1. Sealed tenders under two part bid system are invited from intending transporters / surveyors within India for conducting detailed Route Survey for Safe Transportation of ODC and heavy weight consignments (Approximate Transportation Weight above 5 MT upto 88 MT) from Bhopal to different sites within India. Sites details are listed in **Annexure "C"** (weight and dimensions mentioned in Annexure-"C").
2. Please submit your quotation for conducting route survey of consignment as per Annexure-B, transported by suitable vehicle (Trucks/ Mechanical Trailer/Hydraulic Trailers/Barges/Ships etc.) along with duly signed terms & conditions (Annexure – A, B, C, D & E enclosed),
3. The tenderer is required to submit an Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of an amount of ₹ 28,100/- specified in tender enquiry/ NIT (Notice inviting Tender) along with the Techno-Commercial bid.
4. All corrigenda, addenda, amendments and clarifications to this Tender will be hosted in web page, [www.bhel.com](http://www.bhel.com) & <https://eprocurebhel.co.in> and not in the newspaper. Bidders shall keep themselves updated with all such amendments.
5. Bidder shall ensure that all the documents submitted to be numbered serially. Bidders must ensure that relevant documents are only attached with the offer.
6. Consortium/ JV bidding is not allowed under this NIT.

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ANNEXURE-A

### TERMS & CONDITIONS

Quotations are invited for conducting detailed route survey for transportation of consignments listed in Annexure- C by Road from BHEL, Bhopal to different Project sites (details mentioned in Annexure- C).

#### SECTION-I

##### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Experience: Bidders which are IRDA (Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India) approved or having valid IBA (Indian Banks Association) as on tender opening date are allowed to submit their bid in this tender.

Bidder should have experience for transportation of one consignment weighing above 60 MT of minimum distance 500 kms. Execution was done during last seven years ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited.

OR,

Bidder's having experience of conducting route survey for consignment weighing above 60 MT of minimum distance 500 kms. Execution was done during last seven years ending last day of month previous to the one in which applications are invited.

Documents to be submitted for proof of experience:

- a) Route survey report conducted indicating consignment weight & distance along with customer contact details (email ID, mobile number etc). OR
  - b) Copy of Receipted LR/ GR indicating weight. In case weight is not mentioned in LR then supporting documents like Loading advice (LA) / DAN etc linked with the LR, along with customer contact details (email ID, mobile number etc). OR
  - c) Experience certificate issued for conducting route survey or transportation of consignment weighing above 60 MT of minimum distance 500 kms along with customer contact details (email ID, mobile number etc).
2. Bidder shall submit an affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper valued Rs. 100/- (duly notarized) and certify that:  
We (Name & Address of bidder) certify that: -
    - o We are not presently banned or black listed by any of the BHEL Units/Govt. of India. Also we are not presently put on hold or delisted by BHEL, Bhopal.
    - o We confirm that conditions given in the tender will only be applicable and any modification made thereon by the bidders will be ignored.
    - o We confirm that none of our Group concerns or affiliates etc. appears on the list of banned firms/companies by BHEL (List available on [www.bhel.com](http://www.bhel.com)) nor any of the Director/Partner/Proprietor of bidder/such group concern or affiliate etc. are involved with such firm/company.

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- We confirm that other than us (Name of bidder), none of our Group concerns or affiliates etc. are participating in the tender directly under same Proprietor/common Partner(s)/common Director(s).
- BHEL may reject the bid or in case the contract has been awarded, then terminate the contract apart from taking any other suitable action under the contract or applicable legal provisions or BHEL guidelines, without any liability for any compensation to us (Name of bidder) if,
- BHEL discovers at any time that any statement made by us in affidavit cum undertaking is false, fraudulent or
- Any document submitted by us was fake or forged Or if BHEL determines in its sole discretion that any statement was aimed at deliberately misleading BHEL with a view to ensure award of the subject contract to the bidder.

