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- 1. If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price.
- 3. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.
- 4. Short Duration Bid has been published by the Buyer with the approval of the Competent authority due to Emergency procurement of critical products/services.
- 5. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:
 - i. If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
 - ii. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.
 - iii. In case Primary product of only one OEM is left in contention for participation in RA on elimination of H-1.
 - iv. If L-1 is non-MSE and H-1 is eligible MSE and H-1 price is coming within price band of 15% of Non-MSE L-1
 - v. If L-1 is non-MII and H-1 is eligible MII and H-1 price is coming within price band of 20% of Non-MII L-1

PRE-QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS

 Average Annual financial turnover during the last 03 years, ending 31st March of the previous financial years (2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23), should be at least Rs. 8.25 Lakhs. In case of Less than three years of fin ancial TO, average of the available years would be calculated over 3 year s period only. **Documents required**: Balance sheet & Profit Loss statement audited by Chartered Accountant.

OR

In case audit of account (P&L Account, Balance Sheet) is not applicable/available then the vendor may submit Turnover Certificate duly certified by Chartered Accountant for the Financial Years i.e. (2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23) as a proof of Financial Soundness.

Any documents submitted certified by Chartered Accountant should have Chartered Accountant's UDIN (as applicable)

- 2. Experience of having successfully executed* similar works** during last 03 years ending last day of month previous to the one in which NIT is invited should be either of the following:
- a. Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to ₹11.00 Lakh each.

OR

b. Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal t o ₹ 13.75 Lakh each.

OR

c. One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to ₹ 22.00 Lakh.

Documents required: Work order/Contract agreement and Work Completion c ertificate/Partial work completion certificate related to executed similar works.

*Executed means the bidder should have achieved this criterion, even if the tot al contract has not been completed or closed. Actual executed value shall be considered, irrespective of completion status of contract (s) under consideration.

- **Similar works means providing commercial passenger vehicles (Van/Bus/Ambulance/Sedan Car/Hatchback Car/SUV/MUV/Motor Cab/Maxi Cab) on Hire/Lease.
- 3. **Start-ups** shall be exempted from the above criteria against sr. no. 1 & 2 with out any relaxation in quality standards or technical parameters as per D.O. No. 5(4)/2016-BE-I dated 15.02.2017. For claiming Start-Up exemption, vendors have to submit DPIIT (Dept. of Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade)/DIPP (Department for Industrial Policy and Promotion) recognition certificates

BHEL reserves the right to verify the documents submitted by the contractor.

In case the Tenderers not fulfilling the above conditions, the offer is liable for rejection. The semi filled, incomplete Tender Documents will be rejected

SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. **Evaluation Criteria:** L1 party shall be decided by considering overall Lowest cost t o BHEL for Monthly 1500Kms of running in quoted "Monthly charges" for Ambulance with Driver and fuel.

Overall cost for the entire contract period shall be arrived as per below formula:

No. of Ambulance (1 number) x No. of months (36 months) x Monthly Charges inclusive of taxes

Monthly charges to be quoted by supplier.

BHEL will divide quoted rates into Two parts for payment purpose as below:

1((i) Monthly Cost of fuel for running of ambulance for 1500kms/month shall be calculated bas ed on mileage provided by the supplier as per attached format in ATC and the Rate of Petro I at Goindwal on the date of Opening of Tender.

Note: The payment of monthly fuel cost will be made at the Average of Fuel rate on 1st, 1 5th and last date of the billing Month at Goindwal, for the actual KM run during the month, as per payment terms clause 9 (a)

2((ii) Monthly Vehicle/Ambulance rent including driver cost (Basic amount) will be arrived at by deducting monthly fuel cost (as calculated above) from monthly charges quoted by supplie r.

Quoted Mileage should be in the range 12km/litre – 18km/litre. Mileage quoted beyond this range would make the bid liable for rejection.

2. **Acceptance of Ambulance:** BHEL shall have the right to Accept/reject the Make & Model of the Ambulance provided by the bidder(s).

Ambulance to be provided should be registered in the name of proprietor / partner/ firm only.

