

**Technical Specifications:**

- a) Furnace Oil conforming to IS 1593:1982 (Second Amendment) Reaffirmed 2004 of MV2 Grade, having Sulphur content less than 4% by mass.
- b) If any change in the IS standard of Furnace Oil is done by Government of India, then the quality of Furnace oil shall be as per latest IS standard, for the supply, accordingly.
- c) Quantity of Furnace Oil shall be 6800MT for two years (Approx 290 MT per month depending on monthly requirement). Monthly requirement can vary by  $\pm$  20%.

**ANNEXURE II****ESSENTIAL CONDITIONS OF SUPPLY**

<b>Technical Details</b>	As mentioned in Annexure I
<b>Test Certificate</b>	Test certificate of furnace oil conforming to technical details mentioned in Annexure I, is required to be submitted by the supplier against the each lot (total 24 lots in complete tender period) of Furnace oil supplied.
<b>Sealing/Locking</b>	Transportation of Furnace oil is in the scope of supplier through their approved tankers on HESG basis FOR BHEL Bhopal. Locking and sealing arrangement on top covers and outlet valves of the Furnace oil tankers shall be done by the supplier as per locking arrangement being done by oil companies to ensure the Quality & Quantity of Furnace oil received at BHEL.
