FORFEITURE OF PRFORMANCE SECURITY/SECURITY DEPOSIT:

The security deposit will be forfeited and credited to BHEL's account in the event of a breach of contract by the supplier.

RELEASE OF SECURITY DEPOSIT:

Performance Security should be refunded to the contractor without interest, after he duly performs and completes the contract in all respects but not later than 60(sixty) days of completion of all such obligations including the warranty under the contract.

CONFLICT OF INTEREST:

"A bidder shall not have conflict of interest with other bidders. Such conflict of interest can lead to anticompetitive practices to the detriment of Procuring Entity's interests. The bidder found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. A bidder may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:

- a) they have controlling partner (s) in common; or
- b) they receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy/ financial stake from any of them; or
- c) they have the same legal representative/agent for purposes of this bid; or
- d) they have relationship with each other, directly or through common third parties, that puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the bid of another Bidder; or
- e) Bidder participates in more than one bid in this bidding process. Participation by a Bidder in more than one Bid will result in the disqualification of all bids in which the parties are involved. However, this does not limit the inclusion of the components/ sub-assembly/ Assemblies from one bidding manufacturer in more than one bid, or
- f) In cases of agents quoting in offshore procurements, on behalf of their principal manufacturers, one agent cannot represent two manufacturers or quote on their behalf in a particular tender enquiry.

One manufacturer can also authorize only one agent/dealer. There can be only one bid from the following:

- 1. The principal manufacturer directly or through one Indian agent on his behalf; and
- 2. Indian/foreign agent on behalf of only one principal,

- b) Balance amount (if value of security instruments is less than 10% of the contract value) from other financial remedies i.e. available bills of the vendor, retention amount etc. with BHEL.
- c) Balance amount from security instrument like EMD, Performance Security and other financial remedies i.e. available bills of the vendor, retention amount etc. with other units of BHEL.
- d) If Recovery is not possible then Legal Remedies shall be pursued.

EVALUATION IN CASE OF MORE THAN ONE BIDDER OCCUPY L1 STATUS:

In the course of evaluation, if more than one bidder happens to occupy L-1 status, effective L-1 will be

decided by soliciting discounts from the respective L-1 bidders.

Vendor should survey properly before submitting the bid and bid the optimized solution in compliance of specification, which will stable, durable and economic in nature are able to cater the specified service level agreement (SLA) for uptime of the system. The integration of all active devices is/are with vendor scope. Power will be provided up to a certain point, afterwards power cable to be arranged by vendor and as per site norms.

Common data back bone is under establishment at site. All the IP based device will use the backbone for intercommunication and communication with central control room. The data backbone specification kept under some other contract scope is as below.

RF based/ Fibre based hybrid network backbone with 3 base station at strategic location and RF link to CCTV PTZ camera location. Pole shall be illumination pole / CCTV camera pole. Power to be tagged from CCTV JB Box (UPS) or illumination pole.

Vendor to connect their IP PA loudspeaker with the specified backbone. Necessary accessories required to connect with backbone is to be consider by the vendor in their scope. Vendor to consider some P2P link / Cat-6 patch cord etc. in lump sum scope. If backbone tapping point is Non-POE, then POE injector or small POE S/W required to be arranged.

Insurance:

It is the sole responsibility of the contractor to insure his materials, equipment, workmen etc. against accidents and injury while at work and to pay compensation, if any, to workmen as per Workmen's Compensation Act. The work will be carried out in a protected area and all the rules and regulations of the client / BHEL in the area of project which are in force from time to time will have to be followed by the contractor.

General Requirements:

- 1. All the required casing / conduits/ cable trays, power packs, erection hardware (viz. junction boxes, brackets, glands, nut-bolts etc.) are included in the bidder's scope.
- 2. The bidder shall guarantee satisfactory performance of the equipment under stipulated variations of voltage and frequency.

- 8. Supplied items are to be brand new.
- 9. Loading/Unloading, Storage, Transportation of Material within Project Premises is in Vendor's Scope. However, Storage Space for Material will be provided by BHEL free of Cost.
- 10. The Bidder Shall Guarantee Satisfactory Performance of the Equipment under Stipulated Variations of Voltage and Frequency.

Special Terms & Conditions:

- 1. Non-Disclosure Agreement: The selected bidder after placement of work order and prior to commencement of work must sign the Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) as per the format specified by BHEL or any other as mutually agreed.
- 2. Agency shall coordinate with various stakeholders including BHEL, its sub-agencies and BHEL/NTPC/DVC (customer), wherever required to execute the contract.
- 3. Agency has to arrange for Personal Protective Equipment (PPEs) for safety of its staff and workmen for site visits.
- 4. Agencies shall make their own arrangements of accommodation, local transportation and logistics such as Computers/laptops /printers/stationary etc. to execute the scope of work.
- 5. All Statutory Compliance (issued by GOI as applicable) for execution of the scope of work, shall be in the scope of Agency. No Extra charges shall be made against any statutory compliance.
- 6. No extra payment shall be made for any work executed on Sunday/holidays or beyond official working hours.
- 7. All the software/license procurement, installation for connection/integration to BHEL/ NTPC/DVC (customer) systems shall be in scope of agency.
