**A. SCOPE OF WORK:**

Two DG Set having a rating of 1750 KVA each was supplied and installed by M/s Cummins Sales & Services Pvt. and also under AMC with the OEM vendor. The batteries of these DG Set needs to be replaced with new one for efficient and reliable operation.

The scope of work is as mentioned below:

- Supply of items as mentioned in BOQ Cum Price Schedule (Annexure-A1).

**General Terms & Conditions**

- 1. Vendor Responsibilities:** The Vendor shall supply Four Numbers of Pulse make Batteries (12V, 160AH) at BHEL SADAN Building, Plot No-25, Sector-16A, Film City, Noida. Vendor will ensure supply of the items at the mentioned address without any wear and tear. Damaged/broken items will not be accepted and replacement (if any) shall be in the scope of the vendor. No additional freight charges shall be paid for replacement of broken/damaged items.
- 2. Delivery Schedule:** The vendor will Supply the batteries within 15 days (at BHEL SADAN Building, Plot No-25, Sector-16A, Film City, Noida.) from the day of placement of Order (Purchase Order).
- 3. Payment Terms:** Best efforts shall be made to release the payment within 30 working days of receipts of material at Site from the date of submission of the bill complete in all respect with all required documents i.e. receipt of invoices (in duplicate). The remittance of payment shall be through NEFT. However, no interest shall be payable for delay in releasing the payment, if any.
- 4.** The offer shall remain valid for a period of 60 days from the due date of opening of Bid (Price Bid).
- 5.** Bid should be free from correction and erasers. Corrections, if any must be counter-signed. If there is a difference between price quoted in words and figures or there is any other discrepancy in the price schedule, higher value(s) will be considered for evaluation and lower values will be considered for ordering.
- 6.** For applicability of MSE and Start-up clauses (if any), the documents valid as on the date of bid opening (including extension) shall be considered. Liquidated Damages/Penalty for delay in supply:
- 7.** (a) LD shall be 0.5% per week or part thereof the total value (excluding taxes) of undelivered portion of the material subject to a maximum of 10% of the total purchase order value (excluding taxes).  
(b) BHEL reserve the right to cancel the Contract in case of delay in delivery by vendor and failure to comply with quality requirements.
- 8. Guarantee /Warranty:** Guarantee/Warranty will be applicable as per OEM.
- 9. Insurance:** It is the responsibility of the supplier to insure the materials in transit till they reach the site. Any damage/pilferage/loss in transit is in the scope of the supplier.



**B. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE BIDDERS:**

1. All documents/ annexures submitted with the offer shall be properly annexed and placed in respective places of the offer as per enclosure list mentioned in the covering letter. BHEL shall not be responsible for any missing documents.
2. Deviation with respect to tender clauses and additional clauses/suggestions in Techno-commercial bid / Price bid shall NOT be considered by BHEL. Bidders are requested to positively comply with the same.
3. BHEL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all Offers without assigning any reasons thereof. BHEL also reserves the right to cancel the Tender wholly or partly without assigning any reason thereof. Also, BHEL shall not entertain any correspondence from bidders in this matter.
4. Since the job shall be executed at site, bidders must visit site/ work area and study the job content, facilities available, availability of materials, prevailing site conditions including law & order situation, applicable wage structure, wage rules, etc. before quoting for this tender. They may also consult this office before submitting their offers, for any clarifications regarding scope of work, facilities available at sites or on terms and conditions.
5. For any clarification on the tender document, the bidder may seek the same in writing or through e-mail, as per specified format, within the scheduled date for seeking clarification, from the office of the undersigned. BHEL shall not be responsible for receipt of queries after due date of seeking clarification due to postal delay or any other delays. Any clarification / query received after last date for seeking clarification may not be normally entertained by BHEL and no time extension will be given.
6. In the event of any conflict between requirement of any clause of this specification/ documents/drawings/data sheets etc. or requirements of different codes/standards specified, the same to be brought to the knowledge of BHEL in writing for clarification before due date of seeking clarification (whichever is applicable), otherwise, interpretation by BHEL shall prevail. Any typing error/missing pages/ other clerical errors in the tender documents, noticed must be pointed out before pre-bid meeting/submission of offer, else BHEL's interpretation shall prevail.
7. In case BHEL decides on a 'Public Opening', the date & time of opening of the sealed PRICE BID shall be intimated to the qualified bidders and in such a case, bidder may depute one authorized representative to witness the price bid opening. BHEL reserves the right to open 'in-camera' the 'PRICE BID' of any or all Unsuccessful/Disqualified bidders under intimation to the respective bidders.
8. Validity of the offer shall be for six months from the latest due date of offer submission (including extension, if any) unless specified otherwise.

