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AMENDMENT -01 to NIT No. 12110

Ref: Tender Spec No: TBSM/AURANGABAD/ETC/TENDER, Dated 20.06.12

With reference to above tender for " Receipt of equipment/ material at site, unloading, inspection, verification, storage, up-keeping during storage, erection, testing, commissioning and handing over of 400/220kV Aurangabad (new) substation, extension of 400kV Aurangabad (MSETCL) substation and extension of 400kV Wardha substation associated with Mundra regional system for WR" following amendments may please be noted:

1. Scope of ETC works of extension of 400kV Wardha substation is being deleted from the NIT. Now ETC works of 400/220kV Aurangabad (New) and extension of 400kV Aurangabad (MSETCL) only are in the scope of the contractor.
2. Revised Bill of Quantities and PQR are attached.
3. The Clause No. A "Overrun Compensation" of Annexure to General Conditions of contract for ETC works stands deleted. Now this clause shall be read as below:

Over-run compensation- If the contract is extended beyond the contract period (including grace period) for any reason (including due to extra work/additional quantity) other than those attributable to the contractor or force majeure conditions, the contractor will be compensated by payment of over-run charges at the rate of 0.2 percent (point two percent) of the executed contract value per month after the expiry of grace period.

The over run compensation will be payable for the eligible period of time extension on account of reasons attributable to BHEL only. No over run will be payable for the extension on account of reasons attributable to contractor and/or force majeure conditions.

Part of Extension attributable to the contractor, if any, in total contract extension shall be exhausted first i.e. immediately after end of grace period. This shall be followed by Extension on account of force majeure conditions, if any and lastly on account of BHEL. The compensation will be payable for the extended eligible period in months and days as applicable.

Any compensation paid to the contractor against over run charges during the eligible extended period of the project will be recovered from the contractor or any payment on this account payable to the contractor will be cancelled if further extension is required due to the reasons attributable to the contractor or situation of risk & cost arises due to failure of the contractor to complete the work.

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If the delay is attributable to the contractor LD will be imposed as per the provision in the contract.

Total Over Run Compensation shall be limited to 10% of the executed contract value as certified in Final Bill. For this purpose executed contract value excludes PVC, ORC, Supplementary/ Additional Items and Extra Works done.

Grace period- The grace period will be defined in the Tender Document based on the calculation as one month for every six month (or part thereof) of the contract period. The prices quoted by the contractor will remain firm till the contract period plus the grace period including extended period if any.

4. In view of revised scope of work the documents related to extension of 400kV Wardha substation in the NIT should not be referred.

Important Notes

- Bidders are required to quote as per revised BOQ for ETC works & Cable glands (Rev.01) for Aurangabad (New) & Aurangabad (MSETCL).
- NIT for extension of 400kV Wardha substation is floated separately.
- **The bidders shall note that the tenders for ETC works of Aurangabad & Wardha substations are being floated simultaneously. In case the bidder submits offers for both the tenders and is awarded the contract for one of the tenders then his offer for second tender will not be considered for reverse auction/price bid opening/ award of contract.**
- All other terms & conditions of the tender specifications remain unchanged

REVISED PRE-QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS

SUB: RECEIPT OF EQUIPMENT/ MATERIAL AT SITE, UNLOADING, INSPECTION, VERIFICATION, STORAGE, UP-KEEPING DURING STORAGE, ERECTION, TESTING, COMMISSIONING AND HANDING OVER OF 400 / 220 KV AURANGABAD (NEW) SUBSTATION AND EXTENSION OF 400KV AURANGABAD (MSETCL) SUBSTATION ASSOCIATED WITH MUNDRA REGIONAL SYSTEM FOR WR.

Sealed Tenders (Under two part Bid system) are invited from competent ETC contractors for Receipt of equipment/ material at site, unloading, inspection, verification, storage, up-keeping during storage, erection, testing, commissioning and handing over of 400/220kV Aurangabad (new) substation and extension of 400kV Aurangabad (MSETCL) substation associated with Mundra regional system for WR. Only those who are technically and financially capable to execute the Job and who fulfil the Pre-Qualifying requirements [PQR] given under are eligible to quote against the above NIT. Tenderers should submit their offer in a sealed envelope as per the procedure specified in tender documents. The minimum PQR of contractor for tender submission shall be as under:

- a) Vendors should have a minimum average annual turnover of **Rs. 60 lacs** for last three financial years ending on 31.03.11 and should submit balance sheet and Profit & Loss Account for last three years (2008-09, 2009-10 & 2010-11).
- b) Vendor should have successfully executed similar job (ref note below) during last seven years ending 30.04.12. Vendor should produce certification/proof in support of execution/ executing similar package from user/end user and should be either of the following:
 - i. **Three similar jobs executed costing (except service tax) not less than Rs. 80 lacs each.**
OR
 - ii. **Two similar jobs executed costing (except service tax) not less than Rs. 100 lacs each.**
OR
 - iii. **One similar job executed costing (except service tax) not less than Rs. 155 lacs each.**
- c) Vendor should have earned profit in at least one year during last three financial years (2008-09, 2009-10 & 2010-11)
- d) The contractor should meet the minimum QR for T&P and testing equipments as per Annexure-I.

NOTE:

- 1. Similar job shall mean: Bidder should have successfully executed erection, testing and commissioning of complete substation of 220 kV rating and above.
- 2. For the similar job the word 'executed' means the bidder should have achieved the criteria specified in the PQR even if the total contract has not been completed or closed.

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3. Quotations received from bidders who do not fulfil the PQR are liable to be rejected without any further evaluation and information to bidders.
4. BHEL reserves the right to:
 - (a) Accept or reject any bid received at its discretion without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
 - (b) Postpone the above mentioned date, split and distribute the work among more than one bidder without assigning any reason whatsoever.
 - (c) May ask for further qualification during techno commercial scrutiny of bids received.
5. BHEL shall not be responsible for any delay, loss, damage for bids sent by post.
6. BHEL shall not be liable for any expenses incurred by bidder in preparation of bid irrespective of whether it is accepted or not.
7. Canvassing i.e. soliciting favour, seeking advantage etc. in any form is strictly prohibited and any bidder found to have engaged in canvassing shall be liable to have his bid rejected summarily.
8. If the bidder deliberately gives any wrong information in his tender to create in circumstances for the acceptance to his bid, BHEL reserves the right to reject such application.
9. Bidder's selection is subject to approval of BHEL's customer for this work.
10. All corrigendum, addendum, amendments and clarifications to this Tender will be hosted in web page, www.bhel.com and not in the newspaper. Bidders shall keep themselves updated with all such amendments.

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
