In case of downloading the tender documents from BHEL website, the prospective bidder has to submit the duly filled up Preliminary Registration Form immediately. Preliminary Registration Form is enclosed herein.
- 2 | Cover I : DEMAND DRAFT [D.D.] & TECHNICAL BID:(Part-I)

D.D. for Rs. 5000/- in favour of M/s. Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd., Ramachandrapuram, Hyderabad - 502 032 for value of tender document, if called for, along with a covering letter. This D.D. is non-refundable. In cas any bidder purchases bid documents from BHEL, Hyderabad, then xerox copy of DD to be submitted and complete technical details, catalogus, drawings and all commercial terms excluding the price. 3 | Cover - II (Part-II) : PRICE BID

- (a) Prices are to be indicated as per Un-Priced Bid as well as in conformity with terms as submitted in Part-I. Bidders are required to quote as per enclosed formats (Price Format & Split Values Format). All applicable taxes and duties are to be indicated clearly in the offer. Tender evaluation shall be done based on landed (FOR DESTINATION) price basis. Processing of any optional item is at the discretion of BHEL. **Offer with any preconditions for price will be rejected.**
- (b) The bidders should submit their best price at this stage itself. They will not be allowed to revise the price. However due to any Techno-Commercial Changes during technical freezing of offers only IMPACT PRICE to Originally quoted price will be allowed for which impact price format will be furnished to the bidders before price bid opening. In exceptional case revised price bid may be invited at the discretion of BHEL due to major changes.

B GUIDELINES:

- If a Supplier is not interested to participate in a tender for which enquiry was either forwarded or purchased by them, it has to submit a "REGRET LETTER" before opening date. If not complied, the concerned Supplier may not be considered for future requirements.

- 6 BHEL reserves its right to reject / load any offer which is having deviations to BHEL Specifications, Standard Terms & Conditions.
- 7 All the bidders are to submit their offers by filling in the format of the BHEL tender documents.
- 8 Tenders should be duly signed and stamped and free from Corrections and Erasures. Corrections, if any, must be attested.
- 9 Tenderers are to know the applicable laws of Government of India and applicable taxes and duties.
- 10 In case of price bid, price break-up should be in line with technical specification / scope of the tender.
- The equipment offered shall be strictly conforming to the specification and for complete unit including accessories (if any) and spares as per Tender.
- 12 Supplier (Applicable for Foreign Vendors only) shall bear the LC confirmation charges in case of seeking confirmed LC and also Bank charges outside India are to the suppliers account
- In case of L/C extension caused by delays, attributable to the Supplier (Applicable for Foreign Vendors only), the L/C extension charges are to be borne by the Supplier.

The date of supply should also be indicated. This is applicable unless specified otherwise in Technical
- 19 The Suppliers who have manufactured at least one equipment of same or higher size for similar applications in the past ten years and such equipment(s) is (are) working satisfactorily for at least 2 years after commissioning or as per Technical Specification are quilified to quote and should enclose a reference list and performance
- The quotation should be valid at least for a period of 90 days from the tender opening date. Price Variation Clause within this period will not be entertained.

- 21 The quotations including the price bids of technically qualified tenderers will not be returned back under any circumstances.

C BASIS OF EVALUATION OF LOWEST BIDDER:

- Evaluation of lowest bidder will be made considering the price of the basic equipment, erection and commissioning charges and Civil Works, FOB/FCA charges, applicable taxes and duties, applicable freight and insurance charges and charges associated with any other items / services mentioned specifically in the tender and also the effect loading factor. Optional items will not be considered for the purpose of evaluation unless or otherwise these are mentioned / communicated to the participating qualified Suppliers.
- For the purpose of comparing prices, tender prices shall be converted to Indian rupees and the conversion shall be made by using the Import Bills Rate (IMP Bills) (exchange) rate quoted by the official source (RBI) on the date of opening of tenders published in the same day newspapers, such as Economic Times, Financial Express, etc. This exchange rate will be followed till placement of order.
- 3 Placement of order will be considered only for lowest offer on Total Cost to BHEL basis.
- 4 The Purchase / Price preference to Government of India Undertakings shall be given as per the guide lines of Government.

D | TERMINATION CLAUSES:

- 1 BHEL has a right to cancel the order for delay in supply beyond penalty period without any monetary or legal obligations.
- 2 Obtaining the Export Licence, if required, is the responsibility of the Supplier. In case of delay in supplying the equipment in time, due to this reason, BHEL has a right to cancel the order without any monetary / legal obligation. To this extent Supplier has to give the undertaking and BHEL has a right to encash Bank Guarantee.

E INDIAN AGENT:

- The Supplier to furnish authenticated copy of the Agency Agreement with his agent detailing precise relationship between them and their mutual interest in the business so as to consider the offer of Indian Agent for indegenous portion of the supply along with techno-commercial bid. However the total responsibility arising out of this tender will be with the Principal Supplier only. For main equipment the offer should be from Principal / Original Equipment Manufacturer. BHEL prefers to deal with principal Suppliers directly.
- 2 The Supplier to furnish original authorisation letter for the Indian Agent. The letter should contain name, contact person, complete postal address including phone, fax and e-mail ID. It must spell out the type of services to be rendered by Indian Agent.

F SECURITY DEPOSIT:

The security deposit shall be for the due and faithful performance of the Contract and shall remain binding not withstanding such variations, alternations or extensions of time as may be made, given, conceded or agreed to between the Supplier / Vendor and BHEL under these Terms & Conditions or otherwise.

- The security deposit furnished by the tenderer will be subject to the terms and conditions of the Contract finally concluded between the parties and the BHEL will not be liable for payment of any interest on the security deposit or any depreciation thereof.
- 3 Non-acceptance of security deposit is liable to reject the offer. The successful bidder shall be required to furnish security deposit within two weeks of acceptance of his order.
- 4 The security deposit should be **5% of the contract value** by successful bidder as per proforma to be furnished after placement of order. The security deposit from foreign suppliers should be from any Bank of international repute. This is to be attested by Indian Embassy and to be registered in India. G PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE:

- 1 Performance Bank Guarantee should be as per proforma to be furnished after placement of order.
- 2 Performance Bank Guarantee of foreign supplier is to be attested by Indian Embassy and to be registered in India and to be kept valid for 18 months from the date of commissioning or 24 months from the date of supply.
- Performance bank guarantee shall be released on application by the Contractor after commissioning of the equipment and after he has discharged all his obligations under the Contract and produced a certificate from BHEL, certifying due completion of the work and submitted a "No Demand Certificate".