3. **Documentation regarding Ambulance:** Registration, Comprehensive Insurance and other relevant documents required for running the Ambulance sho

uld bear name of proprietor / partner / firm only. Provided Ambulance must h ave Commercial/Transport registration.

Vendor shall submit Registration Certificate, Insurance and Purchase Invoice of the Ambulance.

- **4. Delivery:** The Contractor/Service Provider shall ensure safe delivery of Amb ulance (as per requirement) mentioned in 'Award of Work' with complete doc uments as per Motor vehicle Act **within 15 Days of Award of Contract**. The use of the Ambulance by the BHEL shall not be interfered in any manner wh atsoever by the Vendor or any person claiming directly or indirectly to be the Vendor.
- **5. Driver & Fuel:** Driver(s) and Fuel shall be provided by contractor/ Service P rovider for operating the Ambulance on 24x7 Basis. Ambulance shall be in po ssession of BHEL 24x7 (including Sundays & Holidays) during hiring period. T he responsibility of keeping the Vehicles in good running condition shall be contractor/ Service Provider. All expenditures during journey pertaining to drive r(s) like driver's meal/lodging, etc. shall be in scope of contractor.
- **6. Driver:** The service Provider shall provide driver(s) having valid driving licen ce, adequate knowledge of reading, writing and spoken Hindi. Driver should be properly Dressed and should have knowledge of different routes. The Driver s deputed for duty should be polite and must possess positive attitude in disc harging their duty. The Reporting time, place, address etc. should be strictly f ollowed by Service provider through driving staff. The service provider must a lso provide mobile phone to the drivers of the Ambulance sent for duty and in timate the same along with mobile no. to BHEL.
 - **Uniform:** Drivers should be well / neatly dressed in Shirt/ Paint with Shoe s.
 - Conduct: Drivers should be polite and well behaved. Chewing of tobacco, smoking and drinking while on duty is prohibited and shall be treated as m isconduct.
 - Police Verification: Service provider must maintain a valid police verific ation of the driver(s), being deputed for service (s) under contract period.
- 7. Replacement of Tyres, Tubes and Battery: Replacement of Tyres, Tube s and Battery at periodical intervals during the Contract period shall be the re sponsibility of Contractor/service provider. Tyres shall be replaced whenever r equired /when treads are worn out below "Tyre Wear Indicator (TWI)" and tub es shall be replaced when punctures are more than three. Tyre should be CEA T/MRF/Apollo/Michelin/Goodyear/JK Tyres/Bridgestone/Continental make only. Battery shall be replaced whenever required during the contract period.
- **8.** All problems related to Maintenance & repair / replacement shall be solved by the Contractor / service provider immediately. However, if he does not respond to rectify the reported Problem, BHEL has reserve the right to rectify the

same and expenditures incurred in the repair / maintenance / spare replacem ent of the hired Ambulance shall be deducted from the running monthly hiring bills of the Contractor/service provider.

9. Payment Terms:

- a. Tentative Monthly running of the Ambulance has been finalized for 1500 kms. (Local & Outstation duties) however actual usage may be more or le ss depending on the requirement. Payment shall be made to the vendor f or basic per month amount (including driver) and actual kms run during th e month at the quoted mileage. For this purpose average fuel rate shall b e considered i.e. Average of Fuel rate on 1st, 15th and last date of Month a t Goindwal.
- i. Ambulance is required for 24x7 including Sundays & Holidays. (Local & O utstation movement).
- ii. Permit, Road Tax, Challan, Toll tax, Interstate Tax etc. are the responsibilit y of the Contractor / Service provider and will be borne by the Contractor / Service provider. However, Toll Tax, Parking & Interstate tax shall be the r eimbursed by BHEL on submission of receipt along with Invoice.
- iii. BHEL shall pay monthly hiring charges, including taxes as applicable. The payment will be made on monthly basis after receipt of the bill in duplicate and verification by Departmental Representative for satisfactory execution of work. BHEL will release the payment from the date of receipt of bill, complete in all respects with all relevant documents, as given below: -

- iv. No advance money will be paid under any circumstances. Also, no interest shall be paid due to delay in making the payment.
- v. All expenditures during duty (Local / Outstation) referred to drivers like driver's meal/lodging, etc. shall be in scope of Service provider.
- vi. GST shall be reimbursed as per actual after shown/available on GST Portal
- vii.Contractor to ensure compliance of GST Law and rules applicable on supply involved in this tender and in the event of any non-compliance by Contractor, implication of the same if any shall be on account of contractor.

viii. **Tax Deduction at source**: Tax shall be deducted at source from runnin g bill as applicable income tax rule & other statutory requirements.

