2	Clause 3.1 (I) regarding 'similar work'	RFP condition shall prevail. For greater clarity, it may be noted that the 'Global Industry Classification Standard (GICS) 2018, S&P Global, MSCI' applies to all the three areas mentioned- energy, industrials, and/or utilities.
3	Tables for Annexure- 8, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 regarding the detail of project references for credentials as per Clause 4.1 and 4.2.1	'Name of the customer/s' and 'Work order ref.' may be sanitized if bound by confidentiality agreement. However, it shall be responsibility of the bidder to arrange interaction with such sanitized customers, as desired and selected by BHEL to satisfy the credentials.
4	Clause 4.2.1 (C-i & C-ii)	RFP condition shall prevail. For greater clarity, it may be noted that the collective experience of lead partner/ partners considered in the proposed team as mentioned in the bid shall be considered for evaluation.
5	Clause 5.4/ Engagement of experts	<i>Revised as</i> 'BHEL may seek expert opinion for validation of recommendations or any other work under the subject scope by the third party at any time, <i>however without disclosing consultant's name and/or trademark.</i> '

6	Clause 5.17/ Liabilities	Revised as 'The selected bidder shall be responsible for any financial losses, damages, liabilities arising out of any breach of contract or any other event attributable to the bidder's management of the contract. BHEL can recover all such losses but limited to the total contract value.'
7	5.12/ Conciliation & Arbitration	The arbitration shall be held as per Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory modification thereof. The last sentence under the paragraph 'Arbitration', 'The arbitration shall be conducted by a sole arbitrator to be appointed by BHEL Unit/ Division/ Business Group issuing the Contract within 45 days of receipt of the complete notice in terms of this Clause.' stands deleted.
