PRE-QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT (PQR) FOR BIDDERS – Rev01

Project	Supply of Ring Granulator Crushers & Vibrating Screening feeders for NTPC North Karanpura Project (3X660 MW STPP)
Scope of Work	Design, Engineering, Manufacture, Supply, Receipt at Site, Storage, Supervision of Erection & Commissioning and Testing for PG parameters for Crushers & Vibrating Screening Feeders.

A. Pre-Qualification Requirement: (Technical)

1	<u>Experience (For Ring Granulator type Crusher):</u> Bidder should have designed, manufactured, erected and commissioned at least two (02) nos. of Ring Granulator Type Crusher for coal application of at least rated capacity of 1000 TPH for coal or other mineral of equivalent volumetric capacity which should have been in successful operation for at least two (2) years prior to the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening.
2	<u>Experience (For Vibrating Screening Feeder):</u> Bidder or his sub vendor for Screens should have designed, manufactured, erected and commissioned at least two (02) nos. of Mechanical vibrator type Vibrating Screening Feeders for coal application of at least 1000 TPH rated capacity and should have been in successful operation for at least two (2) years prior to the date of Techno-Commercial bid opening.
3	<u>For Coal Handling Experience:</u> The bidder should have an experience of design, manufacture, Erection and commissioning of Crushers and Vibrating Screens in at least one number integrated bulk material handling plant (essentially comprising of conveying and crushing) of 1000 TPH rated capacity or above for coal or other minerals of equivalent volumetric capacity which should have been in successful operation for at least one (1) year prior to the date of Techno- Commercial bid opening. Certificate for the same to be submitted along with the offer confirming that the system being supplied has worked along with Conveying system satisfactorily for minimum 1(one) year.

NOTES:

1	Bidder shall submit requisite Documentary evidence such as attested copy of award letter/ contract and also completion certificates/ performance certificates of previous works executed with aforesaid criteria, properly indexed along with offer.
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2	Bidder shall submit details of experience, i.e., jobs executed, jobs in progress in the following below format indicated, along with the offer.

B. Pre-Qualification Requirement: (Financial)

1	Vendors should have a minimum average annual turnover of. Rs. 08 Crores during last 3 financial years (FY 2011-12, 2012-13 & 2013-14) ending 31 st March 2014, and should submit Annual reports (Audited balance sheets, Profit & Loss Accounts), Bankers Solvency certificate & ITCC of these three years.
2	In case of foreign bidders, bidder should have an established Indian Operations to provide services during Supply, Erection, Testing, Commissioning and Post Commissioning support till warranty period.
3	Financial pre-qualification of the foreign bidder (other than Indian bidders) may also be evaluated on the basis of the report from a reputed third party business rating agency like Dun & Bradstreet, Credit reform etc. The foreign bidder is to submit the report from reputed third party. The evaluation of foreign bidder, exchange rate (TT selling rate of SBI) as on scheduled date of the tender opening (Part-1 bid in case of two part bid) shall be considered.

Important Notes to the Bidder:

1. Bidder to note that the acceptance of the offer is subjected to the "Bidder approval from our customer, NTPC" and BHEL reserves the right to reject offer of any bidder based on their poor/ non-performance in past/ present projects/ orders.
2. Bidder has to submit credentials/ details, required by the customer (NTPC) for seeking approval of customer. In case NTPC does not approve the credentials of the bidder, the bidder will be technically rejected.
3. Bidder shall have adequate field service organization to provide the necessary field erection and management services required to successfully erect, test and commission the equipment/ system as required by the bidding documents.
4. **Bidder shall submit the point wise confirmation to the PQR points, properly indexed along with the offer.** Bidders to submit the documents related to proof of collaboration/ agreement, if any.
5. BHEL reserves the right to:
 - a) Accept or reject any bid received at its discretion without assigning any reasons whatsoever.

- b) Postpone the scheduled date without assigning any reason whatsoever.
 - c) May ask for further qualification during techno commercial scrutiny of bids received and bidder will comply.
6. BHEL shall not be responsible for any delay, loss, damage for bids sent by post. BHEL shall not be liable for any expenses incurred by bidder in preparation of bid irrespective of whether it is accepted or not.
 7. Canvassing i.e. soliciting favor, seeking advantage etc. in any form is strictly prohibited and any bidder found to have engaged in canvassing shall be liable to have his bid rejected summarily.
 8. If the bidder deliberately gives any wrong information in his tender to create circumstances for the acceptance to his bid, BHEL reserves the right to reject such application.
 9. If any bidder is black listed or put on hold by any of the BHEL units, such bidder will not be eligible for this tender and their bids shall not be accepted.
