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1. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.

2. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. 3. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

4. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. 1. **Nominated Inspection Agency:** On behalf of the Buyer organization, any one of the following Inspection Agency would be conducting inspection of stores before acceptance:
Pre-dispatch Inspection at Seller Premises (applicable only if pre-dispatch inspection clause has been selected in ATC): BY BHEL AIA by raising inspection call on <https://cqir.bhel.in/>
Post Receipt Inspection at consignee site before acceptance of stores: By BHEL
2. **Registration / Empanelment Requirement:** Contract shall be awarded to only such sellers , who are registered / empanelled / approved / enlisted with BHEL for the required goods / service category on the date of bid opening. Prospective bidders (if not already registered), are advised to get themselves registered with the said registration authority before bid opening date. (It is certified that the registration is granted by the registering agency as per Rule 150 of GFR following a fair, transparent and reasonable procedure.)
3. **Bidder financial standing:** The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.
4. Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:
 - a. Copy of PAN Card.
 - b. Copy of GSTIN.
 - c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
 - d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.
5. Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions
 1. **Inspection** : By BHEL or BHEL authorized Inspection Agency
(Indigenous Supplier needs to register ONLINE in BHEL website (www.cqir.bhel.in) for offering for Inspection for first time. On readiness of ordered material, supplier shall raise the inspection call request online (www.cqir.bhel.in) with minimum notice period of 07 working days to the authorized representative of the Purchaser for inspection/ testing as provided in PO).For Indigenous vendors, BHEL representative from HPVP Unit or Corporate Quality is authorized to carry out audits along with TPIA at vendor's works before clearing the items for dispatch. Inspection charges for arranging BHEL representative will be borne by M/s BHEL provided Inspection is carried out anywhere in India.After completion of Inspection by TPIA, the scanned copies of Inspection reports, MTCs and other Test Reports applicable as per TDC are to be sent to BHEL for obtaining material dispatch clearanc
 2. Hazardous chemicals and flammable substances shall be transported only through authorized transporters and all safety practices as laid down in applicable legislative requirements such as Central Motor vehicle rules, manufacture, storage and import of Hazardous chemical 1989,etc. shall be followed.
 3. Price Quoted shall be in UOM as mentioned against each items and shall be Including all price components like Testing, Packing, Forwarding, Transportation, Insurance, GST ,the price of thinner as sought against each item, GeM charges etc.
 4. **Pricing Terms:** Bidder's quoted rates/ price for supply part of the contract shall remain firm throughout the contract including extension, if any, for any reason whatsoever and no escalation is admissible for this contract.
 5. **Fraud Prevention Policy:** The Bidder along with its associate/ collaborators/ sub-contractors/ sub-vendors/ consultants/ service providers shall strictly adhere to BHEL Fraud Prevention Policy displayed on BHEL website <http://www.bhel.com> and shall immediately bring to the notice of BHEL Management about any fraud or suspected fraud as soon as it comes to their notice."
 6. BHEL reserves the right to cancel the Enquiry / Tender at any stage without assigning any reasons thereof. Also BHEL reserves the right to reject or accept one or any offer without assigning any reason.
 7. Vendor should guarantee the material against all design and manufacturing defects and for performance for the shelf life of the Items. If any defect is noticed during the above period, the

same shall be rectified/replaced free of cost on FOR Destination basis within a reasonable time.

- 8. Linking up of Old issues:** In case if you have any outstanding problem with earlier supplies, you should not link up against this enquiry or PO at later stages.

9. GUIDELINES FOR SUSPENSION OF BUSINESS DEALING WITH SUPPLIERS:

1.0 Integrity commitment, performance of the contract and punitive action thereof:

1.1. **Commitment by BHEL:** BHEL commits to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption in connection with the tender process and execution of the contract. BHEL will during the tender process treat all Bidder(s) in a transparent and fair manner, and with equity.

1.2. Commitment by Bidder/ Supplier/ Contractor:

1.2.1. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor commit to take all measures to prevent corruption and will not directly or indirectly influence any decision or benefit which he is not legally entitled to nor will act or omit in any manner which tantamount to an offence punishable under any provision of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or any other law in force in India.

1.2.2. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, and is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract and shall adhere to relevant guidelines issued from time to time by Govt. of India/ BHEL.

1.2.3. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will perform/ execute the contract as per the contract terms & conditions and will not default without any reasonable cause, which causes loss of business/ money/ reputation, to BHEL.

6. Data Sheet of the product(s) offered in the bid, are to be uploaded along with the bid documents. Buyers can match and verify the Data Sheet with the product specifications offered. In case of any unexplained mismatch of technical parameters, the bid is liable for rejection.
7. For hazardous chemical/item, all precautionary measure as per regulation from the point of transportation/ handling/ storage/ safety/ health/ environment to be undertaken/ specified before dispatch. During dispatch, proper symbol for the hazard/ MSDS/ Batch No./ date of manufacturing/ Gross Weight/ Net Weight/ shelf Life etc are to be written/ printed/ pasted on the body of the packing.
8. ISO 9001: The bidder or the OEM of the offered products must have ISO 9001 certification.

Disclaimer
