Corrigendum dated 09.08.2024 to NIT no 83816

1. Transportation Clause 3.0 of NIT is amended as given below:

One Way Transportation of free issue materials from BHEL to vendor works, limited to 80 Kms is under BHEL scope. However, in case vendor works is beyond 80 Kms from BHEL, vendor to arrange pick-up of the free issue materials from BHEL. Delivery of the finished Subcontracted items to BHEL stores is the scope of the vendor. Vendor to include the above factors in their quoted price.

In case of wrong/defective material issued by BHEL, scope of transportation of such wrong / defective material from vendor works to BHEL and re-sending of corresponding materials from BHEL to vendor's works is in the scope of BHEL.

Non-lifting of material as specified by BHEL within 07 working days of intimation may be treated as refusal by the vendor and the initial allotted load as per distribution to the vendor may be reduced to that extent. The load so reduced may be redistributed to other vendor(s) based on recommendations of the empowered Committee of respective Products.

As vendor visit for machine verification by BHEL is envisaged, workplace wise enlistment of vendors would be taken up by BHEL which will act as for inclusion into BHEL's Product Material Directory (PMD) for all the HMS(Heavy machining subcontract) & MMS(Medium Machining subcontract) workplaces. Based on this enlistment, BHEL may call upon for entering into Techno commercial MoU for "Heavy Machining Workplaces" to be operated on need basis.

Inclusion into PMDs may entitle for participation in future Limited Tenders. Vendors can also apply for registration of the items on Vendor registration portal (https://supplier.bhel.in/)
