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1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. 2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be

given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

3. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

4. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all without any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Generic

3. **Generic**

5. **Generic**

6. **Generic**

1. The Seller shall not assign the Contract in whole or part without obtaining the prior written consent of buyer.
2. The Seller shall not sub-contract the Contract in whole or part to any entity without obtaining the prior written consent of buyer.

11. **Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC**

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

Below mentioned are the ATC clauses of tender

1. Warranty period shall be applicable for a period of 24 months from the date of dispatch of goods. The seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any break down during the guarantee period. Seller should have well established Installation, Commissioning, Training, Troubleshooting and Maintenance Service group in INDIA for attending the after sales service.

2. PBG will be applicable for a period of 24 months from the date of dispatch of goods + claim period of 03 months, for a value equal to 10% of the basic value of purchase order. It shall however be noted that PBG is not applicable against supply of Spares. Also note that PBG should be in the format specified in Annexure III of ATC and no deviation to this format will be allowed.

Note: In case PBG is not furnished, the 10% basic amount will be withheld from the supply invoice. This withheld amount will be paid either against submission of supplementary invoice & Original PBG (or) against supplementary invoice without PBG after expiry of Warranty period.

3. Unloading of material at destination is in the scope of BHEL.

4. Delivery period for Main Supply & Spares shall be 260 days from the date of placement of contract.

5. Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract: Applicable for a period of 03 years after the completion of the warranty (defect liability) period of equipment.

6. a. Terms of Payment for Supply : 90% payment of the basic price of Goods along with 100% GST on the Goods Price but excluding installation and commissioning charges will be paid within 45 days-MSE /60 days-Medium Enterprise /90 days-Non MSME of generation of "Delivery Consignee Receipt-cum-Acceptance Certificate (CRAC) for initial payment" against online submission of complete set of invoicing documents.

Balance 10% payment of the basic price of Goods and 100% charges for installation and commissioning charges along with GST on these charges will be paid within 45 days-MSE /60 days-Medium Enterprise /90 days-Non MSME of generation of "Installation CRAC" against online submission of complete set of invoicing documents after installation and commissioning of goods.

Note: If the E&C could not be completed till the end of the Warranty period due to reasons not attributable to the supplier, BHEL may consider releasing the retention money to the supplier within 45 days-MSE /60 days-Medium Enterprise /90 days-Non MSME against Bank Guarantee (BG) for equivalent value valid for an initial period of one year. BG format for Advance payment towards E&C retention money will be shared by BHEL upon seller's request at the time of expiry of Warranty period.

b. Terms of Payment for Service (ICT): 100% payment will be released within 45 days-MSE /60 days-Medium Enterprise /90 days-Non MSME of issue of job completion certificate against submission of complete set of invoicing documents.

c. Terms of Payment for Post Warranty Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract phase: 100% CAMC charges along with tax as applicable, will be paid within 45 days-MSE /60 days-Medium Enterprise /90 days-Non MSME from the date of submission of supplementary invoice/documents against proof of completion of CAMC on quarterly basis.

Performance bank guarantee applicable for Comprehensive Maintenance Contract (CMC) is to be submitted at start of the CMC and shall be applicable at 2.5% on total CMC Charges. The PBG submitted after award of contract shall be released only after new PBG for the CMC period is submitted and accepted by buyer/consignee after due verification.

Bank guarantee for CMC is to remain valid till completion of CMC period plus one year. The bank guarantee for CMC shall be submitted to buyer directly. In case, seller fails to submit the PBG or does not provide services for the CMC contract after expiry of warranty period then PBG of equipment shall be forfeited.

7. Pre-dispatch inspection at Seller premises: Before dispatch, the goods will be inspected by Buyer / Consignee or their Authorized Representative or by Nominated External Inspection Agency (independently or jointly with Buyer or Consignee as decided by the Buyer) at Seller premises (or at designated place for inspection as declared / communicated by the seller) for their compliance to the contract specification. For in-house testing, the Sellers will provide necessary facilities free of cost.

Seller shall notify the Buyer through e-mail about readiness of goods for pre-dispatch inspection and Buyer will notify the Seller about the Authorized Representative/ Nominated External Inspection Agency and the date for testing. While bidding, the sellers should take into account 14 days for arranging inspection from the date of email offering the goods for inspection. Any delay in arranging inspection beyond 14 days due to reasons not attributable to seller, shall be on the part of buyer and BHEL will extend the delivery period for such period of delay.

