1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore): Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are

not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .The buyers are advised to refer the OM No.F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023.

- 2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY. - 3. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:
 - i. If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
 - ii. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.
 - iii. In case Primary product of only one OEM is left in contention for participation in RA on elimination of H-1.
 - iv. If L-1 is non-MSE and H-1 is eligible MSE and H-1 price is coming within price band of 15% of Non-MSE L-1
 - v. If L-1 is non-MII and H-1 is eligible MII and H-1 price is coming within price band of 20% of Non-MII L-1

Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions/क्रेता द्वारा जोड़ी गई बिड की विशेष शर्तें

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Generic

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

3. Generic

Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:

- a. Copy of PAN Card.
- b. Copy of GSTIN.
- c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
- d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.

4. Generic

Supplier shall ensure that the Invoice is raised in the name of Consignee with GSTIN of Consignee only.

5. Generic

Without prejudice to Buyer's right to price adjustment by way of discount or any other right or remedy

available to Buyer, Buyer may terminate the Contract or any part thereof by a written notice to the Seller, if:

- i) The Seller fails to comply with any material term of the Contract.
- ii) The Seller informs Buyer of its inability to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period or such inability otherwise becomes apparent.
- iii) The Seller fails to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period and/or to replace/rectify any rejected or defective Material(s) promptly.
- iv) The Seller becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation.
- v) The Seller makes a general assignment for the benefit of creditors.
- vi) A receiver is appointed for any substantial property owned by the Seller.
- vii) The Seller has misrepresented to Buyer, acting on which misrepresentation Buyer has placed the Purchase Order on the Seller.

6. Generic

While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the screenshot of GST portal confirming payment of GST.

7. Scope of Supply

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components): Only supply of Goods

8. Inspection

Nominated Inspection Agency: On behalf of the Buyer organization, any one of the following Inspection Agency would be conducting inspection of stores before acceptance: Pre-dispatch Inspection at Seller Premises (applicable only if pre-dispatch inspection clause has been selected in ATC):

9. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

10. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

1. PRE-QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT:

The participated vendor must have supplied minimum $[1/5^{th}]$ of Tender Enquiry quantity $[1/5^{th}]$ of same/ $[1/5^{th}]$ of Tender Enquiry quantity $[1/5^{th}]$ of Tender E

As a supporting document to Point (A) following has to be provided:

- i. Proof of Order: copy of Purchase Orders/Purchase Agreements etc.
- ii. Proof of Supply: Copy of Invoice/ BL Copy/ any other document to confir m supply of material against above Purchase Order.
- iii. Proof of Quality: Copy of Test Certificate/ Specification etc (Required if, purity/ chemical composition is not mentioned on Purchase Order/ Invoice copy etc)
- Original Manufacturer's Test certificate is required along with dispatches.

Participating traders are required to mention name of Manufacturer, from which they intend to supply the

material, along with Techno-commercial Bid. This will be considered as one of the criteria for qualification o f offer of Traders. Traders are bound to supply the item along with Original Manufacturer's Test Certificate from the same Manufacturer, which they have mentioned at the time of submission of Technical Bid. This will be one of the criteria for acceptance of material at CFFP

- Guarantee certificate is required.
- Third party inspection is applicable. Final inspection at CFFP BHEL Haridwar
- PAYMENT TERMS: 100% payment will be made to the seller within 45/60/90 days (as per below menti oned table) after receipt; subject to acceptance of material at CFFP / BHEL, Haridwar through e-payment by the Buyer.

Participating MSME bidders which are already registered with CFFP BHEL, need to ensure that their latest MSME status is updated with CFFP for getting above payment preference. Also, MSME bidders not register ed with CFFP should provide copy of "previous financial year's audited balance sheet and P&L statement" along with UDYAM certificate for availing above mentioned payment preference.

- 5. Permissible quantity variation: +/-5%
- 7. Early delivery is acceptable for First Lot.
 - RISK PURCHASE: In case of abnormal delays (beyond the maximum late delivery period as per LD cla use) in supplies / defective supplies or non-fulfilment of any other terms and conditions given in Purchase Order, BHEL may cancel the Purchase Order in full or part thereof, and may also make the purchase of suc h material from elsewhere / alternative source at the risk and cost of the supplier. BHEL will take all reason able steps to get the material from alternate source at optimum cost. If bidder does not agree to the abov e Risk Purchase Clause, BHEL reserves the right to reject the offer. In case for compelling reasons BHEL ac cepts the offer without acceptance of this clause by the bidder and in the eventuality of Risk Purchase, app ropriate action will be taken as per BHEL extant rules. This will be without prejudice to any other right of B HEL under the contract or under General Law.
 - 8. The scope of third party inspection shall be as under:
 - A. The inspection is to be carried out as per the ordered specification ensuring original manuf acturer's packing, Original manufacturer test certificates etc. as per specification and the linkage
 - B. The material should be identified as per the specification like original manufacturer's name

- , Batch/lot no, Net weight, material name. The material should be packed as per specificati on and sealed by the inspection agency. The seal details should be mentioned in the third party inspection report.
- C. The test certificate should contain the complete witnessing of the chemical analysis of mat erial as per IS1472 for nos. of test required in a lot and their testing methodology for evalu ating nos. of element required by the material specification, size verification as per P.O. Sp ecification, purchase order no, Batch/lot no of material, seal details of the inspector along with corresponding packing (packing list).
- The material shall be packed such as to prevent loss/deterioration in quality during handling, transport and storage. It should be in manufacturer's packing. Each package should be marked with the following details: name of the material, Manufacturer's Name/ Trademark & Net Weight.
 - 10. Conflict of Interest: A bidder shall not have conflict of interest with other bidders. Such conflict of in terest can lead to anti-competitive practices to the detriment of Procuring Entity's interests. The bidder found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. A bidder may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:
 - a) They have controlling partner (s) in common; or
 - b) They received or have received any direct or indirect subsidy/financial stake from any of them; or
 - c) They have the same legal representative/agent for purposes of this bid; or
 - d) They have relationship with each other, directly or through common third parties, tha t puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the bid of ano ther bidder: or
 - e) Bidder participates in more than one bid in this bidding process. Participation by a Bi dder in more than one Bid will result in the disqualification of all bids in which the parties a re involved. However, this does not limit the inclusion of the components/sub-assembly/Assemblies from one bidding manufacturer in more than one bid; or
 - f) In cases of agents quoting in offshore procurements, on behalf of their principal man ufacturers, one agent cannot represent two manufacturers or quote on their behalf in a particular tender enquiry. One manufacturer can also authorise only one agent/dealer. There can be only one bid form the following:
 - The principal manufacturer directly or through one Indian agent on his behalf;
 and
 - Indian/foreign agent on behalf of only one principal;

or

- g) A Bidder or any of its affiliates participated as a consultant in the preparation of the d esign or technical specifications of the contract that is the subject of the Bid; or
- h) In case of a holding company having more than one independently manufacturing uni ts, or more than one unit having common business ownership/management, only one unit should quote. Similar restrictions would apply to closely related sister companies. Bidders must proactively declare such sister/common business/management units in same/similar line of business.

11. Generic

- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
