If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be relaxed from the the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking Relaxation from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for Relaxation.

2. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. 1. **Payment term:**

80% payment of Supply value will be made within the stipulated days as mentioned below from the date of receipt of material with clear documents at BHEL R&D, Hyderabad.

Balance 20% of Supply Value plus 100% of Installation and Commissioning (ICT Charges) portion of PO value will be paid against ICT Certificate issued by BHEL and Submission of Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) by Supplier.

GST will be reimbursed against submission of proof of payment of GST to govt. of India.

Type of bidder:

- A. For Micro & Small enterprises (MSEs) payment will be made within 45 days
- B. For Medium Enterprises will be made within 60 days
- C. Non MSMEs will be made within 90 days

However, GST Portion of Invoice shall be released only upon:

b) Relaxation of Norms for Startups:

The condition of Prior Turnover and prior experience is relaxed for all startups whether Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) or otherwise subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications in accordance with the relevant provision of GFR,2005 and other DOE-PPD notifications for relaxation norms for startups issued from time to time.

8. **Terms of Delivery:** Shall be Free On Road (FOR) BHEL R&D, Hyderabad-500042.

9. Vendor has to submit this **GeM bid document duly signed and stamped on all pages**. By submitting signed GeM bid document it affirms that vendor has accepted to all the terms and conditions mentioned in this bid such as Payment terms, delivery period, Terms of Delivery, EMD, CEBG, PBG, Interest of delayed submission of PBG and CEBG, Integrity pact (IP), Penalty clauses, Breach of contract, Remedies and Termination etc.

10. Insurance, loading/unloading from vendor site to BHEL R&D Hyderabad will be in vendor scope only. Vendor has to quote price(s) inclusive of GST, Transportation/Insurance, Loading/Unloading charges.

11. **Breach of contract, Remedies and Termination:** In case of breach of contract, wherever the value of security instruments like performance bank guarantee available with BHEL against the said contract is at least 10% of the contract value, the same be encashed. Expiry of claim period may be kept 3-6 months after validity date. PBG shall be from one of the Consortium banks of BHEL or from a reputed bank and confirmed by any Consortium bank of BHEL. The offers of the suppliers not accepting to this clause will be rejected.
