1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore): Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchasi preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local conte shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountar a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. - 2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry o Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bic wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid fo supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No.F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent applica of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Mak India) Order, 2017.
- 3. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid

participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which wo be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices receiv in Bid / RA process.

- 4. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder the technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:
  - i. If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
  - ii. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.
  - iii. In case Primary product of only one OEM is left in contention for participation in RA on elimination of H-1.

"A bidder shall not have conflict of interest with other bidders.