### SECTION-II

#### 3. SCOPE OF WORK:

Survey Report should contain following information:

- i. The Route Survey shall cover the important bridges, Road over bridges, overhead transmission lines, level crossings and any other important infringements en-route, identified with distance in Km from starting points. The route survey should clearly identify narrow roads, sharp turns, unworkable gradients, culverts, underpass, overhung, overhead structure or any other similar obstacles etc requiring removal, shifting, modification, strengthening widening, straightening or construction of bypasses/approach roads for safe transportation of ODCs.
- ii. The route survey shall also cover the position of different bridges/ culverts etc. to be negotiated on way and their capacity to be assessed for bearing of required load of consignment, making necessary bypass etc, if required, to negotiate weak bridges / culverts etc without violating motor vehicle acts and other rules of state Govt, Central Govt and local bodies.
- iii. The Route Survey shall be supported by photographs identifying the major milestones along the way.
- iv. Road map highlighting the route.
- v. Summary and conclusion (destination-wise) - In case during feasibility Route Survey, it is found that consignments cannot be transported in particular destination, detailed reasons along with photograph to be furnished. Suggestion to make the Route feasible in that particular segment should also be elaborated.
- vi. Required permissions from civil authorities / Railway / Electricity Board / Irrigation etc. are to be indicated.
- vii. Budgetary price giving details like cost of civil work en-route, if any, giving further details of each civil work at different destinations en-route.

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### 4. PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF TENDERS on E TENDERING:

Bidder has to submit offer directly through E-PROCUREMENT MODE. The tender is floated online through our E-Procurement Site <https://eprocurebhel.co.in>. The bidder may respond by submitting their offer online in our e-Procurement platform at <https://eprocurebhel.co.in>

The bids shall be submitted in two parts: (a) Techno-Commercial bid (Part-I) and (b) Price bid (Part-II). The tender shall be submitted online as per the instructions mentioned below:

#### a) Techno-Commercial bid (Part-I) (Un priced Tender)

All Technical details (eg. Eligibility Criteria requested (as mentioned below)) should be attached, failing which the tender stands invalid & may be REJECTED. Bidders shall furnish the following information along with technical tender (preferably in pdf format):

- Technical Bid (without indicating any prices).
- All the supporting documents for qualification requirements mentioned in SECTION-I of Annexure-A as above.
- Duly signed & stamped copy of tender documents and other enclosures i.e. all pages of their offer.
- Earnest money Deposit (EMD) furnished in accordance with NIT Clause 7. Documentary evidence for submission of EMD amount of ₹ 28,100/-.
- Un priced price bid (Annexure-C).
- Duly signed & stamped Annexure-D on your letter head.
- Duly filled signed & Stamped Annexure-E.
- Proof for evidencing the authority of person signing the quotation. (Relevant extracts of AOA and/or MOA and /or copies of Board Resolution, Notarized copy of Power of Attorney/Partnership Deed etc. as applicable).

Technical bid without any of the above documents is liable to be rejected. However, bidder not submitting inputs against (c) above i.e. EMD along with Techno-commercial bids may be disqualified.

Route survey/any other charges shall NOT be mentioned anywhere in the Techno-Commercial Bid.

#### b) Price Bid (Part-II):

- Prices are to be quoted in the Price Bid format online on e-tender portal.
- The price should be quoted for the accounting unit indicated in the tender document.
- Note: It is the responsibility of tenderer to go through the Tender document to ensure furnishing all required documents in addition to above, if any. Any deviation would result in REJECTION of tender and would not be considered at a later stage at any cost by BHEL.
- A person signing (manually or digitally) the tender form or any documents forming part of the contract on behalf of another shall be deemed to warrantee that he has

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authority to bind such other persons and if, on enquiry, it appears that the persons so signing had no authority to do so, the purchaser may, without prejudice to other civil and criminal remedies, cancel the contract and hold the signatory liable for all cost and damages.

