01	Price: Supplier shall be quoted on " FIRM PRICE " basis only. No price variation clause will be entertained.		
02	Terms of Delivery:		
(a)	Indigenous Supplies : FOR - Destination means FOR - BHEL Stores, Ranipet [Packing & Forwarding, Freight & Insurance are in Supplier's scope i.e. included in the quoted prices. Materials to be dispatched through BHEL approved carriers freight pre-paid]. The list of approved carriers will be attached along with Purchase Order. In case our approved carriers are not available, after prior permission goods can be despatched through other than approved carriers.		
(b)	Foreign Supplies : FOB / FCA basis inclusive of SEA / AIR-worthy packing and inclusive of all charges till FOB / FCA. Freight charges up to Chennai Port may also be quoted separately. Normally BHEL would place order on FOB basis and shipment is to be done thro' nominated freight forwarder of BHEL as per terms & conditions of agreement between BHEL and its freight forwarder. However, if so required BHEL may place order on C&F basis also.		
03	Delivery Period: To mention clearly the exact delivery period as it attracts contractual penalty on delays through penalty clause. To be indicated in weeks from date of receipt of Letter of Intent (LoI)		
04	Penalty: Supplier should quote a definite delivery period and any delay in delivery beyond the P.O delivery date will attract Penalty of 0.5% per week subject to a max. of 10% of order value. The vendor should quote only confirmed delivery. Please note that confirmed delivery indicated includes the approval of drawings, Data sheet, Quality plan etc. as applicable. (Date of despatch is considered for calculating penalty). Date of despatch will be reckoned as the date of delivery for the supply of equipment. Loading Factor for non-acceptance of Penalty Clause: Will attract maximum 10% loading on the offer and accordingly proportionate percentage will be loaded for accepting lesser percentage of penalty clause. Example : If the Supplier has accepted for maximum 5% penalty clause, then balance 5% will be loaded for evaluating lowest bidder.		
05	Payment Terms: Offer with deviations to BHEL Payment Terms will be loaded at the Base Rate of SBI + 2% for the period of relaxation sought by bidder for deviated amount for the purpose of evaluating the lowest bidder. Offers with advance payment are liable to be rejected. In no case BHEL shall accept liability towards any interest payments.		
(a)	Terms of payment for Indigenous Offer: Dispatch of Goods on door delivery basis only. Goods dispatched with documents presented through Bank is not preferred by BHEL . Payment through Electronic Fund Transfer mode only.		
(i)	80% payment will be made within 45 days after successful completion of supply, installation and commissioning subject to submission & acceptance of Operative Performance Bank Guarantee for 10% of contract value. 10% of the contract value will be paid within 45 days at the end of second year. Balance 10% of the contract value will be paid within 45 days at the end of third year.		
(ii)	In case if there is NO Erection/Installation and Commissioning involved for the item the following payment term would be considered. 100% payment within 45 days from the date of acceptance of the materials by BHEL at BHEL Ranipet.	Not Applicable	
06	Guarantee Period: Refer Technical Specification Annexure. Ref. BAP:IC:TS:PAC001. Non acceptance of Guarantee Period / lesser period than specified: Will attract disqualification of the offer.		
07	Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG): The Supplier shall submit a PBG for 10% of the contract value or acceptance for retaining 10% of contract value by BHEL in lieu of PBG valid for the agreed Guarantee period (Three years).

	Bank Guarantee (PBG) shall be in the prescribed form given by BHEL and it is to be obtained from the list of bankers provided by BHEL. Supplier shall affix Non-Judicial Stamp as per stamp act on the BG form to be sent by BHEL along with Purchase Order.		
	Bank Guarantee (PBG) from foreign suppliers should be in the prescribed form given by BHEL from any Bank of international repute. The bank guarantee is to be confirmed by any of the approved Banks of BHEL. All bank charges towards this will be to the account of supplier only. No extra charges will be payable by BHEL on this account.		
	Non acceptance of Performance Bank Guarantee / retention of 10% of contract value by BHEL or acceptance of a PBG with lesser percentage or lesser period than specified: Will attract disqualification of the offer.		
08	Erection & Commissioning (E & C) Charges: Supplier to specify clearly the E & C Charges. Service tax shall be extra as applicable. Requirement of technical specification needs to be complied with.		
09	Essential / Mandatory Spares (Refer specification / Annexure): Refer Technical Specification Annexure. Ref. BAP:IC:TS:PAC001.		
10	Validity: Supplier to mention clearly the validity date of the offer. [Minimum 180 days from the technical bid opening date]		
11	Risk Purchase: Supplier specific confirmation is required for this clause - The purchaser at his option will be entitled to terminate the contract and to purchase elsewhere at the risk and cost of the seller either the whole of the goods or any part which the supplier has failed to deliver or despatch within the time stipulated as aforesaid or if the same were not available, the best and the nearest available substitute therefor. The supplier shall be liable for any loss which the purchaser may sustain by reason of such risk purchases in addition to penalty at the rate mentioned in "Penalty" clause.		
12	Reverse Auction (R/A) / Bidding through Internet: BHEL will usually finalise the purchase of capital items thro' R.A (Reverse Auction). The R.A will be conducted by the service provider nominated by BHEL for this purpose. However, BHEL reserves the right to waive the requirement of R.A and proceed with tender opening based on the sealed bid offers received. In such cases, information would be given to the bidders by BHEL prior to price bid opening. Hence, in their own interest all bidders are required to submit their best competitive bid in the first instance in the sealed cover.

14	Excise duty in % (for Indigenous supplier): To be indicated by supplier. ED invoice is required for availing Cenvat benefit		
(ii)	Sales tax in % (for Indigenous supplier): VAT / CST to be indicated by the supplier.

15	Income Tax : Wherever applicable income tax shall be deducted at source as per the rules and regulations of the Government of India. Necessary Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) certificate will be issued by BHEL for which supplier shall indicate Permanent Account Number (PAN).		
16	Test Certificate: To be submitted.		
17	O & M Manual: 3 sets in English language.		
18	Training: Supplier's scope at no extra cost. Wherever required training shall be given by the supplier at no extra cost either at suppliers works or at BHEL works or both. The number of mandays of training required is given seperately along with technical specification. After completion of training, necessary training completion certificate shall be obtained by the vendor from concerned BHEL authorities.		
19	Pre-Despatch Inspection (PDI): BHEL will have the option to pre-inspect the machine / equipment at Supplier's works by BHEL's own inspector or by third party agency appointed by BHEL before despatch..Inspection call for carrying out the inspection shall be given 30 days before for foreign supplies and 15 days before for indigenous supplies from the scheduled contract delivery date. However final inspection for acceptance will be carried out at BHEL's works at Ranipet.
