Name of work - “Design, Manufacturing, Supply, Receipt at Site, Erection, Painting, Finishing Works etc. and Handing over to site REMOVABLE/ RE-ERECTABLE TYPE PRE-ENGINEERED, PRE- FABRICATED Steel Type Office Complex WITH FURNITURE, Closed Storage Shed, Mess Building, Civil Quality Lab, Safety Park; Development of Open Storage Yard, Concrete Raised Platform, Pre-cast Concrete Sleeper, Approach Roads, High Mast Lighting Tower Foundation and Construction Water Reservoir/ Sump; Supply and installation of Weigh Bridge including associated Civil Works (Foundation, Control Room, Approaches, etc.), Design, Manufacturing, Supply of Field offices (Porta Cabins) at 2X660 MW MAHAGENCO Koradi BTG Project.”

A) Some of the Bidders sought clarifications in regard to the published tender specification. The clarifications issued by BHEL are as below;

1	Kindly provide the Cross section, elevation, and roofing dwg. details for HOD cabin, Manager Cabin, field cabin, etc.	Please note that design is in the scope of bidder and bidder to refer TCC Clause 2.3 and Chapter-XII for tentative layout drawings. However, elevation shall be maintained at maximum of 3-4m.
2.	Kindly provide Plan, section and elevation of all types of structures included in the tender.	Please note that design is in the scope of bidder and bidder to refer TCC Clause 2.3 and Chapter-XII for tentative layout drawings. However, elevation shall be maintained at maximum of 3-4m.
3.	Kindly clarify whether the temporary security gate and compound for securing construction material will be in the scope of the contractor or BHEL.	Refer TCC Clause 9.9 wherein it is mentioned that <i>“Material required for the works, whether brought by the Contractor or supplied by BHEL, shall be stored by the Contractor only at places approved by the Engineer. Storage and safe custody of material shall be the responsibility of the contractor”</i> .
4.	Kindly confirm whether land for setting up the labor colony will be provided free of cost by BHEL or needs to be arranged by the contractor.	Refer Clause 3.9.2 of TCC wherein it is mentioned that <i>“Land for labour colony shall be arranged by Contractor at their own cost as per availability outside project area within 5Km.....”</i> .
5.	Kindly confirm whether the materials issued by BHEL, such as steel and cement, are free-issue or chargeable.	Refer Chapter-IX of TCC and Clause 9.1 of TCC wherein it is mentioned that <i>“The contractor shall, at his own expenses (Inclusive of Taxes), provide all materials required for the work”</i> .
