All or any such disputes or differences arising between the parties to this contract hall be referred to an Arbitral Tribunal consisting of single arbitrators. Sole arbitrat shall be appointed on mutually agreed by both the parties.

The place of arbitration shall be New Delhi for foreign vendors. The language of ar tration shall be English. The substantive law applicable to the substance of the distensive the law. GISTC clause may be referred for this clause.

For Indigenous Source. The venue of arbitration shall be Haridwar Courts, which w have exclusive jurisdiction.

18. <u>Conciliation Clause</u>: Model conciliation clause for conduction conciliation proceedings under the BHEL conciliation scheme, 2018 will be applicable against this enquy.

## 19. Arbitration Clause:

In case of any dispute arising out of or in connection with this contract, the same all be referred to arbitration under Arbitration & Conciliation Act 1996 of a sole ark rator who shall be appointed by mutual consent of the parties. The seat & venue of arbitration shall be Haridwar. The proceedings shall be conducted in English. The of verning law of the contract shall be the substantive Law of India.

## 20. Breach of contract, Remedies and Termination

In case of breach of contract, recovery of 10% of total contract value shall be pplicable. Recovery shall be done by encashing security instruments like C ntract Execution Bank Guarantee, performance bank guarantee, EMD. In case value of security instruments available is less than 10% of the contract value, he balance amount be recovered from other financial remedies (i.e. available ills of the contractor, retention amount, etc. with BHEL) or legal remedies sha be pursued. Further, levy of liquidated damages, debarment, termination, decoping, short-closure, etc., shall be applied as per provisions of the contract.

## 21. Force Majeure Clause

a. Either party shall be entitled to suspend performance of his obligations under the contract to the entitled to suspend performance of his obligations under the contract to the entitle that such performance is impeded or made unreasonably onerous by any of the following circumst ces: fire, war, flood, riots, earthquake etc.

- b. The party claiming to be affected by force majeure shall notify the other party in writing immediate without delay on the intervention and on the cessation of such circumstances.