- v. A tender, which does not fulfil any of the above requirements and/or gives evasive information/reply against any such requirement, shall be liable to be ignored and rejected.
- c) Uploading of the price bid in prequalification bid or technical bid (Part-I) may RESULT IN REJECTION of the tender.

Any mentions like “actual” or “approximate” on any account or any other information in the price bid shall not be considered and the quotation is liable to be rejected. In case any other information other than cost of transportation is furnished in the price bid, information/deviation/condition etc. shall be ignored.

**The currency of this contract is Indian Rupees (INR).**

- a. If any bidder submits a combined bid or gives the price in Techno-Commercial bid, his offer may be liable to be rejected.
- b. Bidders shall quote the rates in English Language and international numerals. The rates shall be entered in figures as well as in words. For the purpose of the tender, the metric system of units shall be used.
- c. All entries in the tender shall either be typed or be in ink. Erasers, cutting and overwriting are not permitted and may render such tender liable to summary rejection. The Bidder shall duly attest all cancellations and insertions.
- d. In case of discrepancy in quoted rates following will be applicable.
  - i. If there is an error in a total corresponding to the addition or subtraction of subtotals, the subtotals shall prevail and the total shall be corrected; accordingly, and,
  - ii. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail subject of (i) and above.
- 5. In case of E-Tenders, no paper bids shall be accepted, therefore, the scanned copy of the Banker’s Cheque/ Demand Draft/ Pay Order/ Details of payment made through Electronic Fund Transfer/ Fixed Deposit Receipt (FDR) / Bank Guarantee should be uploaded in the E-Procurement Portal and hard copy of the same should reach to following address . BHEL shall not be responsible for postal or any other delays in this regard.)

Bidders may please note that no other mode of bid submission shall be considered for evaluation apart from Clause no. 04 to 05 mentioned above.

**Offers received after due date & time shall be considered late and will be rejected. BHEL shall not be responsible for any delay.**

6. The Techno-Commercial bids shall be opened at 2:00 PM on the same day in the presence of those bidders who choose to be present. The price bids of Technically & Commercially accepted bidders shall be opened on a subsequent date which will be intimated to all qualified bidders.

**7. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD):-**

An amount of ₹ 28,100/- (Rupees Twenty Eight Thousand only) shall be paid by bidders towards EMD in the form of –

Mode of Deposit:

- (i) Cash deposit as permissible under the extant Income tax act (before tender opening)
- (ii) EMD is to be furnished through e-Mode (ie NEFT / RTGS / Net Banking / PoS / SB Collect etc.) (before tender opening) The following link to be followed for SB Collect platform : <https://www.bhelbpl.co.in/qcins/iccs.htm> .  
Bank details of BHEL / Bhopal as per ANNEXURE-B.
- (iii) Bankers cheque/ Pay order/ Demand draft, in favour of BHEL (with offer)
- (iv) EMD can also be accepted in the form of FDR issued by Scheduled Banks /Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act (FDR should be in the name of the Contractor, a/c BHEL)  
In addition to the above, EMD amount in excess of Rs. 02 Lakhs may also be accepted in the form of Bank Guarantee as per BG proforma of BHEL from scheduled bank. The Bank guarantee in such cases shall be valid for at least 06 months.
- (v) The quotations received without EMD likely to be rejected. Any request for adjustment of EMD from the amounts due from BHEL to the bidders shall not be accepted and the offer shall be rejected.
- (vi) EMD shall be exempted for MSE's (Micro & Small Enterprise), subject to production of statutory documents along with bid (Part I).

8. The EMD of successful tenderer will be retained as part of Security Deposit and EMD in respect of unsuccessful bidder shall be refunded normally within fifteen days of the award of work. EMD shall not carry any interest.

9. (a) Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) furnished by the bidder shall be forfeited if:

- i. After opening the tender, the bidder revokes his tender within the validity period or increases his earlier quoted rates.
- ii. Failure to enter into agreement within a week of award of contract.

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- iii. If tender process is delayed/disrupted due to an act of bidder/deviations from BHEL terms & conditions etc.