10. Repair and Maintenance

i. Servicing, Maintenance & Repairing:

- a. All Servicing, running maintenance /minor repairing including Replac ement of Tyres, Tubes and Battery (other than major accident) will be rectified immediately within 01 days by the Contractor/service provid er at their sole risk, responsibility and cost. Ambulance shall be return ed back after servicing/repair works within a maximum period of 01 d ays.
- b. **Major repairing:** In case of major repair (accidental damage/engine overhaul etc.), the repair period shall be not more than 10 days. Repairing against major accidental damage engine overhaul etc. shall be done by the Contractor/service provider at the cost and risk of the Contractor/service provider. Alternate similar vehicle should be provided by the contractor in case of absence of ambulance for more than One day for Major repairing else penalty provisions shall apply.
- Settling claims with insurance company will be the sole responsibility
 of Contractor/service provider and BHEL will have no liability in this re
 gard.
- **ii.** Ambulance should have valid RC, Insurance, PUC, Fitness Certificate , Permit / Road Tax (if applicable). In case any of these documents are n ot valid / expired then payment shall be deducted at double rate of the d aily payment rate calculated on pro-rata basis from running bill.
- **11. Liabilities:** Liability that may arrives on account of certain events / conditions on BHEL:
 - i. **Liability on theft or total loss of Vehicles:** In the event of contract ed Ambulance being stolen or damaged beyond repair, the service pert aining to that Ambulance shall be considered automatically terminated. The responsibility for insurance claim from the Insurance Company for s uch thefts / total loss will be of the Contractor / Service Provider. BHEL s hall not pay deficit (if any this regard).
 - In the event of Ambulance being stolen or damaged beyond repair, BHE L shall require Ambulance in replacement. Ambulance to be provided in replacement must comply all specification as per Tender along with bel ow mentioned points:
 - a. Registration date of the Ambulance to be provided in replacement sh all not be earlier than that of registration date of Stolen/damaged Am bulance.

- b. Odometer reading of the Ambulance to be provided in replacement s hall not be more than that of Stolen/damaged Ambulance.
- ii. **Liability on account of third-party claims**: Handling of all legal lia bilities / claims arising out of third-party claims shall be responsibility of Contractor / Insurance Company.
- 12. Log Book: The Service Provider shall maintain the Log-Book as provided by BHEL. The Log-Book should be got signed by the Driver as well as by the Concerned BHEL Executive (to be assigned by BHEL for the purpose) at the end of each journey daily which would indicate the details such as opening and the closing meter reading, point of starting / ending of journey, route d etails, date & time of reporting.
- **13. Contract Period:** The Contract Agreement will be valid for a period of 36 months. The same may however be extended with mutual agreement, in w riting, on the same Terms and Conditions.
- 14. Foreclosure / Termination: The BHEL reserves the right to terminate the contract any time prior to the expiry of hiring period at its sole discretion. In the event of foreclosure/ termination of the contract in respect of vehicle s, BHEL may, without prejudice to any other right to remedy which shall have accrued or shall accrue thereafter to BHEL, to terminate the contract by giving 01 months' notice in writing. The notice will be deemed to have been served as and when sent to the postal /e-mail address given in the tender.
- **15.** Activities on Expiry / Termination / Cessation of Hiring Period: Aft er the Expiry/Termination / Cessation of hiring period, BHEL shall return to Contractor the following:
 - i. The hired Ambulance.
 - ii. **Documents** Relevant documents with respect to the ambulance , including Registration certificate in original and the original insurance policy.
 - iii. **Payments**: BHEL shall stop paying monthly hiring rentals for that particular Ambulance from the date of the termination of the contract.
- **16. Governing Law and Jurisdiction:** In case of any dispute and difference s, Tarn Taran, Punjab, Court shall have only and exclusive Jurisdiction to adjudicate upon.
- 17. Arbitration: Arbitrator of Contractor & BHEL shall appoint the third Arbitr ator for all disputes, differences, claims and questions whatsoever arising o ut of this Agreement and the proceedings shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 or an y statutory modification thereof. The venue of the arbitration, if any, shall be Goindwal, Punjab.

