereof neither of the parties shall by reason of such event be entitled to terminate this Contract or claim for damages against the other in respect of such non-performance or delay for such period. Performance under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such event has come to an end or ceased to exist. If the performance in whole or part of any obligation under this Contract is prevented or delayed by reason of any such event, claims for extension of time may be granted for periods considered reasonable by the respective area HOD at his discretion subject to prompt notification by the contractor.

18.IMPORTANT NOTE:

BHEL reserves the right to short close this work with one-month advance notice due to administrative reasons. BHEL's decision in this regard is final. Under such circumstances payment will be made for on pro rata basis for the service rendered out up to the period.
