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1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

3. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all without any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. Further, if bid(s) of any seller(s) eligible for MSE preference is / are coming within price band of 15% of Non MSE L-1 or if bid of any seller(s) eligible for Make in India preference is / are coming within price band of 20% of non MII L-1, then such MSE / Make in India seller shall also be allowed to participate in the RA process.

## Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions

### 1. Generic

After award of contract - Successful Bidder shall have to get Detailed Design Drawings approved from buyer before starting fabrication. Successful Bidder shall submit Detailed Design Drawings for Buyer's approval, within 15 days of award of contract. Buyer shall, either approve the drawings or will provide complete list of modification required in the drawings within 5 days. Seller shall be required to ensure supply as per approved Drawings with modifications as communicated by Buyer. If there is delay from buyer side in approval of drawing- the delivery period shall be refixed without LD for the period of delay in approval of Drawing.

### 2. Generic

**Bidder financial standing:** The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.

### 3. Generic

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

### 4. Generic

Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:

- a. Copy of PAN Card.
- b. Copy of GSTIN.
- c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
- d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.

5. **Generic**

Data Sheet of the product(s) offered in the bid, are to be uploaded along with the bid documents. Buyers can match and verify the Data Sheet with the product specifications offered. In case of any unexplained mismatch of technical parameters, the bid is liable for rejection.

6. **Generic**

Installation, Commissioning, Testing, Configuration, Training (if any - which ever is applicable as per scope of supply) is to be carried out by OEM / OEM Certified resource or OEM authorised Reseller.

7. **Inspection**

**Nominated Inspection Agency:** On behalf of the Buyer organization, any one of the following Inspection Agency would be conducting inspection of stores before acceptance:

Pre-dispatch Inspection at Seller Premises (applicable only if pre-dispatch inspection clause has been selected in ATC): **VENDOR WORKS**

**BUYER ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. **Vendor offers will be considered for price bid opening subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions**
  - I. **PQR requirement**
  - II. **Techno-commercial suitability**
2. **Deviation:** Vendor to indicate deviations (if any) in the Sub Delivery Enquiry Deviation Format only.
3. **Document Submission along with the offer:** Bidder to submit the complete documents as per tender requirement along with their offer submission. All the technical documents which have been attached along with our enquiry i.e Specification, Drgs, QP, Packing Procedure, Data Sheet etc, signature to be endorsed on all pages with company seal. Any query (Technical/Commercial) during evaluation stage, shall be replied within 2 days from BHEL email date and all clarification will be initiated through email only. If the vendor fails to respond, even after 3 reminders, then the vendor will be considered as non-responsive and their offer shall be liable for rejection.
4. **Document Submission after PO: Not Applicable. Vendor shall follow BHEL drawing & Quality Plan.**
5. **The L 1 bidder who has received the PO for the tendered items shall not split the total quantity while offering for inspection until unless specified instructions issued by BHEL.**
6. **Inspection & testing requirements:** Inspection and testing requirements are to be carried out as per the specification and BHEL/customer approved QAP; all test certificates are to be submitted in complete set as indicated in our specification /QAP. In case of Vendor QP the same shall be submitted for approval along with the offer.

## 7. Inspection notice period:

**For Third Party Inspection**, Vendor shall raise inspection call to at least **one working day** prior to the proposed date of inspection at vendor works.

**For Joint Inspection**, Vendor shall raise inspection call to **at least 15 working day**, prior to the proposed date of inspection at vendor works.

Dispatch instructions will be provided on receipt of clear inspection report. No material should be dispatched without our dispatch clearance. Vendor shall dispatch the consignment immediately after getting dispatch clearance from BHEL.

8. **Self-certification:** In line with Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 issued by DPIIT, vendor to submit Self-certification in Letterhead indicating the percentage of Local content as per given format.
9. **MSE :** Vendor to submit UDYAM Registration copy to validate MSE status.

## 10. RISK PURCHASE:

If the supplier fails to deliver the goods within the delivery period specified in the Purchase Order, BHEL will be entitled to terminate the contract and to Purchase elsewhere at the risk and cost of the seller either the whole of the goods or any part which the supplier has failed to deliver or despatch within the delivery period mentioned in the Purchase Order. "Such Risk Purchase clause shall be operated as per the extant BHEL procedures"

Risk and Cost against Balance Work:

Risk & Cost Amount= [(A-B) + (A x H/100)]

Where,

A= Value of Balance scope of Work/ Supply (\*) as per rates of new contract

B= Value of Balance scope of Work/ Supply (\*) as per rates of old contract being paid to the contractor/ supplier at the time of termination of contract i.e. inclusive of PVC & ORC, if any.

