- 1- Tenders are invited on behalf of the BHARAT HEAVY ELECTRICAL LIMITED JHANSI for Work –**Maintenance of epoxy coating inside fy area**. The work is estimated to cost **Rs 3.59 Lakhs**. This estimate, however is given merely as a rough guide
- 2- SCOPE OF WORK :- Carry out maintenance of epoxy flooring inside factory premises. The work shall have to be done as and when required. The contractor will have to arrange material offer instruction received from Engineer- in- charge and carry out the work within the time given.
- 3- The tender shall be in the prescribed Form.
- 4- The works are required to be Carried out for a period of One Year from the fifteen days after the date on which the Engineer-in-charge issues written orders to commence the work or from the date of handing over of the site, whichever is later, in accordance with the phasing, if any , indicated by the Company/Corporation in the tender documents .the site is expected to be handed over on or about immediately
- 5- No two or more concerns in which an individual is interested as a Proprietor and /or a partner shall tender for the execution of the same works, if they dose all such tenders shall be liable to be rejected
- 6- The **DGM – Civil & Estate** shall be the Accepting Officer hereinafter refers to as such for the purpose of this contract.
- 7- Tender documents consisting of plans, specifications, Schedule (s) of quantity of the various classes of work to be done, the conditions of contract and other necessary documents will be open for inspection at factory civil office from **12/09/12 to 04/10/2012** between 9 am to 3 pm.
- 8- Tenderers are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and subsoil (so far as it is practicable), the form and nature of the site, the means of access to the site the accommodation they may be require and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks , contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or effect their tender. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site, whether he in specs it or not and no extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed.
- 9- Submission of a tender by a tenderer implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and of conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plants etc will be issued to him by the company corporation and local conditions & other factors bearing on the execution of the works .
- 10- A tendered should quote in figures as well as in word rate (s) tendered. The amounts for each item should be worked out and the requisite totals given. Special care in figures only in such a way that inter pole ration is not possible. The total amount shall be written both in figures and in words. In case of figures the words Rs should be written before the figure of rupees and the words. 'paisa' after the decimal figures e.g. Rs 2.15 and in case of words, the words 'Rupees' should precede and the words 'paisa' should be written at the end . Unless the rate is in whole rupees and followed by the word 'only ' it should invariably be upto two places of decimal.
- 11- The work shall be awarded to the overall lowest bidder. The quantities mentioned in the tender shall be used for comparative statement calculation and award of work. The actual quantities can vary during the course of the contract.

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- 12- Tenders shall be received at ADM security gate upto 13:15 hours on the **05/10/2012 (Friday)** and shall be **opened at 05/10/2012 (14:00)** hours on the same day in the presence of tenderers who may be present.
- 13- The tender shall be accompanied by earnest money ( unless exempted from depositing it ) of **Rs 10,000.00 (Ten thousand rupees only)** in BHEL cash receipt ( as permissible under Income Tax Act) pay order or Demand draft only in favour of BHEL Jhansi.
- 14- On acceptance of tender earnest money will be treated as part of the security if applicable.
- 15- Bharat Heavy Electrical Ltd. Jhansi will return the earnest money, where applicable, to every unsuccessful tenderer on the request of the tenderer and after award of work to now successful bidder.
- 16- A tenderer shall submit the tender which satisfies each and every essential condition laid down in this notice, failing which the tender will be liable to be rejected.
- 17- The Bharat Heavy Electrical Ltd. Jhansi reserve to themselves the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and tenderer shall be bound to perform the same at his quoted rates. The work is on labour basis.
- 18- Sales Tax or any other tax on materials in respect of this contract if applicable shall be payable by the contractor and the company /corporate will not entertain any claim whatsoever in this respect.
- 19- This notice of tender shall form part of the contract documents.
- 20- The contract may be awarded on overall lowest basis only.
- 21- Income Tax shall be recovered as per the applicable laws. Presently **income tax @ Rs 2% of gross value** of bill will be recovered from the contractor's bills.

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**QUALIFYING CRITERIA**

The work is specialized in nature which requires skilful workmanship & timely completion. All the following criteria will have to be met and documentary proof in support of the same to be submitted along with Techno Commercial Bid. Only those parties meeting the following criteria shall be eligible for opening of price bids. The decision of BHEL in this regards shall be final.

**(I) FINANCIAL**

- (1) The Bidder should have an Average Annual financial turn over during the last 3 years, ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2012 not less than **Rs. 1.08 Lakhs**.
  
