- 1. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
- 2. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total OUANTITY.
- 4. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all without any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. Further, if bid(s) of any seller(s) eligible for MSE preference is / are coming within price band of 15% of Non MSE L-1 or if bid of any seller(s) eligible for Make in India preference is / are coming within price band of 20% of non MII L-1, then such MSE / Make in India seller shall also be allowed to participate in the RA process.

1. Generic

After award of contract – Successful Bidder shall have to get Detailed Design Drawings approved from buyer before starting fabrication. Successful Bidder shall submit Detailed Design Drawings for Buyer's approval, within 7 days of award of contract. Buyer shall, either approve the drawings or will provide complete list of modification required in the drawings within 5 days. Seller shall be required to ensure supply as per approved Drawings with modifications as communicated by Buyer. If there is delay from buyer side in approval of drawing– the delivery period shall be refixed without LD for the period of delay in approval of Drawing.

3. Generic

Accordingly, bidders with Local Content less than or equal to 20% will be treated as "Non Local Supplier". The prescribed LC shall be applicable on the date of Bid opening. Sanctions on the bidders for false / wrong declaration or not fulfilling the Local Content requirement shall be as per the PPLC policy. Further following additional provisions are added in the certification and verification of local content provision of the Preference to Make in India clause:

- i. In case of foreign bidder, certificate from the statutory auditor or cost auditor of their own office or subsidiary in India giving the percentage of local content is also acceptable. 1. PROJECT INFORMATION:

The Project Site details are given below:

1.1 LOCATION AND APPROACH

Place : Dadri

2. SCOPE OF SUPPLY

This specification covers the manufacture, inspection, testing, and supply of Flexible rubber hoses for Wet Limestone Based FGD application to NTPC Dadri 2X490 MW. These hoses are used for transferring the condensate (40% Sulfuric Acid) from the FGD outlet duct to Condensate Collection seal pot.

3. APPLICABLE SPECIFICATIONS AND STANDARDS:

Design, Manufacturing, Inspection and Testing of the hose shall conform to the latest applicable Indian / British / American/International Standards.

IS 7654 : Specification for Rubber Hose for Chemicals

4. QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENT:

- a) Vendor shall be a manufacturer of Flexible Rubber Hoses. Supporting documents like MSME certificate, ISO certificate, Certificate of Incorporation shall be submitted.
- b) At least two unpriced PO copies of previously supplied Rubber hoses for similar chemical applications shall be provided by the vendor as proof of experience.

5. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

All hoses shall meet the Duty condition mentioned in the Specification. The lining shall consist of a suitable rubber compound resistant to chemicals for which the hose is to be used. The textile reinforcement shall be provided by Natural or man-made fibre, fabric or yarn. The cover shall consist of a suitable rubber compound resistant to chemicals for which the hose is to be used. The lining and cover shall be of uniform thickness, reasonably concentric and free from air blisters, porosity and splits. The Hose material shall be made of Natural Rubber/Neoprene. The fabric/Reinforcement shall be made of High Strength Synthetic Cords. Hose shall remain in round shape while stacking in Horizontally lying position.





** These hoses shall be suitable for inserting into the drain nipple whose details are given below. The Hose ID shall be suitable for inserting into the 2" Barbed insert End. For each hose, 2 nos of circular hose clamps has to be provided for securing the hose to the drain nipple.



5.2 DUTY CONDITON:

- a) Both outside and inside of the Hoses shall be lined and the lining shall be suitable for acidic condition.
- b) Pressure rating 1 bar
- c) Fluid Handled 40% sulphuric acid @ 62 deg C
- d) Hose material Natural rubber/Neoprene Rubber. Material shall be suitable for fluid being handled.
- e) It should be possible to cut the hose to required length to suit site condition
- f) Flange holes shall be as per Class # 150 B 16.5 standard
- g) Length of the Hose Indicated in clause 5.1 may vary by +/-10% and it will be informed during drawing approval stage after order. Vendor shall accept the same without any additional cost.

5.3 AMBIENT CONDITIONS:

The grade of material for hoses shall be such as to work satisfactorily in the following range of ambient conditions: -

Temperature: - 5° to 55°C Relative humidity: - up to 90%

6. INSPECTION AND TESTING

The hoses shall be inspected & tested as per latest edition of relevant Indian/International standards. Inspection will be done by BHEL or its authorized agency. Material Test Certificates shall be submitted.

7. WARRANTY:

Warranty shall be 24 months from the date of Supply or 18 months from the date of commissioning whichever is earlier. During Warranty period, any defects noticed due to faulty material and workmanship, shall be rectified/replaced by vendor free of cost.

8. PACKING

- a) The finished material shall be packed and shipped to the destination only after dispatch clearance from BHEL QA and Purchase.
- b) Individual items shall be wrapped in a polythene hessian and the package shall be kept in a wooden box prior to dispatch. The packing shall contain adequate cushioning to prevent damage during transit and storage. Each hose shall be tagged with hose size, length, fittings etc. in such a way that it is visible without removing individual packing.
- c) Each box shall be labelled regarding its content along with Purchase Order Details, PO. Item no., destination and dispatchers address.
- d) Hose shall be rigid enough so that circular shape shall not deform during storing, transport and stacking of material at Site.
