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1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which

no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. 2. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

3. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:

- i. If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
- ii. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.
- iii. In case Primary product of only one OEM is left in contention for participation in RA on elimination of H-1.
- iv. If L-1 is non-MSE and H-1 is eligible MSE and H-1 price is coming within price band of 15% of Non-MSE L-1

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

**2. Generic**

Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:

- Copy of PAN Card.
- Copy of GSTIN.
- Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
- Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.

**3. Generic**

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

**4. Scope of Supply**

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Only supply of Goods

**5. Purchase Preference (Centre)**

Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for percentage of 25% of total value.

**6. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC**

1. Material shall be supplied as per attached specification as per Specification FF05039Rev 02.
2. Prices to be quoted on F.O.R. CFFP BHEL Haridwar basis.
3. Delivery period shall be as per GeM bid (On intimation basis).
4. Quantity tolerance will be  $\pm 5$  % of tendered quantity.
5. All the charges (Freight, insurance, cylinder charges, GST etc.) are inclusive in the quoted rate.
6. Ordered quantity is valid for 2 years of supply from contract date.
7. Intimation of Argon cylinders will be given approximately on Weekly basis.
8. Requirement of Argon gas per intimation shall be approx. 420 - 490 CuM / 60-70 filled Cylinders.
9. Argon cylinders are required to be delivered at CFFP within 2-3 days from date of intimation.
10. However, BHEL reserves the right to call any no. of cylinders with mutual agreement.
11. Vendor has to keep stock of minimum 150 cylinders at CFFP, separate rent will not be paid for cylinder s. Maximum holding time for these cylinder is 6 months.
12. Oxygen and moisture shall be max. 2.00 ppm.
13. Argon Purity in the supply should be of UHP Grade-1 i.e. 99.999% purity.
14. Delivery Gas Pressure in supplied cylinder should be 135-150 Kg/cm<sup>2</sup>

**15. Payment terms:** Payment shall be made through e-payment, subject to acceptance of material and s ubmission of the required documents, complete in all respects, as per following details:

**16. Breach of contract, Remedies and Termination:** In case of breach of contract, recovery of 10% of total contract value shall be applicable. Recovery shall be done by encashing security instruments like Co ntract Execution Bank Guarantee, performance bank guarantee, EMD. In case value of security instrument s available is less than 10% of the contract value, the balance amount be recovered from other financial re medies (i.e. available bills of the contractor, retention amount, etc. with BHEL) or legal remedies shall be p ursued. Further, levy of liquidated damages, debarment, termination, de-scoping, short-closure, etc., shall be applied as per provisions of the contract.

17. PO delivery date is tentative in nature. However, Argon gas shall be delivered for the part quantity as a nd when requirement basis.

18. Cylinder repair & maintenance to be done by supplier. No separate cost will be paid by BHEL Haridwar. In case, any defective cylinder if fund in supply, it will not be considered for material clearance.

19. Vendor has to ensure to provide safety caps /protection for cylinder valves.

20. The enquiry quantity is subjected to part delivery on as and when requirement basis. Thus there may b e 5 / 7 multiple lot of supply to complete enquiry/PO quantity.

21. All cylinders are required to be examined and tested periodically as per the Govt. rules, responsibility for compliance with these tests will be on the seller, who will carry out test as may be required.

**22. Conflict of Interest:** A bidder shall not have conflict of interest with other bidders. Such conflict of interest can lead to anti-competitive practices to the detriment of Procuring Entity's interests. The bidder found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. A bidder may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:

- a) They have controlling partner (s) in common; or
- b) They received or have received any Direct or indirect subsidy/financial stake from any of them; or
- c) They have the same legal representative/agent for purposes of this bid; or
- d) They have relationship with each other, directly or through common third parties, that puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the bid of another bidder; or
- e) Bidder participates in more than one bid in this bidding process. Participation by a Bidder in more than one Bid will result in the disqualification of all bids in which the parties are involved. However, this does not limit the inclusion of the components/sub-assembly/Assemblies from one bidding manufacturer in more than one bid; or
- f) In cases of agents quoting in offshore procurements, on behalf of their principal manufacturers, one agent cannot represent two manufacturers or quote on their behalf in a particular tender enquiry. One manufacturer can also authorise only one agent/dealer. There can be only one bid form the following:
  - 1. The principal manufacturer directly or through one Indian agent on his behalf; and
  - 2. Indian/foreign agent on behalf of only one principal;or
- g) A Bidder or any of its affiliates participated as a consultant in the preparation of the design or technical specifications of the contract that is the subject of the Bid; or
- h) In case of a holding company having more than one independently manufacturing units, or more than one unit having common business ownership/management, only one unit should quote. Similar restrictions would apply to closely related sister companies. Bidders must proactively declare such sister/common business/management units in same/similar line of business.

24. The offers of the **bidders who are under suspension** as also the offers of the bidders, who engage the services of the firms debarred across BHEL, shall be rejected. The list of firms debarred across BHEL is available on BHEL website: [www.bhel.com](http://www.bhel.com).

9.0 Integrity commitment, performance of contract and punitive action thereof:

9.1 Commitment by BHEL:

BHEL commits to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption in connection with the tender process and execution of the contract. BHEL will during the tender process treat all bidder(s) in a transparent and fair manner, and with equity.

**9.2 Commitment by Bidder/Supplier/Contractor:**

- a. The Bidder/Supplier/Contractor commit to take all measures to prevent corruption and will not directly or indirectly influence any decision or benefit which he is not legally entitled to nor will act or omit in any manner which tantamount to an offence punishable under any provision of the Indian penal code, 1860 or any other law in force in India.
- b. The Bidder/Supplier/Contractor will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, and is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract and shall adhere to relevant guidelines issued from time to time by Govt. of India/BHEL.