#### 10. SECURITY DEPOSIT (SD)

- i. Security Deposit means the security provided by the Contractor towards fulfilment of any obligations in terms of the provisions of the contract.
- ii. The total amount of Security Deposit will be 3% of the contract value. EMD of the successful tenderer shall be converted and adjusted towards the required amount of Security Deposit.
- iii. The balance amount to make up the required Security Deposit of 3% of the contract value shall be furnished through e-Mode (ie NEFT / RTGS / Net Banking / PoS / SB Collect etc.) only. The following link to be followed for SB Collect platform:

Alternatively

The security deposit amount shall be accepted in the following modes of deposit also:

- i. Bank Guarantee from Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act. The Bank Guarantee format should have the approval of BHEL and valid till the completion of contract. All fresh/extended BGs will be issued/extended with minimum claim period of 12 months from date of completion of contract.
  - ii. Fixed Deposit Receipt issued by Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act (FDR should be in the name of the Contractor, a/c BHEL).
  - iii. Securities available from Indian Post offices such as National Savings Certificates, Kisan Vikas Patras etc. (held in the name of Contractor furnishing the security and duly endorsed/ hypothecated/ pledged, as applicable, in favour of BHEL)
- (Note: BHEL will not be liable or responsible in any manner for the collection)

At least 50% of the required Security Deposit, including the EMD, shall be deposited within 30 days of placement of WO. Balance of the Security Deposit can be recovered, if applicable, by deducting 10% of the gross amount progressively from each of the running bills of the Contractor till the total amount of the required Security Deposit is collected.

If the value of the work done at any time exceeds the contract value, the amount of Security Deposit shall be correspondingly enhanced and the additional Security Deposit shall be immediately deposited by the Contractor or recovered from payment/s due to the Contractor.

"Bidder agrees to submit performance security required for execution of the contract within the time period mentioned. In case of delay in submission of performance security, enhanced performance security which would include interest (SB/ rate + 6%) for the delayed period, shall be submitted by the bidder. Further, if performance security is not submitted till such time the first bill becomes due, the amount of performance security due shall be recovered as per terms defined in NIT I contract, from the bills along with due interest ".

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Security Deposit shall be released to the Contractor upon fulfilment of contractual obligations as per terms of the contract.

**11. GST LAW COMPLIANCE**

**1) Unregistered transporter and but GST to be paid on reverse charge basis:**

Reverse Charge under GST:

- (a) Transporter has to submit invoice within 30days of completion of service and the reverse charge liability shall arise at the earliest of date of payment to service provider or 60 days from date of issue of invoice by transporter.
- (b) In case BHEL is not able to discharge its reverse charge liability for reasons attributable to transporter, then the same shall be recovered from transporter along with interest, penalty etc if any.

**2) Transporters registered under GST and tax to be paid on reverse charge basis:**

Transporters to ensure filing of GST returns on time giving details of all invoices raised on BHEL. Any loss of ITC to BHEL due to non-compliance by contractor shall be recovered from the transporter. An undertaking that GST returns have been filed declaring all invoices on BHEL to be submitted along with bill to claim payment.

- (a) Transporter has to submit invoice within 30days of completion of service and the reverse charge liability shall arise at the earliest of date of payment to service provider or 60 days from date of issue of invoice by transporter.
- (b) In case BHEL is not able to discharge its reverse charge liability for reasons attributable to transporter, then the same shall be recovered from transporter along with interest, penalty etc if any.

**3) Transporter registered & GST payable on forward charge basis:**

GST to be submitted on time and copy of challan to be submitted along with bill for claiming payment. All GST returns to be submitted on time giving details of all invoices raised on BHEL during the period. Any loss of ITC to BHEL due to non-compliance by contractor shall be recovered from the transporter along with interest. An undertaking that GST returns have been filed declaring all invoices on BHEL to be submitted along with bill to claim payment.

