All the sealed envelopes are then to be put in one single envelope **super scribed with Enquiry No. and Due date**. Offer must reach our tender room latest by 11.00 AM (IST) on the due date mentioned in enquiry. Late offers shall not be considered in any condition.

5. **Tender Evaluation:** On due date of enquiry, only PQR Bid offer (Part-I) shall be opened and after scrutiny, vendors who are qualified in Pre-Qualification Requirement, Techno-commercial bid(Part-II) of those vendors shall be opened in tender room, for which separate advance intimation shall be given.

After technical / commercial scrutiny, price bid (Part-III) of the vendors who are found technically & commercially in line with our requirement shall be opened, for which separate advance intimation shall be given.

6. **Tender Cost Evaluation**, shall be on the basis of delivered cost i.e. Landed/total cost to BHEL. Evaluation of bids will be done on the basis of total cost of mandatory & optional activities. The bidder which will quote the lowest total value for the mandatory as well as optional activities to be selected as the lowest bidder. Evaluation of Tender will be on Package-wise.

(FOR FOREIGN VENDORS)

Foreign exchange rate of 'TT selling rate of State Bank of India (SBI)' prevailing on the date of Part-I (PQR) bid opening shall be taken. If the relevant day happens to be a bank holiday, then the forex rate as on the previous bank (SBI) working day shall be taken.

7. **Inspection for foreign vendor-** by BHEL/ Customer /BHEL appointed Third Party Agency (wherever applicable) prior to dispatch in line with approved manufacturing and Quality Plan. Charges, if any, are to be shown separately in the **Price- Bid**. In addition to this, inspection may be carried out by BHEL & its Customer at vendors works.

For indigenous Vendors-Inspection shall be carried out at vendor's works by BHEL/ Customer /BHEL appointed Third Party Agency. In addition to this, inspection may be carried out by BHEL & its Customer at vendors works.

8. **Penalty for Delay in Delivery:** Subject to force majeure conditions, Penalty shall be 0.5% of the total order value per week of delay or part thereof, subject a maximum of 10% of the total order value. In case of staggered delivery schedule, penalty shall be 0.5% of the undelivered portion per week or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% of the total order value. Loading for penalty clause shall be to the extent to which it is not agreed to by the bidder (at offered value).
9. Firms on **HOLD** for particular PMD or **DELISTED** Firms at Bhopal Unit Level or **BANNED** firms at corporate level / who engage the services of the banned firms, are not allowed to participate in the tender and their offers shall be summarily rejected. 17. **Compliance to MAKE IN INDIA circular issued by Gol:
MAKE IN INDIA Preference**

This has reference to Government of India Circular no. P-45021/2/2017-BE-II dt 15.06.2017 for Preference to Make in India and subsequent amendment issued thereon. A self-certification complying the condition below may please be submitted through return mail on company letter head duly signed by competent authority. Procedure for preference to make in India shall be applicable in the tender as per Government circular no.P-45021/2/2017-BE-II DTD 15.06.17. Minimum Local content shall be 50%.

Margin of purchase preference to make in India shall be 20%.

For this procurement, public procurement (preference to make in India), order 2017 dt 15.06.2017 & 28.05.2018 and subsequent order issued by the restrictive nodal ministry shall be applicable even if issued after issue of this NIT but before finalization of contract/PO/WO against this NIT. In the event of any nodal ministry prescribing higher or lower percentage of purchase preference and/ or local content in respect of this procurement, same shall be applicable.

False declaration will be in breach of the code of integrity under Rule 175 (i)(h) of the General Finance Rule for which a bidder or its successors can be debarred for up to two years as per Rule 151(iii) of the General Finance Rules along with such other actions as may be permissible under Law.

To avail purchase preference under Make in India guidelines, vendor should be categorized as Class 1 supplier. For a vendor to be classified as Class 1 supplier, bidder & their mill from which support letter has been furnished shall have to submit annexure – III with seal and sign duly ratified / verified by statutory auditor or cost auditor of the company (in case of companies) or from a practicing chartered accountant (in respect of suppliers other than companies) giving the percentage of local content

18. Integrity Pact (IP) – Independent external monitor (IEM): -

IP is a tool to ensure that activities and transactions between the company and its bidders/contractors are handled in a fair, transparent and corruption free manner. 19. OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES

There are some optional activities included in the scope of work defined in the technical specifications attached herewith. Evaluation of bids will be done on the basis of total cost of mandatory & optional activities. The bidder which will quote the lowest total value for the mandatory as well as optional activities to be selected as the lowest bidder. However, payment for the optional activities (as per Clause 3 of scope of work) to be made only in the case when BHEL decides to get the optional activities conducted. Otherwise, payment for the mandatory activities only will be made. Decision on conductance of the optional activities will be taken after completion of the mandatory pre-witness tests.

20. DELIVERY

For the mandatory pre-witness tests (clauses 2.1 & 2.2 of scope of work) followed by witness tests (clause no. 5 of scope of work) and completion of all deliverables including model test procedure, model test reports and supply of model etc., the delivery period from the date of placement of order shall be 9 months or the duration agreed at the time of Order placement. In case, BHEL decides to get the optional tests conducted (clause 3 of scope of work), the delivery period shall be 15 days more than the above duration.

21. Performance bank guarantee equivalent to 10% of the Order value shall be submitted by vendor. PBG shall be valid up to the guarantee period or successful performance whichever is earlier.

22. MODEL CONCILIATION CLAUSE FOR CONDUCTING CONCILIATION PROCEEDINGS UNDER THE BHEL CONCILIATION SCHEME, 2018:

The proceedings of Conciliation shall broadly be governed by Part-III of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 or any statutory modification thereof and as provided in Annexure.
