2. **PAYMENT TERM:** 80% payment of PO value shall be made within 45 days for MSE, 60 days for Mechanical Enterprises and 90 days for Non-MSE from the date of receipt of material at BHEL. Balance 20% of PO value will be paid against acceptance by end user of BHEL (As per point no-3 of Scope of Supply for this order) and submission of Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) valid for **13 months** (from date of final acceptance by BHEL) by Supplier from any of the Consortium Banks of BHEL for 10% of total PO Value in prescribed Format. The PBG confirmation charges shall be borne by vendor.

3. **Bank Guarantee and Loading against non-acceptance of BHEL's Payment Terms:**
