Sub: Issuance of Corrigendum regarding addition of new Terms & Conditions in Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

A. Corrigendum regarding following Terms & Conditions has added in new ATC (Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC) on GeM portal: -

1. Vendor approval of unapproved bidders shall be taken up with end customer for approval for which bidders to submit credentials for approval.
2. Evaluation shall be on the basis of total all inclusive, landed price at consignee destination (Refer cl. No. 6 & 13 of GTC. However, bidder to note that unloading of items (at delivery point) shall be in Buyer's scope. Bidder to quote price accordingly.
3. Bidder to note that Guarantee and Warrantee terms shall be as per cl. No. 10 of GTC on GeM. However, bidder to note that Guarantee/warrantee time period shall be 18 months from the date of the last supply in the contract.
4. Bidder has to note that payment Terms shall be as: 100% payment shall be released within 60 days (45 days for micro or small sellers as per MSMED ACT) of issue of Consignee Receipt-cum-Acceptance Certificate (CRAC) and on-line submission of bills.
5. Compliance of model clauses as provided in Annexure-III of Ministry of Finance Order (Public Procurement No. 1) issued on 23.07.2020 (Restrictions under Rule 144 (xi) of the GFR,2017) shall be applicable for subject tender. Model Certificates provided in same Annexure-III shall also be complied. Further, relevant clause of order no. 25-11/6/2018-PG dated 02.07.20 issued by MoP shall also be complied. An undertaking regarding Model Clauses (as applicable from Annexure-III) shall be furnished along with bid documents.
6. If any modification required by buyer in drawings, drawing shall be revised by seller and resubmitted to BHEL within 7 days from the intimation of modification required.
7. Bidder to note that this item/Package/System falls under the list of items defined in Para 3 of Ministry of Finance guideline dated 20.09.2016 (procurement of items related to public safety, health, critical security, operations and equipment etc.) & hence criteria of prior experience/ turnover shall be same for all the bidders including start-up/ MSME.
8. Bidders to ensure that Third party/Customer issued certificates being submitted as proof of PQR qualification should have verifiable details of document/certificate issuing authority such as name & designation of issuing Authority, its organization contact number and E-mail Id etc. In case the same is found not available, Purchaser has the right to reject such document from evaluation.
9. "Due to COVID-19 pandemic condition prevailing in the country, BHEL/PEM may go for Remote Inspection of Offered items, if required. Vendors are requested to be equipped with the facilities/gadgets as indicated in the guidelines available at : <https://www.bhelpem.com/Documents/VendorSection/Vendor/Guidelines.pdf>



10. Kindly note that, The Bidder declares that they will not enter into any illegal or undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal with other Bidder(s). This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process.
In case, the Bidder is found having indulged in above activities, suitable action shall be taken by BHEL as per extant policies/ guidelines.
11. In case of joint bidding, Bidders shall be required to furnish scope matrix which should be clearly defined between them.
12. PQR criteria uploaded with specification shall prevail Value of Experience criteria and Past performance parameter mentioned in original bid.

Bidder to go through the same before submitting the Bid.