TDS under Income Tax as applicable shall be deducted at prevailing rates on gross invoice value from the RA bills. Any income tax liability of the Contractor at source shall be deducted in accordance with Indian Income Tax law as applicable from time to time and necessary certificate in respect of such deduction in accordance with Law shall be furnished to the Contractor at his written request to BHEL. Similarly, any GST TDS applicable is to be deducted from the bill.

The PAN Number & GST Number shall be pre-printed on the freight bill. In the event of any disallowance of input credit or applicability of interest or any other financial liability arises on BHEL-Bhopal due to any default of transporter under GST, such implication shall be to Bidder's account.



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### 12. BHEL RESERVES THE RIGHT TO: -

- 1) BHEL reserves the right to accept the offers in part or in full, cancel the Tender enquiry or short close the contract without assigning any reason.
  - 2) Accept or reject any of the bid/all bids or cancel/withdraw the invitation for bid without assigning any reason whatsoever, and in such case no bidder/intending bidders shall have any claim arising out of such action by BHEL.
  - 3) Reject conditional tenders, tenders containing absurd or unworkable rates and tenders which are incomplete and otherwise considered defective and tenders not in accordance with the tender conditions, during the tender evaluation process.
  - 4) Cancel/terminate the work order/contract at any time during its currency without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
  - 5) BHEL reserves the right to either short close or terminate the contract entered into with any of or all of the transport operators at its discretion without assigning any reason by giving one-month notice by registered post acknowledgement due or in person under recorded delivery.
  - 6) In case BHEL decides to send the consignment by Railways, then the road/multimodal contract shall be cancelled and in such a case BHEL will not be liable for any cost or commitment made by the bidder.
13. Non-compliance of BHEL's terms and conditions/conditional offer on the part of bidder will result in his offer liable to be rejected.

### 14. REJECTION OF OFFERS:

All information furnished by the bidder is taken to be authentic for evaluation of tender. Any information found to be incorrect subsequently at any time, the offer shall be rejected and EMD/SD shall be forfeited and suitable disciplinary action shall be taken against the bidder.

### 15. VALIDITY: -

15.1) Validity of Bid: 90 days from the date of opening of the Technical Bid. The price bids of all items/consignments may be opened simultaneously or separately in parts with prior intimation to bidders.

15.2) Validity of Contract for execution: Once contract is awarded it shall be valid for a period of TWELVE (12) Months for execution of the contract thereafter. BHEL reserves the right to extend the period of the contract for further period of THREE (3) months, on same rates, terms and conditions. The contract may further be extended beyond three months with mutual consent of BHEL and bidder.

### 16. BID EVALUATION CRITERIA:

Bidders have to quote for all the 3 destinations. Offers shall be evaluated on overall L1 basis on lowest cost to BHEL basis. Work will be awarded to single party at L1 rate acceptable to BHEL.

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In case of L1 position occupied by more than one bidder, effective L1 will be decided by soliciting discount from the respective L-1 bidders.

In case more than one bidder happens to occupy the L-1 status even after soliciting discount, the L1 bidder shall be decided by a toss/ draw of lots, in the presence of the respective L1 bidder(s) or their representative(s).

Rank will be done accordingly. BHEL's decision in such situations shall be final and binding. If quoted rates are high, negotiations may be conducted with L-1 bidder. The work shall be awarded to L1 (being lowest) at quoted/negotiated rates acceptable to BHEL only.

L1 bidder shall be decided based on conventional mode of opening of price bid.

### 17. COMPLETION & SUBMISSION OF ROUTE SURVEY

Successful L1 bidder has to submit Route Survey Report in coloured hard copy duly binded. Expected completion time for route survey and submission of Survey Report shall be:

**Note:** Above survey period has given on normal weather condition. In case of abnormal whether conditions and other force majeure conditions, bidders have to submit documentary evidence for increase in survey time. Additional survey time shall be allowed with the approval of BHEL (Head of Logistics) based on the representation received from the bidder on case-to-case basis.