- (2) The bidder should have the experience of successfully completing similar works during the last seven years ending 31.08.2012 amounting to values mentioned as under in a completed contract. ( running contract in a BHEL unit will acceptable along with certificate of satisfactory work performance from Engineer – in- Charge)
  - a) Three similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to **Rs. 1.44 lakhs**  
**Or**
  - b) Two similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to **Rs 1.80 lakhs**  
**Or**
  - c) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to **Rs 2.87 lakhs**

**Definition of similar work(s):** Epoxy flooring work on industrial floors.

- (3) The Bidder should possess PAN No, Service Tax Number (PAN based), TIN No. and submit a copy of the supporting documents along with tender documents.

**(II) HR and Legal**

- (1) The bidder is required to obtain PF registration, ESI registration and Central Labour License before start of work. If the bidder already has these documents, they must be submitted along with techno-commercial bid. If not, the bidder must submit affidavit of obtaining PF, ESI registrations and Central Labour License within 15 days of issue of Letter of Intent by the department. Work at site will be permitted only after all the above requirements are fulfilled and documents submitted to BHEL
  
- (2) The bidder must sign self declaration of compliance to all statutory and legal requirements of Appropriate Government and other Legal Authorities.
  
- (3) The bidder must submit self declaration of having never been blacklisted from any BHEL unit or any State / Central Government department / PSU
  
- (4) The bidder must submit self Certificate declaring the firm and its proprietor/partners/Directors has never been found guilty by a court for crimes of fraud , dishonesty or moral turpitude

**(III) Technical Proficiency**

- (1) The bidder must submit the list of tools, plants and machinery available with them
- (2) The bidder must submit the list of technical and skilled manpower available with them

**SCHEDULE "C"**

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT**

- 1- The BHEL General Conditions of contract shall an integral part of this contract. ( The BHEL General condition of contract may be seen in civil Office )
- 2- The Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) shall have overriding priority over General Conditions of Contract (GCC). Whenever there is any contradiction between the GCC and SCC, the SCC shall be treated as final.
- 3- The following General Conditions of Contract shall not be applicable; they shall be treated as deleted: 9(d), 34.A.2, 34.A.3, 34.A.4, 34.A.5, 34.A.6, 34.A.7, 34.A.8, 34.A.9, 34.A.10, 34.A.11, 34.A.12, 51.1 (b), 51.2, 51.3, 52.1, 53(b).2, 53(c), 53(d), 53(e), 53(e).1.
- 4- The contractor shall take necessary precautions for the safety of his workmen.
- 5- The contractor shall take proper care to avoid any damage to BHEL property. If any damage does take place, the contractor will be fully responsible for the same .The decision of Engineer in charge is such case shall be final and binding on contractor.
- 6- The contractor will follow all safety rules required in connection with execution of such type of works.
- 7- The contractor will have to get his workman insured at his cost. Work order will be issued on productions of this document to the deptt.
- 8- The contractor shall make his own arrangement for his residing the supervisor near by the township for execution/interest of work. If available the BHEL can provide the accommodation at commercial rent (electric charger and water charge extra) as per rule.
- 9- The Workman Compensation Act, its implications, licensing and liabilities of Minimum Wages Act will be entirely the responsibility of the contractor.
- 10- The workers should be trained enough for the work and should be engaged on approval of the engineer -in charge.
- 11- No minor worker will be allowed to work.
- 12- The contractor is advised to take insurance policy to cover accident risk under Workmen's Compensation Act in respect of workmen engaged by him.
- 13- The contractor shall be wholly responsible for the behavior of his workmen with the office staff and with the residents of the township.
- 14- Contractor will have to ensure that the work places are entirely cleaned
- 15- In case any time contractor fail to arrange the work BHEL will deduct the expenses to make alternate arrangement for the same.
- 16- Any **electric power** required for contractors' lighting/machinery for the purpose of work shall be supplied **FREE OF COST** by the company at the written request of the contractor at one point subject to the observance of rules an regulations of Electric board / company. If it is observed that power is being wasted, BHEL shall have the right to recover cost of such

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consumption including arrears. Power will **not** be allowed for **cooking** and **room (air) heating** in winter season: For this purpose, on written application chargeable power can be allowed. The rates shall be the rates applicable for industrial consumption in U.P.