The goods would be dispatched to consignee only after clearance in pre-dispatch inspection. Consignee's right of rejection as per GTC in respect of the goods finally received at his location shall in no way be limited or waived by reason of the goods having previously been inspected, tested and passed by Buyer/ Consignee or its Nominated External Inspection Agency prior to the goods' shipment.

8. Material despatch clearance certificate (MDCC): Seller should take into account 14 days for issuance of despatch clearance by BHEL from the date of successful inspection report. Any delay in issue of MDCC beyond 14 days shall be on the part of buyer and BHEL will extend the delivery period for such period of delay.
9. Shortages: In the event of shortage on receipt of goods and/or on opening of packages at site, all such shortages, caused by supplier's act or omission, shall be made good at free of cost within a reasonable time that BHEL may allow from such intimation.
10. Transit Damages: In the event of goods having found in damaged condition upon opening of packages at site, supplier shall make good of all such damages within a reasonable time from such intimation by BHEL.
11. Dispatch documents: Complete set of despatch documents (original + 1 photocopy set) as per Purchase Order shall be forwarded to Purchase Officer/BHEL directly. Despatch documents shall include the following:

Invoice (01 original and 01 copy with original sign & seal / digitally signed invoice), Packing List, NIL Short-Shipment Certificate, POD (Proof of Delivery) on Lorry Receipt (L/R) and original Performance Bank Guarantee (directly from issuing bank to BHEL).

One set of Invoice, L/R, Packing List & E-way bill (Part-A & B) shall be e-mailed immediately to BHEL-EDN during despatch.

Note: Detailed Packing List should indicate package-wise content details and also Net & Gross weight of each package.

12. Prevailing tentative E&C/Commissioning schedule: June,2023. Commissioning/ E&C call will be issued to vendor after actual readiness of site. In case of requirement of multiple visits for reasons not attributable to seller, delivery period for service shall be considered from date of actual readiness of site fronts.

13. After award of contract, Successful Bidder shall submit complete set of documents (like drawings, bill of materials, datasheets, catalogues, quality plan etc. as called in tender specification) for approval, within 21 days of award of contract. Buyer shall issue manufacturing clearance along with approved documents within 75 days from receipt of complete set of documents from seller. Any delay in providing approved documents beyond 75 days shall be on the part of buyer and BHEL will extend the delivery period for such period of delay.

In case of any corrections in documents to be incorporated by seller for approval of document based on end-user/consultant/buyer comments, revised documents have to be submitted incorporating all corrections within 07 days. Seller shall be required to commence manufacturing only after receipt of approved documents from BHEL.

14. Packaging and dispatch: The Seller shall package the goods safely and carefully considering the peculiarity of the material for safe transport by Sea/ Air / Rail/ Road to its destination suitably protected against loss, damage, corrosion in transit and the effect of tropical salt laden atmosphere. The packages shall be provided with fixtures/ hooks and sling marks as may be required for easy and safe handling. If any consignment needs special handling instruction, the same shall be clearly marked with standard symbols / instructions. Hazardous material should be notified as such and their packing, transportation and other protection must conform to relevant regulations.

The packing, shipping, storage and processing of the goods must comply with the prevailing legislation and regulations concerning safety, the environment and working conditions. If safety information sheets (MSDS - Material Safety Data Sheet) exist for an item or the packaging, vendor must provide this information without fail along with the consignment.

Each package must be marked with Consignee name, Purchase order number, Package number, Gross weight and net weight, dimensions (LxBxH) and Seller's name. Packing list of goods inside each package with PO item number and quantity must also be fixed securely outside the box to indicate the contents of each box.

Total number of packages in the consignment must also be indicated in the packing list.

Separate packing & identification of items should be as follows.

1. Main Scope - All items must be tagged with part no. & item description.
2. Commissioning accessories - All items must be tagged with part no. & item description.
3. Mandatory spares - All items must be tagged with part no. & item description.

Nevertheless, vendor shall adhere to dispatch & packing instructions issued by BHEL at the time of dispatch.

15. Integrity Pact: Execution of Integrity Pact is applicable for this tender. Refer Annexure-IV of ATC in this regard.

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent

Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity/restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and/or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid. Further any reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses shall also be null and void. If any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations. Additional Clause For Comprehensive Maintenance Charges

1.CMC shall include preventive maintenance including calibration as per technical/ service /operational manual of the manufacturer, service charges and spares, after satisfactory completion of Warranty. During the CMC period commencing from date of the successful completion of warranty period, Service personnel shall visit each consignee site as recommended in the manufacturer's technical/ service /operational manual, at least once in six months or as per user requirement. Cost of consumables shall not be included in CMC. Further there will be 98% uptime warranty during CMC period on 24 (hrs) X 7 (days) X 365 (days) basis, with penalty, to extend CMC period by double the downtime period.

