With reference to the above-mentioned tender enquiry for **Lighting Fixtures, Lamps and Misc. Items package**, following may please be noted:-

1. Clause no. 24 of NIT may be read as below: -

Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders / Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid.

Package is non-divisible in Nature, If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L 1 + 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller(s) shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price (Ex-works + Freight) and contract will be awarded for Approx. 33% of total Contract Value i.e. **2X800 MW Adani RAIGARH TPP Phase-II** Project order and L1 Non MSE bidder will be awarded for Two projects i.e. **2X800 MW ADANI POWER RAIPUR TPP – BTG & 2x 800 MW MTEUPPL MIRZAPUR PHASE I BTG** Projects:-

- If L1 bidder is MSE bidder, splitting criteria as mentioned below (**Split Criteria**) shall be exercised (post implementation of below note, as applicable).
- If L1 bidder is Non-MSE bidder, MSE preference shall be exercised. L1 price (Ex-works + Freight) of Non-MSE bidder shall be counter offered to all MSE bidders (within the price band of L1 +15%) as per CST (comparative statement) ranking post RA one by one- Further, in case, none of the MSE



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bidders (within the price band of L1 +15%) accept the counter offer, then counter offer will be given to Non- MSE bidders as per CST (comparative statement) ranking post RA one by one. Two projects namely **2X800 MW ADANI POWER RAIPUR TPP – BTG & 2x 800 MW MTEUPPL MIRZAPUR PHASE I BTG** shall be awarded to L1 Non- MSE Bidder and **2X800 MW Adani RAIGARH TPP Phase-II** shall be awarded to such qualified MSE /non-MSE bidder, as applicable.

- c) For concurrent application, please refer the OM No.F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017.

**SPLIT CRITERIA:**

Bidders to note that contract of subject tender is proposed to be done with Two (02) vendors approximately in the ratio of 67:33 i.e. Raipur and Mirzapur orders will be awarded to L1 bidder and Raigarh project order will be awarded to L2 bidder/Other Techno-commercially qualified bidders at L1 price (Ex-works + Freight).

L1 price (Ex-works + Freight) shall be counter offered to all those Techno-commercially recommended bidders one by one based on their ranking in CST post RA (in case L2 does not accept L1 price, counter offer shall be given to L3 and so on), who were eligible for participation in RA process for approximately 33% of order value i.e. Raigarh Project.

If none of the bidder accepts counter-offered L1 rates, then all 3 project contracts shall be awarded to L1 vendor for 100% value.


Above splitting criteria shall be applicable only if splitting of tendered quantities is not achieved through MSE preference.





	LED Lighting fixture manufacturer as per sub-vendor list (refer technical specification) or i) Vendor should be a Manufacturer of LED lighting fixture. ii) Availability of type test reports conducted at independent Lab or witnessed by third party of LED fixture as per relevant standard. iii) Availability of routine & acceptance test reports of LED lighting fixture to establish in-house capability at manufacturer's works to carry out routine & acceptance tests as per relevant standard. iv) Vendor should have supplied LED lighting fixtures to power plant/ industrial installations.
2.0	<u>Lighting System Design Capability</u>






2. In case vendor is able to meet criteria at Sl. No. 2 only and not Sl. No. 1 above, vendor can tie-up with any lighting manufacturer (herein termed associate) who is meeting all criteria mentioned in S. No. 1 & submit the credentials of associate. Vendor to submit MOU on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100 /- with associate at bidding stage.
