3. CONDITIONS RELATED TO THE WELFARE OF LABOURS

1. Clause 1 is amended as :-

As per the BHEL requirement Contractor will have to make an additional payment to the contract workmen as given below, over and above the minimum wages prescribed by the Government of Punjab from time to time.

Unskilled: Rs.2000/- per month

Semiskilled: Rs.2300/- per month

Skilled: Rs.2500/- per month

This additional amount shall remain fixed during the period of the contract.

2. Clause 2 is amended as :-

The contractor is required to get their employees/ laborers covered under PF & ESI and by suitable Insurance scheme against risk over PF & ESI. The Policy taken by them should be produced to BHEL authorities

3. Clause 4 is added as :-

The contractor will have to cover their workmen under PF, ESI, Bonus Act etc. based On the above payments rate (Minimum Wage + Additional Wage).

All clauses mentioned in various sections other than above mentioned will remain the same.
