LIQUIDATED DAMAGES FOR DELAYED DELIVERY clause will be mentioned below is applicable: ---

Liquidated Damages, wherever referred under this Tender/Agreement, shall mean and refer to the damages, not in the nature of penalty, which the contractor agrees to pay in the event of delay in delivery of supplies, breach of contract etc. as the case may be.

Liquidated Damages leviable upon the Supplier/Vendor is a sum which is agreed by the parties as a reasonable and genuine pre-estimate of damages which will be suffered by BHEL on account of delay/breach on the part of the Supplier/Vendor.

If the Seller/Service Provider fails to deliver any or all of

the Goods/Services within the original/re-fixed delivery period(s) specified in the contract, the Buyer will be entitled to deduct/recover the Liquidated Damages for the delay, unless covered under Force Majeure conditions aforesaid, @ 0.5% of the contract value of delayed quantity per week or part of the week of delayed period, until actual delivery or performance, as pre-estimated damages not exceeding 5% of the total contract value without any controversy/dispute of any sort whatsoever. However, in case of inordinate delay maximum deduction shall be 10% of the total contract value.

Note: <u>Inexcusable delays of more than one-fourth (25%) of the completion period specified in the contract shall be treated as inordinate delay(s).</u>

All other terms & conditions of the NIT shall remain unchanged.
