TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION OF FRAME WORK AGREEMENT FOR ARCHITECTURAL, CIVIL AND STRUCTURAL DESIGN ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR NON-PLANT BUILDINGS/STRUCTURES

Technical Pre-Qualification Requirement

MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

The bidders should meet the following minimum eligibility/qualifying criteria:

Work experience

Bidder should have successfully completed similar work for any one of the following in last 7 (seven) years from latest date of bid submission.

a. Three similar works each of value not less than 41.6 lakh

OR

b. Two similar works each of value not less than 52.0 lakh

OR

c. One similar work each of value not less than 83.2 lakh

Explanatory Notes

- (i) "Similar works" shall mean providing "Architectural and Civil" or "Architectural and Structural" design for industrial building or commercial building or high-rise residential building having height > 15m.
- (ii) The bidder should submit documentary proofs in support of the criteria mentioned above.