### **C. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CONTRACTOR IN RESPECT OF LOCAL LAWS, EMPLOYMENT OF WORKERS ETC.**

The following are the responsibilities of the contractor in respect of observance of local laws, employment of personnel, payment of taxes etc. The subcontractor shall fully indemnify BHEL against any claims of whatsoever nature arising due to the failure of the contractor in discharging any of his responsibilities hereunder:

- a. The contractor shall comply with all applicable State and Central Laws, Statutory Rules, Regulations, Notifications, etc. such as Payment of Wages Act, Minimum Wages Act, Workmen Compensation Act, Employer's Liability Act, Industrial Disputes Act, Employers Provident Act, Employees State Insurance Scheme, Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970, Payment of Bonus & Gratuity Act, Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1996, The Building and Other Construction Workers' Welfare Cess Act, 1996 and other Acts, Rules, and Regulations for labour/workers as applicable and as may be enacted by the State Government and Central Govt. during the tenure of the Contract and having force or jurisdiction at Site. The Contractor shall also comply with provisions of and give all such notices to the local Governing Body, Police and other relevant Authorities as may be required by the Law.
- b. The contractor shall pay and bear all taxes, fees, license charges, Cess, duties, deposits, tolls, royalties, commission or other charges which may be leviable on account of his operations in executing the contract.
- c. The contractor shall be responsible for proper accommodation including adequate medical facilities for personnel employed by him.
- d. The contractor shall be responsible for the proper behaviour and observance of all regulations by the staff employed by him.
- e. The contractor shall ensure that no damage is caused to any person/property of other parties working at site. If any such damage is caused, it is responsibility of the contractor to make good the losses or compensate for the same.
- f. In case the contractor is required to undertake any work outside the scope of this contract, the rates payable shall be those mutually agreed upon if the item rates are not mentioned in existing contract.
- g. BHEL shall recover the amount of compensation paid to victim(s) by BHEL towards loss of life/ permanent disability due to an accident which is attributable to the negligence of contractor, contractor or firm or any of its employees as detailed below.
  - i. Victim: Any person who suffers permanent disablement or dies in an accident as defined below.
  - ii. Accident: Any death or permanent disability resulting solely and directly from any unintended and unforeseen injurious occurrence caused during the manufacturing/ operation and works incidental thereto at BHEL factories/ offices and precincts thereof, project execution, erection and commissioning, services, repairs and maintenance, trouble shooting, serving, overhaul, renovation and retrofitting, trial operation, performance guarantee testing undertaken by the company or during any works/ during working at BHEL Units/ Offices/ townships and premises/ Project Sites.



iii. Compensation in respect of each of the victims:

a) In the event of death or permanent disability resulting from Loss of both limbs: Rs.10,00,000/- (Rs. Ten Lakh). b) In the event of other permanent disability: Rs.7,00,000/- (Rs. Seven Lakh)

c)Permanent Disablement: A disablement that is classified as a permanent total disablement under the proviso to section 2 (I) of the Employee's Compensation Act, 1923.

iv. The contractor shall not stop the work or abandon the site for whatsoever reason of dispute, excepting force majeure conditions. All such problems/disputes shall be separately discussed and settled without affecting the progress of work. Such stoppage or abandonment shall be treated as breach of contract and dealt with accordingly.

**D. VALIDITY OF OFFERS**

The rates shall be kept open for acceptance for a minimum period of 60 days from latest due date of offer submission (including extension, if any). In case BHEL (Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd) calls for negotiations, such negotiations shall not amount to cancellation or withdrawal of the original offer which shall be binding on the tenderers.

Further, BHEL reserves the right to reject the offer of bidder (s) without assigning any reason.

**E. TERMINATION & FORECLOSURE OF CONTRACT**

BHEL reserves the right to terminate or foreclose the contract/part there-off at its own discretion by giving 30 days' notice in writing.

**F. SUB-CONTRACT:**

The vendor shall not sublet any portion of the contract without the prior written approval of BHEL.

**G. ARBITRATION & CONCILIATION**

Gem GTC shall be followed.

**H. No Interest payable to Contractor**

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any other document comprising in the Contract, no interest shall be payable by BHEL to Contractor on any moneys or balances including but not limited to the Security Deposit, Retention Money, RA Bills or the Final Bill, or any amount withheld and/or appropriated by BHEL etc., which becomes or as the case may be, is adjudged to be due from BHEL to Contractor whether under the Contract or otherwise

**I. JURISDICTION OF COURT:**

Courts at Noida (Gautam Budh Nagar) shall have exclusive jurisdiction to decide the dispute, if any, arising out of or in respect of the contract(s) to which these conditions are applicable.

**K. SUSPENSION OF BUSINESS DEALINGS**



BHEL reserves the right to act against the vendor who either fail to perform or Tenderers/Contractor who indulge in malpractices, by suspending business dealings with them in line with BHEL guidelines issued from time to time.

**L. TAXES & DUTIES: -**

- a) To enable BHEL to avail GST input tax credit, contractor shall submit GST compliant Tax invoice containing all the particulars as stipulated under invoice Rules of GST Law. Payment shall be made to the contractor only after submission of GST complaint Tax invoice. The successful bidder shall raise GST compliant invoice affixing GSTN of BHEL's unit availing the services.
- b) BHEL reserves the right to protect its interest against any loss on account of availability of GST credit.
- c) GSTIN of BHEL is "09AAACB4146P2ZC".
- d) Any new/ change in statutory levy as and when made applicable by the Government shall become applicable against documentary evidence.
- e) Payment to the contractor will be subjected to TDS as per rules in force from time to time. The Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) shall be done as per the provisions of Income Tax Act & GST, as amended from time to time and a certificate to this effect shall be provided to the contractor by BHEL
- f) Invoice submitted should be in the format as specified under GST Laws viz. all details as mentioned in Invoice Rules like GSTIN registration number, invoice number, quantity, rate, value, taxes with nomenclature- CGST, SGST, IGST mentioned separately, HSN (Harmonized System of Nomenclature) Code/ SAC (Services Accounting Code) Code etc.
- g) The Contractor has to give an undertaking that GST as mentioned in the invoice has been/ will be paid and also file returns as per respective extant rule.