**17- EXECUTION OF CONTRACT:**

- 18.1 The successful Tenderer's responsibility under this contract commences from the date of issue of the Letter of Intent by Bharat Heavy Electrical Limited. The successful tenderer shall be required to execute a contract in the "Prescribed form" as per GCC with BHEL within 15 days after the acceptance of his tender and in any case before the commencement of work. The expenses for completion and stamping and registration of the agreement with prescribed authority, if necessary shall be borne by the Contractor.
- 18.2 The contractor shall commence the work within the time indicated in the Letter of intent and shall proceed with the same with due expedition without delay.
- 18.3 If the successful tenderer fails to commence the work within the stipulated time, BHEL, at its sole discretion, will have the right to cancel the contract. His Earnest money and/or Security Deposit will stand forfeited without any further reference to him without prejudice to any and all of BHEL's other rights and remedies in this regard.
- 18.4 All the works shall be carried out under the direction and to the satisfaction of BHEL.
- 19- Work shall be carried through out work period (contract period) without interruptions due to any Sunday /holiday round the clock and contractor has to make suitable arrangement for the same without any extra compensation .
- 20- The contractor has to obtain registration no service tax code & account code etc from commission rate of central excise and service tax , Kanpur without which tender shall not be issued . He shall have to comply with the requirement of the commission ate .
- 21- The payment shall be made on the basis of measurement only as per unit given in schedule. The contractor or his supervisor /authorized person maintained a register and entry the work /measurement immediately and verified daily/after the work by BHEL supervisor .
- 22- MEASUREMENT OF WORK AND MODE OF PAYMENT
- 22.1 All payments will be made as per "Price Schedule" only after completion of that work. The same will be entered in measurement Book as running account (RA bill) & both the party will sign in that.
- 22.2 All recoveries due from the contractor for the month/period shall be affected in full from Corresponding running bills unless specific approval from competent authority is obtained to the contrary. The recoveries could be I.Tax, Stamp duty on S.D etc.
- 22.3 Measurement shall be restricted to that quantity for which it is required to ascertain the Financial liability of BHEL under this contract.
- 22.4 The contractor shall bear the expenditure involved if any, in meeting requirements. The contractor shall, provide all the assistance with appliances and other thing necessary for Measurement or re-measurement.
- 22.5 Passing of bills covered by such measurement does not amount to acceptance by BHEL of the completion of the work measured. Any left out work has to be completed by the Contractor, as directed.
- 22.6 Final measurement bill shall be prepared in the Performa prescribed for the purpose, based on the certificate issued by the Engineer that the entire work as

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Stipulated in the tender Specifications has been completed in all respect to the entire satisfaction of BHEL. The Contractor shall give unqualified 'No claim' and 'no demand' certificate. The abstract of final quantities and financial values shall also be entered in the measurement book and signed by both the parties. The final bill shall be paid within a reasonable time after completion of the work. After the payment of final bill, only the guarantee obligation percentage value shall remain unpaid, which will be released as per GCC.

**NOTE :-** Normally it takes approximately 60 days for the payments to be released by BHEL after recording the measurements.

23 - In all cases of disputes emanating from and in reference to this agreement contract and all questions, dispute for difference of any kind what so ever arising out of or relating to this agreement contract the matter/dispute shall be referred to the arbitration of the sole arbitration of Executive director/Group general manager/General Manager of BHEL, Jhansi or any other person (including an employee of BHEL) even though he had to deal with the matter relating to this agreement contract nominated by the said Executive Director/GGM/GM to act as sole arbitrator. The arbitrator shall be under the arbitrator and conciliation act of 1996 and the rules there under. The arbitrator may from time to time with the consent of the parties enlarge the time for making and publishing the award. No person other than the above or his nominee can act as arbitrator. The venue of arbitrator shall be at Jhansi or the place decided by the arbitrator. The ward of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties of this agreement. The court at Jhansi only should have jurisdiction in the case/matter.

24- The quantity of each item has been mentioned in the tender on tentative. The actual quantity will be as per work given . The quantity may be variate as per requirement. The contract may be awarded on overall lowest basis only.

25- Contractor will submit Central Labour license within 15 days of issued of LOI.

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT FOR CIVIL WORK**

26 Test certificate for all materials to be made available by the contractor as per direction of Engineer-in -charge including strength of concrete cubes , bricks, aggregates. And any other materials provided by contractor.

27. The works have to be carried out as per CPWD specifications 1977, Wherever CPWD specifications are silent, the work shall carried out as per BIS specifications. In case of defective BHEL will have full right to reject the work or part there of .Such defective work if any , will have to be rectified at contractor's cost . The opinion of Engineer in charge shall be final in this matter. If the defective work is allowed to stand BHEL shall have the absolute right to reduce the rates for such items and the contractor shall have no claims over such defective work allowed on reduced rates.

30- The contractor shall have to make his own storage sheds for materials to be issued by BHEL. If Deemed necessary by engineer in charge, the contractor shall make separate store for cement With double lock system .

**TERMS & CONDITIONS OF THE TENDER**

31-The contractor shall comply with the following general terms, conditions and special instructions.

