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1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore): Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

A. PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

- a) THE BIDDER SHOULD HAVE SUPPLIED NON FERRIC ALUMINIUM SULPHATE (ALUM) WITH MINIMUM QUANTITY 20.0 MT, TO ANY GOVT/PSU/REPUTED ORGANISATIONS IN LAST THREE YEARS ENDING ON LAST DATE OF BID SUBMISSION. ALL RELEVANT DOCS TO BE SUBMITTED IN SUPPORT OF THE ABOVE.
- b) BIDDER SHOULD HAVE AVERAGE ANNUAL FINANCIAL TURNOVER OF Rs. 3.0 LAKH OR MORE DURING THE LAST THREE YEARS, ENDING on 31ST MARCH'20 AND SHOULD SUBMIT THEIR AUDITED BALANCE SHEET AND PROFIT & LOSS ACCOUNT IN SUPPORT OF THE SAME.

IN CASE AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS HAVE NOT BEEN SUBMITTED FOR ALL THE THREE YEARS AS INDICATED ABOVE, THEN THE APPLICABLE AUDITED STATEMENTS SUBMITTED BY THE BIDDERS AGAINST ABOVE 3 (THREE) YEARS, WILL BE AVERAGED FOR 3 (THREE) YEARS.

IF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO BE AUDITED STATUTORILY, THEN INSTEAD OF AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS, FINANCIAL STATEMENTS ARE REQUIRED TO BE CERTIFIED BY THE CHARTERED ACCOUNTANT.

- c) INDIAN BIDDER OR INDIAN COUNTER PART OF FOREIGN BIDDERS SHOULD FURNISH PAN (PERMANENT ACCOUNT NO.).

NOTE:

- i. THE BIDDER WHO MEETS THE ABOVE PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIAN CAN ONLY PARTICIPATE IN THE TENDER.
- ii. BIDDERS QUOTING IN INDIAN CURRENCY (INR) ONLY SHALL BE QUALIFIED.

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B. The scope of unloading is excluded from the scope of seller for this GeM bid.

C. Vendor has to submit – Guarantee Certificate, Test Certificate and Warrantee Certificate during Supply.

D. Material shall be tested at a lab recommended by BHEL/Customer or consultant before dispatch. Sample collection for the same may be done in presence of Customer/BHEL. However, the concentration of all chemicals shall again be verified at site. In case concentration/quantity found lower/less as per the requirement, the successful bidder to replace the same within 05 days failing which BHEL reserves the right to procure the same at the risk & cost of successful bidder.

- E. The staggered delivery schedule in this GeM bid is tentative, Actual delivery period for each lot will be considered from date of MDCC.
- F. Dispatch is to be made on written confirmation and against Material Dispatch Clearance Certificate (MDCC) from BHEL-PMX/ SITE. Supply of the Chemicals at site is to be completed within 15 days of issue of MDCC. Material to be dispatched only after issuance of MDCC by BHEL. Supply may be done on staggered basis as per the Tentative Delivery Schedule.
- G. Entire quantity shall be supplied through flakes in HDPE bag.

- 2.Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Only supply of Goods
- 3.Actual delivery (and Installation & Commissioning (if covered in scope of supply)) is to be done at following address Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited, Construction Manager, BHEL Site Office, C/o Executive Engineer (Construction Stores Administrative Building) 2 x 660 MW Suratgarh TPS, Dist - Sriganganagar Rajasthan, India, PIN - 335805.
- 4.Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.
- 5.Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:
- a. Copy of PAN Card.
 - b. Copy of GSTIN.
 - c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
 - d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.
- 6.For hazardous chemical/item, all precautionary measure as per regulation from the point of transportation/ handling/ storage/ safety/ health/ environment to be undertaken/ specified before dispatch. During dispatch, proper symbol for the hazard/ MSDS/ Batch No./ date of manufacturing/ Gross Weight/ Net Weight/ shelf Life etc are to be written/ printed/ pasted on the body of the packing.
- 7.Supplier shall ensure that the Invoice is raised in the name of Consignee with GSTIN of Consignee only.
- 8.**Shelf Life:** The Product to be supplied must have minimum one year Shelf Life. On the date of supply, minimum one year usable shelf life should be available / balance.
- 9.Without prejudice to Buyer's right to price adjustment by way of discount or any other right or remedy available to Buyer, Buyer may terminate the Contract or any part thereof by a written notice to the Seller, if:
- i) The Seller fails to comply with any material term of the Contract.
 - ii) The Seller informs Buyer of its inability to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period or such inability otherwise becomes apparent.
 - iii) The Seller fails to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period and/or to replace/rectify any rejected or defective Material(s) promptly.
 - iv) The Seller becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation.
 - v) The Seller makes a general assignment for the benefit of creditors.
 - vi) A receiver is appointed for any substantial property owned by the Seller.
 - vii) The Seller has misrepresented to Buyer, acting on which misrepresentation Buyer has placed the Purchase Order on the Seller.
- 10.While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the screenshot of GST portal confirming payment of GST.
- 11.Material Test Certificate Should Be Sent Along with The Supply. The Material Will Be Checked by Buyer's Lab & the Results of the Lab will be the Sole Criteria for Acceptance of the Item.
- 12.Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specification and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid. Further any reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents / clauses shall also be null and void. If any seller has any objection / grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
