It is declared upfront that the enquiry shall be subject to Reverse Auction (RA). Bidders may kindly note the Reverse Auction (RA) field as mentioned and asked for in enquiry template & ensure to proceed with choosing “YES” against same when asked during submission of their offer to give their acceptance for participation in RA.

BHEL shall be resorting to Reverse Auction (RA) (Guidelines as available on www.bhel.com) for this tender. RA shall be conducted among all the techno-commercially qualified bidders.

Price bid of all techno-commercially qualified bidders shall be opened for purpose of RA and same shall be considered as initial bids of bidders in RA. In case any bidder(s) do(es) not participate in Reverse Auction, their sealed envelope price bid along with applicable loading, if any, shall be considered for ranking.
