	Bidders must submit performance certificate for satisfactory execution of contracts from minimum three customers for “container ocean freighting to/from India” for work executed in last three years (ending last day of month previous to one in which tender was due for opening). Clarification for MSME suppliers: MSE suppliers can avail the intended benefits only if they submit along with the offer, attested copies of either EM II certificate having deemed validity (5 years from the date of issue of acknowledgement in EM II) or valid NSIC certificate or EM II certificate along with attested copy of CA certificate (format enclosed as per Annexure I where deemed validity of EM II certificate of 5 years has expired) applicable for the relevant financial year (latest audited). Date to be reckoned for determining the deemed validity will be the date of bid opening (Part I incase of 2 part bid). Non submission of such documents will lead to consideration of their bids at par with other bidders. No benefits shall be applicable for this enquiry if any deficiency in the above required documents are not submitted before price bid opening. If the tender is to be submitted through e-Procurement Portal, then the above required documents are to be uploaded on the portal. Documents should be notarized or attested by Gazetted officer.

Clarification for Clause I (a) of Section III (Turnover Criteria):

Parties must submit the turnover details related to ocean freighting of containers only.