2.CMC charges to be indicated as percentage of cost of equipment quoted for each year after the warranty period.

3.GST shall be included in the CMC Charges quoted.

4.Cost of CMC will be added for Ranking/Evaluation purpose with depreciation formula. A 10% discounting rate per year shall be applied on CMC Charges for price evaluation on Net Present Value.

5.The payment of CMC will be made on quarterly basis after satisfactory completion of said period, duly certified by end user.

6.While creating a bid or RA, buyers shall indicate whether CMC is required against Yes/No" options. If CMC Charges are included, an option for number of years for CMC required after the warranty period shall be available. Under this option up to 10 years can be chosen for CMC charges beyond warranty period.

7.In case the bid has a provision for CMC, the warranty of the product will also be deemed to have been converted into Comprehensive warranty including preventive maintenance and calibration as per technical/ service /operational manual of the manufacturer, service charges and spares, during the Warranty Period also. Sellers are therefore advised to include the cost of Comprehensive Warranty including spares (excluding consumables) also in product Cost.

8.The CMC functionality shall be available in bid only and no direct RA shall be applicable. In case of bid to R/A decrement rules shall be applicable on total price inclusive of CMC charges. Bunching of products shall not be available while creating bids with CMC charges.

8.1.Buyer shall indicate number of years of warranty by selecting different options available in the field depending on warranty parameter applicable in category parameters for the equipment. No. of years of warranty indicated here shall supersede the warranty period indicated elsewhere in bid or product specifications. The Seller while participating in Bid/RA will get fields to indicate CMC charges as percentage depending on number of years of CMC selected by Buyer. The following shall be applicable, if 5 year CMC selected:

CMC charges for 1st year after warranty period- Percentage to be indicated- A1

CMC charges for 2nd year after warranty period- Percentage to be indicated- A2

CMC charges for 3rd year after warranty period - Percentage to be indicated- A3

CMC charges for 4th year after warranty period - Percentage to be indicated- A4

CMC charges for 5th year after warranty period - Percentage to be indicated- A5

Similarly, A6 to A10 are to be indicated for 6th to 10th year of CMC if applicable.

8.2.The calculation of CMC Charges shall take into account the number of years of warranty and duration of CMC as specified while creating bid.

8.3.In the price evaluation, the system shall provide function to calculate the cost of each equipment by formula indicated below including CMC and then show the inter-se-ranking of the bidders. The following are the variables

(i) Number of years for which CMC required.

(ii) Number of years of product warranty

The formula for calculating total cost including CMC charges shall be as under:

C - Cost for equipment quoted and n shall be number of years of product warranty specified.

If 2 year warranty specified, n shall be 2 and if 5 year warranty specified, n shall be 5. A1, A2, A3, A4 & A5 shall depend on how many years CMC selected. For 3 year CMC, only A1, A2 and A3 factors are to be taken into account and A4 and A5 will not be applicable.

8.4. CMC charges offered for each subsequent year should be same or higher than preceding year.

8.5. The CMC charges shall be offered within range of 3 to 10% of cost of equipment.

9. Since CMC charges are to be paid only later for each year during CMC period, applicable performance guarantee amount after placement of contract shall be based on the cost of equipment excluding the cost of CMC Charges.

10. Performance bank guarantee applicable for CMC is to be submitted at start of the CMC and shall be applicable between 2.5% to 5% as specified in bid on total CMC Charges. The PBG submitted after award of contract shall be released only after new PBG for the CMC period is submitted and accepted by buyer/consignee after due verification. Bank guarantee for CMC is to remain valid till completion of CMC period plus one year. The bank guarantee for CMC shall be submitted to buyer directly. 11. In case of splitting of order quantity, equipment cost and CMC charges offered by L1 bidder shall be matched by higher quoting eligible bidders on one-to-one basis. The equipment cost and CMC charges (year to year) shall be matched individually.

12. The CMC Contract shall be an offline contract to be handled by buyer. The payment of CMC will be made on quarterly basis after satisfactory completion of said period, duly certified by end user and scope of CMC will be as per para 1 above.

13. CMC Charges are inclusive of all the charges for Transportation, Lodging, Boarding, all insurances including third party insurance and all other incidental charges. The same shall include GST. The prices also include cost of spares and damaged parts. Purchaser does not have any liability, whatsoever, over and above the cost of CMC. It also includes for arranging hand tools & tackles, special tools etc. required to carry out the work.