18. The successful bidder shall enter into an agreement prior to taking up the job/s on Non-Judicial Stamp Paper worth Rs.500/- at his cost. The agreement shall be entered within a week of award of contract.

19. Failure to enter into agreement within a two week may lead to forfeiture of EMD / SD and termination of contract, subject to decision of competent authority at BHEL. In such an event BHEL reserves the right to conduct route survey from alternate bidder, at the risk and cost of

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the awarded bidder and extra expenditure, if any, incurred by BHEL shall be recovered from the defaulter bidder.

20. Bidder shall nominate one competent person to ensure proper coordination of logistics for the entire duration of each contract.

### 21. PENALTY FOR LATE SUBMISSION OF ROUTE SURVEY:

Timely submission of route survey is the essence of the contract. The quoted time for completion of route survey shall form the basis of implementation of LD penalty, in case of award of work/execution.

Delay in submission of route survey report will attract penalty @ 2% (two percent) per week of delay or part thereof subject to a maximum of 15% of payable amount shall be levied.

### 22. INDEMNITY:

The bidder/transporter shall indemnify and keep indemnified BHEL all losses, claims, etc. arising out of any of his acts of his agents or associates or servants during the currency of each contract.

### 23. PREVENTION OF CORRUPTION:

a) Canvassing in any form or any attempt to influence directly or indirectly any official of BHEL will lead to rejection of the bid and forfeiture of the Earnest Money Deposit.

b) BHEL shall be entitled to cancel the contract and to recover from the bidder the amount of any loss resulting from such cancellation if the bidder has offered or given any person any gift or consideration of any kind as an inducement or reward for doing or intending to do any action in relation to the obtaining or the execution of the contract or any other contract with BHEL, if the like acts shall have been done by any persons employed by him or acting on his behalf whether with or without the knowledge of the bidder in relation to this or any other contract with BHEL.

### 24. SUB-LETTING:

Sub-letting of the work either in full or in part is strictly prohibited. Violation shall lead to forfeiture of EMD and finally termination of the contract.

### 25. PAYMENT:

100% payments shall be made within 90 days / 45 days (for contractor covered under MSME act), after completion of work (s) as per work order. The document in support of MSE to be Udhyam Certificate only.

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#### 26. RISK PURCHASE:

If the work is not executed or partly executed within the agreed execution period, BHEL reserves the right to cancel the order and get the work executed from the alternate source(s) at the Risk and Cost of the Contractor. In such an event, it shall be obligatory on the part of contractor to make good any loss suffered by BHEL

BHEL reserves to itself the following rights in respects of this Contract without entitling the bidder for any compensation. If at any time during the currency of the contract, the bidder fails to fulfill all or any of the services required under the scope of work, BHEL reserves the right to get the work done by other parties or departmentally at the cost and risk of the bidder and also forfeit the EMD. Balance amount, if any, will be recovered from the transporters freight bills at any unit of BHEL.

26.1) To recover any money due from the bidder under this contract or any other contract will be recovered from the EMD or/ & pending bills from any unit of BHEL.

26.2) To claim compensation for losses sustained including BHEL's supervision charges & Overhead charges in case of termination of Contract.

#### 27. ARBITRATION:

- a. If at any time, any questions, disputes or differences whatsoever arising out of or in any way concerning the contract between BHEL and the Bidders/contractors, the same shall be referred to the sole arbitrator i.e. Head of the unit/Executive Director, HEEP, BHEL, Bhopal or nominee appointed by him in writing. The arbitration shall be conducted in line with the provisions of Indian ARBITRATION AND CONCILIATION ACT, 1996. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both parties.
- b. The contract shall continue to be operated during the arbitration proceedings unless otherwise directed in writing by BHEL or unless the matter is such that the contract cannot be operated till the decision of the arbitrator is received.
- c. The place of Arbitration will be BHEL Bhopal.

#### 28. JURISDICTION:

In case of any suit or other legal proceedings arising under or relating to the contract, the courts at Bhopal only shall have jurisdiction.

#### 29. BANNED FIRMS:
