- 1 Kindly quote your rates on firm price basis with the offer validity of minimum Sixty days from the date of tender opening. The same shall be per Running Meter basis for each item and on FOR, BHEL, Trichy. In case of foreign vendors, the offer shall be on FOB basis only.
- 2. Kindly quote for enquired specification only (**not its equivalent**) that meets Technical Delivery Conditions vide TDC No: 0/108/00 (copy attached).
- a) size and single length should be in line with the enquiry.
- 3. Item quantity required and tolerance in Quantities shall be quoted as per our enquiry requirement. Normally+/-10% tolerance in quantities of ordered quantity will be acceptable to BHEL.
- 4 Our delivery requirement is as follows:
 - For Enqy.Sl.No.3-- 5,000 meters are to be delivered within two months of Letter of Intent / Purchase Order. Balance quantities for enqy sl.nos are to be despatched only after April,2012 and shall be completed within May,2012.

 Offers not meeting this delivery will not be considered.
- 5. Prices shall be firm till entire execution of the Purchase Order. Price variation clause is not acceptable.
- 6. Lowest prices received against BHEL enquiries need not be the technically acceptable one and in that case BHEL reserves the right not to consider the same.
- 7. Heat Number, Specification of material, size, colour coding and supplier's emblem/logo are to be hard stamped on all Tubes / pipes.
- 8. Our normal payment termis 100% payment within 45 to 90 days after the acceptance of material at BHEL Stores for indigenous vendors. No other payment term is acceptable to BHEL. In case of Foreign vendors, 100% payment through Letter of Credit.

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- 9. Original Test certificates in triplicate shall accompany the dispatches.
- 10. Delivery schedule shall be strictly as per BHEL requirements only which is indicated in the Enquiry / Purchase Order sheet that will be issued. In case of delay in delivery, beyond the end delivery dates given in the Purchase Order sheet, Liquidated Damage clause will be applicable at the rate of 0.5 % per week and subject to a maximum of 15% of undelivered portion of the item value.
- 11.The delivery of the item shall be strictly as per BHEL's enquiry/ Purchase orders. In case of urgency, the delivery period have to be altered to meet BHEL's production plan.
- 12. Confirmation for compliance is to be given in the offer for all the conditions specified in the respective Technical Delivery Conditions.
- 13.BHEL reserves the right to increase / decrease the enquired quantities or to delete the enquired quantities for any of the items. - 15. The materials are to be dispatched with proper packing and binding.
- 16.BHEL reserves the right to finalise the tender either through price bid open or **through Reverse Auction route**. A typical copy of "Business Rules and Conditions" of Reverse Auction is enclosed herewith for information and reference.
- 17. The offers are invited in two parts.

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20. The quantity in the enquiry is final. No upward /downward revision in the quantity will be made to suit the minimum heat load if any required by the vendor. Hence the vendor is permitted to supply the materials within +/- 10% tolerance allowed for the quantity.

- 21. In addition to all the above conditions, BHEL standard terms & conditions given as a separate annexure shall also be applicable to the extent they are not superseded by the above conditions.
- 22. Non-adherence to these special conditions of enquiry and BHEL's standard terms and conditions will lead to disqualification of offer.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF RA

Against this enquiry for the subject item/system with detailed scope of supply as per enquiry specifications, BHEL may resort to "REVERSE AUCTION PROCEDURE" i.e., ON LINE BIDDING ON INTERNET.

- a. For the proposed reverse auction, technically and commercially acceptable bidders only shall be eligible to participate.
- b. BHEL will engage the services of a service provider who will provide all necessary training and assistance before commencement of on line bidding on internet.
- c. BHEL will inform the vendor in writing in case of reverse auction, the details of Service Provider to enable them to contact & get trained.
- d. Business rules like event date, time, Start price, bid decrement, extensions etc. also will be communicated through service provider for compliance.
- e. Vendors have to fax the Compliance form in the prescribed format (provided by Service provider) before start of Reverse auction. Without this, the vendor will not be eligible to participate in the event.
- f. 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1.0 SCOPE

Technical Delivery Condition specifies 1.1 additional requirements for the delivery of cold drawn seamless alloy steel tubes conforming to AISI 602.

This TDC is supplementary to the mandatory requirements 1.2 covered in the specification.

The size and quantity shall be as specified in the 1.3 purchase order.

CHEMICAL COMPOSITION AND PROCESS 2.0

The tubes shall be made from fully killed steel made by 2.1 any one of the electric furnace processes.

2.2 The tubes shall be made by cold drawing only.

2.3 The chemical composition of the steel shall conform to the requirements given below, in both ladle and product analysis:

5.0 MECHANICAL TESTS

5.1 The tubes shall be subjected to mechanical tests as per specification. The acceptance criteria for tensile testing shall be as follows:

Tensile strength : 130 - 260 Ksi Yield strength : 110 - 200 Ksi

% Elongation : 10 min. % Reduction in area : 40 - 60

6.0 NON DESTRUCTIVE TESTS

6.1 ULTRASONIC TEST

- 6.1.1 Each length of tube shall be subjected to ultrasonic test in accordance with ASTM E213 with calibration notch of depth 5% of the wall thickness of the tube or 0.3 mm whichever is greater. However, the maximum notch depth shall be limited to 1.5 mm.
- 6.1.2 The calibration tube shall contain two longitudinal notches not exceeding 50 mm, which have been accurately machined along with longitudinal axis of the tube. For tubes of outer diameter exceeding 30 mm, one notch shall be on the outside and the other notch shall be on the inside separated by atleast 75 mm.
- 6.1.3 Each tube shall be scanned so that the sound beam is propagated in both the clockwise and counter clockwise directions as observed from one end of the tube.

6.2 HYDRAULIC TEST

- 6.2.1 Each length of the tube shall be hydraulically tested, if specified in the PO, to the pressure indicated.
- 7.0 REPAIR
- 7.1 Repairs involving fusion welding is prohibited.
- 7.2 Wherever defects are rectified by mechanical means, the wall thickness requirements shall be satisfactorily met with, and the surfaces shall be smoothly dressed up without any sharp edges.

8.0 WORKMANSHIP

8.1 The tubes shall be free from mill scales both on the inside and outside and shall present a workman like finish.

9.3 PRESERVATION

- All painted details shall be protected with one coat of 9.3.1 transparent rust preventive.
- 9.3.2 All tubes shall be applied with resin type translucent rust preventive coating on the outside and either with rust preventive coating or rust inhibitor on the inside.
- The ends of the tube shall be closed with end caps, which 9.3.3 should be securely held so that it will not fall off during transit.

9.4 PACKING

All the tubes shall be supplied in bundles, properly 9.4.1 packed in wooden crates to avoid any dent formation and other transit damages to the tubes. The weight of each consignment shall not exceed 2 tons.



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IV **SPARES**:

The tenderer should quote separately for spares that are required for two years trouble free operation. The spares offer should accompany the offer of main equipment, otherwise the quotation will be overlooked.

V VALIDITY:

The offers for main equipment and spares shall be kept open for acceptance for 90 days (ninety days) from the date of opening of the tender.

VI TEST CERTIFICATES, OPERATING AND MAINTENANCE MANUALS:

The tenderer shall clearly mention in their offer, that the Test Certificate and Operating and Maintenance Manuals, etc., as called for in the technical specification, in the required number of copies will be provided at no extra cost. VII TERMS OF PAYMENT:

VIII GENERAL:

- (i) Preference will be given to suitable indigenous or ex-stock imported offers failing which imported offers from incoming consignment against the indigenous supplies "Stock and sale licence" will be accepted. If "stock and sale licence" is not available with the indigenous suppliers, the same shall be indicated in their offer.
- (ii) Bank Guarantee: The supplier in the event of an order, should furnish a Bank Guarantee from an approved Bank at no extra cost in a proforma which will be Supplied to the Supplier, along with the order, for an amount equivalent to 1 0% of the value of the contract. The Bank Guarantee should remain in full force and effect during the period that would be taken for successful completion of the contract and shall continue to be enforceable till 12 months from the date of receipt of consignment at purchaser's site or 18months from the date of last shipment at the Port of Delivery whichever is earlier.

IX LD / PENALTY AND INTEREST ON ADVANCES FOR DELAY IN DELIVERY:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. QUOTATIONS:

- a. Each tender should be sent In double cover, should be sealed and super scribed with correct Tender No., item of supply and due date of opening. The outer cover should only bear the address of this office and should not have any indication that a tender is within. Tow or more quotation should not be sent in one cover but the quotation against each tender should be sent separately to avoid confusion. Tender should not be addressed to any individual's name but only by designation.
- b Tenders should be free from CORRECTION AND ERASURES. Corrections if any, must be attached. All amounts shall be Indicated both in words as well as figures. Where there is difference between amount quoted in words and figures, amount quoted in words shall prevail.
- c Price should be F.O.R. dispatching station inclusive of risk in transit and remain valid for 60 days from. the due date.
- d If any Sales Tax is payable as extra to the quoted price it should be specifically stated in quotation* along with CST & T.N.G.S.T No. failing which the purchaser will not be liable for payment of Sales Tax. Our T.N.G.S.T No. 3550005 Dated 01-04-1995 C.S.T. No. 259383 Dt. 11.06.1991.

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4 TERMS OF PAYMENT:

100% Payment will be made after 45 to 60 days on acceptance of materials. Where required by the purchaser, the successful tenderer must send the operation and maintenance manuals, test certificates, drawings, etc., for tie materials should be sent immediately after dispatch of the materials and a statement to that effect should be made in the Invoice. Failure to comply with this provision will result In delay In payment of the bills. Goods dispatched either by V.P.P. or by thro' document presented through bank will not be accepted unless agreed to by the Purchaser.

The Original Excise Duty Gate Pass or certified extract form Excise Duty Ledger should accompany the material. A Photostat copy of the above gate pass for each delivery challan should be submitted along with the original bills routed through bank or submitted directly to BHEL Department.

5 **SECURITY DEPOSIT**:

For purchase over Rs.5000/- the successful tender/s may be requested to furnish a Bank Guarantee/Security Deposit for an appropriate value as may be determined by BHEL.

6 LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

Therefore, the delivery of the goods specified in the purchase order should be made with in the time prescribed. Where the seller supplies or despathces the goods beyond the delivery period specified the purchaser will have no obligation to accept the goods. If accepted liquidated damages at the rate of ½ % of the value of goods delayed for each week of delay or part thereof will be levied without prejudice to any other relief of compensation due to the purchaser under any other condition of this contract.

7 RISK PURCHASE :

Alternatively the purchaser at his option will be entitled to terminate the contract and to purchase elsewhere at the risk and cost of the seller either the whole of the goods or any part which the supplier has failed to deliver or dispatch within the time stipulated as aforesaid or if the same were not available, the best and the nearest available substitute therefore. The supplier shall be liable for any loss which the purchaser may sustain by reason for such risk purchases in addition to penalty at the rate mentioned in clause 6 above.

8 PREFERENTIAL DELIVERY:

It should be noted if a contract is placed on a higher tender as a result of this invitation to tender in preference to the lowest acceptable offer in consideration of the earlier delivery, the seller will be liable to pay to the purchaser the difference between the contract rate and that of the lowest acceptable tender on the basis of final price F.O.R. destination, including all elements of freights, sales tax, duties and other incidents, incidental in case of failure to complete supplies In terms of such contract within the date of delivery specified In the tender and incorporated in the contract.

9 MODVAT / CREDIT :

If any Excise Duty Is payable, the chapter head/sub-head reference .and the rate of the duty should be quoted. If the tender is availing MODVAT credit for his input materials, the effect of proforma crash should be passed on to the purchased, Tenderer under MODVAT shall be preferred.

10 PURCHASE: Preference will be given to CPSUS as per Government guidelines.

11 GENERAL:

The Purchaser reserves the right to split up the tender and place order for individual items with different tenders and also increase or decrease the quantity.

Any other conditions which might have been quoted by the seller and are in contravention to the terms prescribed in the order and which have not been specifically accepted in by Purchaser will not be applicable to the contract.