- **18.** BHEL reserves the right to reject or cancel the offers without assigning an y reason(s) whatsoever.
- **19.** BHEL reserves the right to verify the correctness of any of the document li ke Ambulance Registration / fitness / Insurance, etc. submitted by the servi ce provider.
- **20.** BHEL shall is no way be responsible for any liability arising due to non-co mpliance of statutory requirement/ regulations w.r.t. the Ambulance as well as the Driver(s).
- **21.** In case, the Contractor / Service provider is constrained to replace driver, prior permission should be taken from Auto-Pool as well as inform to Main Hospital about the change.
- 22. Contractor / Service provider shall be solely responsible for payment of w ages/ salaries and other allowances to his personal that might become app licable under any act of order of Govt. from time to time during the validity of contract. BHEL shall have no liability whatsoever on this account (i.e. sta tutory compliance with regard to Ambulance and also the driver deployed i ncluding the wages, allowance and other charges etc. of the drivers deploy ed). Contractor to furnish declaration regarding compliance of all statutory obligations alongwith monthly bill.
- **23.** Contractor / Service provider shall not appoint any sub-service provider/ s ub-agency to carry out any obligation under the contract.
- **24.** Contractor / Service provider must provide contact number (at least 02 N os.) & at least 01 E-mail Id of himself or his representatives / employees, w ho shall provide/monitor the service/ backup arrangement and attend any c omplain or information regarding the contract/ service all days 24x7. BHEL will not bear any hindrance due to any third party/ person.
- **25.** BHEL reserves the right to reject any or all bids at any stage of tendering process without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- **26. Deviation**: The Service provider must comply with the tender specificatio n and all terms and conditions of contract. No deviation shall normally be entertained.

27. Penalities: Penalties for non compliance shall be as per GeM SLA

RISK PURCHASE

Risk & Cost Clause, in line with Conditions of PO may be invoked in any of the following cases:

- i) Supplier's poor progress of the supply vis-à-vis delivery/execution timeline as stipulated in the Contract, backlog attributable to supplier including unexecuted portion of supply that does not appear to be executable within balance available period
- ii) Withdrawal from or abandonment of the supply by contractor before completion as per contra
- iii) Non-supply by the Supplier within scheduled completion/delivery period as per Contract or as extended from time to time, for the reasons attributable to the supplier.
- iv) Termination of Contract on account of any other reason (s) attributable to Supplier.
- v) Assignment, transfer, subletting of Contract without BHEL's written permission resulting in te rmination of Contract or part thereof by BHEL.
- vi) Non-compliance to any contractual condition or any other default attributable to Supplier.

The value under Risk purchase clause shall be calculated as follows:

Risk & Cost Amount = $[(A-B) + (A \times H/100)]$

Where, A= Value of Balance scope of Work/ Supply (*) as per rates of new contract B= Value of Balance scope of Work/ Supply (*) as per rates of old contract being paid to the contractor/ supplier at the time of termination of contract i.e. inclusive of PVC & ORC, if any.

H = Overhead Factor shall be taken as 5

In case (A-B) is less than 0 (zero), value of (A-B) shall be taken as 0 (zero).

*(Balance scope of work/ supply) Difference of Tendered/Contract Quantities and Executed Quantities as on the date of issue of Letter for 'Termination of PO/Contract', shall be taken as balance scope of Supply for calculating risk & cost amount.

Contract quantities are the quantities as per original contract. If, Contract has been amended, quantities as per amended Contract shall be consider ed as Contract Quantities.