The contractor shall fully comply with the following enactments:

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- a. Contract Labour (R&A) Act, 1971.
  - b. Wage Rates not less than that notified by State Labour department from time to time.
  - c. Payment of Wages Act.
  - d. ESI Act, 1948.
  - e. EPF Act, 1952.
  - f. Workmen's Compensation Act, 1923.
  - g. Stamp duty Act, 1898
  - h. The company's instructions as issued from time to time in regard to working hours, wages, leave, holidays etc.
32. The Contractor shall obtain license from the appropriate Labour Commissioner's office, of appropriate Government if he engages 20 (Twenty) or more workmen only.
33. The contractor shall produce the following Registers and forms before commencement of work, verification by the Executing Officer of the company.
- a. Form XIII - Register of workmen employed by contractor (Rule 75).
  - b. Form XIV - Employment card issued by contractor (Rule 76).
  - c. Form XVI - Muster Roll (Rule 78 (1) (a) (i)).
  - d. Form XVII - Register of Wages (Rule 78 (1) (a) (i)).
  - e. Form XVII - Register of wages-cum Muster Roll (in case of weekly payment).
  - f. Form XIX - Wage slip (Rule 78 (b)).
  - g. Form XX - Register of deduction for damages or loss (Rule 78(1)(a) (ii)).
  - h. Form XXI - Register for fines (Rule 78 (1) (a) (ii)).
  - i. Form XXII - Register of advances (Rule 78 (1) (a) (ii)).
  - j. Form XXIII - Register of overtime (Rule 78 (1) (a) (iii)).
  - k. Form XXIV - Register to be sent by the contractor to licensing officer (Rule 82) (1).

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The contractor shall maintain the above neatly, completely and legibly for inspection by various statutory authorities and the company officials even at short notice.

**Indemnity clause**

That BHEL-Jhansi will not, in any manner be responsible for any act, omission or commission of the workers engaged by contractor and no claim in this respect will lie against BHEL-Jhansi. If any such claim is made against BHEL-Jhansi by any worker or his heirs engaged/employed by the contractor, which BHEL-Jhansi is obliged to discharge by virtue of any statute or any provision of law and rules due to mere fact of the workers of the contractor working at BHEL- Jhansi premises or otherwise, the contractor will be liable to indemnify/reimburse BHEL-Jhansi all the money paid in addition to the expenses incurred by him. The contractor must indemnify and keep indemnified BHEL- Jhansi against all losses and claims for injuries or damage to any person or property whatsoever which may arise of or in course of the operation of the contract and against all claims, demands, proceedings, damages, cost, charges and expenses whatsoever in respect of contingencies depicted herein shall be deemed as expected risk.

The Contractor has to make an agreement with BHEL in the format prescribed only on Rs. 100/- Non - Judicial Stamp Paper.

**Legal compliance clause**

35. The contractor will comply with all the provisions regarding licensing, welfare and health, procedures, maintenance of various records and registers etc., as provided under the contract Labour (Regulation & abolition) Act 1970, rules amendments, orders, notifications there under issued by the Appropriate Government from time to time. For non-compliance of any provisions, statutory compliance under law, the contractor shall be responsible for penalties levied by the appropriate authority under the Act. The contractor shall also be liable to comply with all other Labour and Industrial Laws and such other acts and Statutes (including Factories Act, Payment of Bonus Act, minimum wages Act, etc.,). Depositing of ESI, PF contribution as may be applicable is the responsibility of the contractor. For any default in compliance, the contractor shall be held responsible.
36. The work shall be supervised by the contractor or through the Authorized representatives on day to day basis.
37. The Contractor shall compensate BHEL for any loss or damage to the plant/property, material of BHEL due to his workmen/representatives' negligence or otherwise during execution of work.
38. In the event of contractor abandoning the work or BHEL revoking the contract BHEL shall have a right to get incomplete work completed at contractor's risk and cost. BHEL shall have a right to terminate the contract at any time without assigning any reason thereof.
39. Security deposit will be released on submission of following certificates from departments mentioned as under:-
40. A. No-dues certificate regarding service tax payment, and any other dues liable to be remitted by contractor under financial laws, to Finance department  
B. In case of non satisfactory performance of the contract, BHEL shall have a right of forfeiting the security deposit. In case of any dispute decision of concerned Head of the Department will be final

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**Arbitration clause & governing law**

All disputes arising in connection with the contract shall be settled by mutual consultation. If no agreement is reached the dispute shall be settled in accordance with Arbitration and conciliation Act, 1996 and the rules made there under. The dispute shall be referred for arbitration to any arbitrator to be appointed by the Head of the unit.

The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties. The venue of the Arbitration shall be at Jhansi in India. The Award to be given by the Arbitration shall be a speaking award. All questions, disputes, differences arising under, out of or in connection with this contract shall be to the exclusive jurisdiction of Jhansi court.

**SAFETY DURING WORK.**

1. Contractor must provide safety equipment (PPE) to his workers during work at site.
2. Contractor must depute a qualified supervisor at all times during the work. He shall be responsible for ensuring safety at site.
