1. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

2. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 80% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

3. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all without any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. Further, if bid(s) of any seller(s) eligible for MSE preference is / are coming within price band of 15% of Non MSE L-1 or if bid of any seller(s) eligible for Make in India preference is / are coming within price band of 20% of non MII L-1, then such MSE / Make in India seller shall also be allowed to participate in the RA process.

Pre-Qualification Criteria

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1. Pre-Qualification Criteria(PQC) / Eligibility criteria: PQC / Eligibility criteria for vendor to participate against this Bid mentioned is essential. Supporting documents need to be attached along with Technical bid, offers without proper supporting documents in line with the requirement shall not be considered for scrutiny.
 - a. Experience Criteria: Experience & Past performance in executing similar or higher capacity Burner in last 7 years from the date of bid opening (PO copies preferably from PSU reckoned as supporting documents).
 - b. Bidder / OEM Turnover Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year is Rs. 100 Lakhs. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid.
2. Price bids of customer (M/s IOCL) / customer's PMC (M/s Worley) approved bidders only will be opened even though bidder is meeting all other PQC requirements. For getting customer / PMC approval, bidder has to extend required support to BHEL and has to provide all supporting documents / Past Track Record (PTR) details to get the approvals from M/s IOCL / PMC.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS (ITB)

1. Bidder shall submit Categorical Confirmation of ITB, Special Terms and Conditions, TDC/Technical documents. Vendor shall comply to all the additional clauses mentioned in GeM Bid Document. The offers of those Vendors who do not comply with all the Clauses in total are likely to be rejected. Documents submitted with the offer shall be signed and stamped on each page by authorised representative of the vendor.
2. **Price bids of customer (M/s IOCL) / customer's PMC (M/s Worley) approved bidders only will be opened. For getting customer / PMC approval, bidder has to extend required support to BHEL and has to provide all supporting documents / Past Track Record (PTR) details.**

4. All the terms and conditions mentioned in ITB, Special terms and conditions, Technical documents / TDC shall supersede any other similar terms quoted elsewhere.
5. **QUOTED PRICE: - Bidder shall quote the Price inclusive of Freight, P&F, Transit Insurance and other charges (GeM transaction charges) including GST.**

7. **Scope of supply and work has to be strictly as per provided TDC / Technical specification.**
8. Mandatory Documents to be uploaded by Bidder:
 - a. Signed & stamped copy of PQC, ITB, Special Terms & Conditions, TDC / Technical documents, MII local content eligibility declaration format and vendors offer.
9. MII Purchase Preference and MII Local content eligibility: MII local content eligibility is minimum 20% local content for the package. Purchase preference to MII sellers available up to price within L1+ 20%. Maximum Percentage of Bid quantity for MII Purchase preference shall be 100% as the tender is evaluated on total package basis. To allow participation only from Class 1/Class 2 Local suppliers as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020.
10. MSE Purchase Preference: Purchase preference to MSE sellers available up to price within L1+ 15%. Maximum Percentage of Bid quantity for MSE Purchase preference shall be 100% as the tender is evaluated on total package basis.

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- A. **A. INSPECTION: By BHEL / BHEL Authorized TPIA and Customer TPIA as per approved QAP.** TPIA Charges will be borne by BHEL, provided Inspection is carried out in India.

Supplier needs to register at BHEL online portal i.e. www.cqir.bhel.in for offering Inspection call as and when material is ready according to contract. On readiness of ordered material, the supplier shall raise inspection call request with a minimum period of 15 working days to the authorized representative of the purchaser for inspection / witnessing the testing as envisaged in P.O. Inspection Charges shall be borne by BHEL if inspection is within India.

BHEL representative either from HPVP Unit or Corporate Quality is authorized to carry out audits at supplier's works before providing the dispatch clearance.

After completion of the Inspection at works respectively, suppliers need to send the scanned copies of TC's, Inspection reports and other applicable Test Reports in accordance with TDC to BHEL with duly endorsed by Inspecting authority for obtaining the material dispatch clearance.

BHEL or its authorized representative shall be entitled to carry out inspection of material and workmanship at supplier's premises or at his sub-contractor's premises at all reasonable times during execution of the contract and before dispatch clearance; Such inspection, examination and testing, if made, shall not absolve the vendor from his obligations under the contract.

- B. **B. DELIVERY LOCATION: FOR BHEL HPVP VISAKHAPATNAM.**

- C. **C. DELIVERY PERIOD: 12 weeks from the date of Code-2 approvals of Burner GA drawing and data sheet.**

- D. **D. DOCUMENTATION:** In the event of order, Vendor should submit all necessary drawings, data sheets, QAP and other relevant documents within 15 days from date of PO for approval. **Vendor has to submit QAP for the approval of BHEL and Customer.**

- E. **E. GUARANTEE:** Vendor should guarantee the material against all design and manufacturing defects and for performance for a period of 18 months from the date of last dispatch or 12 months from the date of commissioning whichever is earlier. If any defect is noticed during the above period, the same shall be rectified / replaced free of cost on FOR destination within a reasonable time.

- F. **F. PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE: -**

- a) In the event of an order, Vendor shall furnish Performance Bank Guarantee from any of our consortium banks (List enclosed) as per the enclosed PBG Format.
- b) Performance Bank Guarantee shall be submitted for 10% of order value along with invoice for last dispatch valid till end of guarantee period with a claim period of 12 months thereafter.
- c) Vendor to instruct their PBG issuing bank to send the Original Performance Bank Guarantee directly to BHEL-HPVP-Visakhapatnam.

G. Other clauses like LD, Risk Purchase, Rejection etc. shall be as GeM General terms and conditions.

2. Bidders shall quote only those products in the bid which are not obsolete in the market and has at least 3 years residual market life i.e. the offered product shall not be declared end-of-life by the OEM before this period.
3. Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.
4. Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:
 - a. Copy of PAN Card.
 - b. Copy of GSTIN.
 - c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
 - d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.
5. While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the screenshot of GST portal confirming payment of GST.
6. Supplier shall ensure that the Invoice is raised in the name of Consignee with GSTIN of Consignee only.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specification and / or terms and conditions governing the bid.