H = Overhead Factor to be taken as 5

In case (A-B) is less than 0 (zero), value of (A-B) shall be taken as 0 (zero).

\*(Balance scope of work/ supply)

Difference of Contract Quantities and Executed Quantities as on the date of issue of Letter for

'Termination of Contract', shall be taken as balance scope of Work/ Supply for calculating risk & cost amount.

Contract quantities are the quantities as per original contract. If, Contract has been amended, quantities as per amended Contract shall be considered as Contract Quantities.

Items for which total quantities to be executed have exceeded the Contract Quantities based on drawings

issued to contractor from time to time till issue of Termination letter, then for these items total Quantities as per issued drawings would be deemed to be contract quantities.

Substitute/ extra items whose rates have already been approved would form part of contract quantities for this purpose. Substitute/ extra items which have been executed but rates have not been approved, would also form part of contract quantities for this purpose and rates of such items shall be determined in line with contractual provisions.

However, increase in quantities on account of additional scope in new tender shall not be considered for this purpose.

NOTE: In case portion of work is being withdrawn, contract quantities pertaining to portion of work withdrawn shall be considered as 'Balance scope of work/supply' for calculating Risk & Cost amount.

11. The Bidder declares that they will not enter into any illegal or undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal with other Bidder(s). This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process. In case, the Bidder is found having indulged in above activities, suitable action shall be taken by BHEL as per extant policies/ guidelines.
12. **SECURITY OF CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION:** The Contractor undertakes and agrees that he/it will

not disclose or reveal in part or full the proprietary/confidential information, which terms shall mean and include patents, trademarks, service marks, registered designs, copyright, design rights, know-how, confidential information, trade and business names and any other similar protected information of BHEL received during negotiation or currency of the contract to any third party or governmental authorities without written permission from BHEL. In the event of termination or expiry of the contract, the contractor shall return all proprietary/confidential information to BHEL. This clause shall survive termination or expiry of the contract.

All the input details: transmittals and sample drawings supplied for preparation of drawings are confidential information of BHEL for specific purpose only. The contractor shall never pass on / part with the information to anybody and shall maintain the secrecy of the information. As soon as the bills are certified by BHEL, all the relevant drawing files shall be erased from PCs and shall not be made use under any circumstances.

BHEL reserves the right to initiate appropriate action including legal proceeds / termination of contract, recovery of damages, penalties etc., if the contractor is found guilty / wrong usage of the documents given by BHEL for any unauthorised activity.

13. By participating in this bid on GeM, Seller undertakes that presently it is not “Debarred/in hold/Banned from Bidding” on the grounds mentioned in <https://www.bhel.com/guidelines-suspension-business-dealings-supplierscontractors>.

**14. Special Instructions for Despatch of Material from Vendor works (applicable for delivery location to project sites only):**

- a. *After material readiness and inspection completion (by TPI/ BHEL/ End Customer), vendor shall seek dispatch clearance from BHEL.*
- b. *After obtaining dispatch clearance from BHEL, vendor shall proceed to generate dispatch documents. After generating dispatch documents (Invoice, LR, E-waybill etc.) vendor shall immediately share these documents to BHEL (scan copy over email) for accounting the materials and securing insurance coverage.*
- c. *After accounting, BHEL would be issuing movement clearance to vendor immediately. Only after movement clearance is received from BHEL, actual/physical movement of goods out of vendor’s premises shall commence.*
- d. *Non-adherence to the above may lead to GST authorities seizing the vehicle & goods and imposing penalty & interest. Any such implication would be to vendors account only.*
- e. *Provision of GST Act highlighted below in connection to this - Pursuant to Sec 31 of CGST Act 2017, a tax invoice has to be raised by the registered person supplying taxable goods before or at the time of removal of goods for supply to the recipient, where the supply involves movement of goods. Where a taxable person supplies any goods without issue of any invoice, the tax authorities has powers to detain the consignment and impose penalties equivalent to 200% of the tax payable as per Section 129 of CGST Act 2017.”*
