However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate. The minimum local content to qualify as a class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. All bidders must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which the bid is liable to be rejected. Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

- 1. **Nominated Inspection Agency:** On behalf of the Buyer organization, any one of the following Inspection Agency would be conducting inspection of stores before acceptance:
 - Pre-dispatch Inspection at Seller Premises (applicable only if pre-dispatch inspection clause has been selected in ATC): Through nominated TPIA
 - Post Receipt Inspection at consignee site before acceptance of stores: NA
- 2.Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.
- 3.Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.
- 4.Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:
 - a. Copy of PAN Card.
 - b. Copy of GSTIN.
 - c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
 - d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.
- 5. Pre-dispatch inspection at Seller premises (Fee/Charges to be borne by the BUYER): Before dispatch, the goods will be inspected by Buyer / Consignee or their Authorized Representative or by Nominated External Inspection Agency (independently or jointly with Buyer or Consignee as decided by the Buyer) at Seller premises (or at designated place for inspection as declared / communicated by the seller) for their compliance to the contract specifications. - 6. While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the screenshot of GST portal confirming payment of GST.
- 7. The bidder is required to upload, along with the bid, all relevant certificates such as BIS licence, type test certificate, approval certificates and other certificates as prescribed in the Product Specification given in the bid document.
- 8.OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase

- the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

- 11.After award of contract Successful Bidder shall have to get Detailed Design Drawings approved from buyer before starting fabrication. Successful Bidder shall submit Detailed Design Drawings for Buyer's approval, within 7 days of award of contract. Buyer shall, either approve the drawings or will provide complete list of modification required in the drawings within 7 days. Seller shall be required to ensure supply as per approved Drawings with modifications as communicated by Buyer. If there is delay from buyer side in approval of drawing- the delivery period shall be refixed without LD for the period of delay in approval of Drawing.
- 12. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses
 - 1) Compliance of model clauses as provided in Annexure-III of Ministry of Finance Order (Public1) issued on 23.07.2020 (Restrictions under Rule 144 (xi) of the GFR 2017) shall be applicable for subject tender. Model Certificates provided in same Annexure-III shall also be complied. Further relevant clause of order no. 25-11/6/2018-PG dated 02.07.20 issued by MoP shall also be complied. An undertaking regarding Model Clauses (as applicable from Annexure-III) shall be furnished along with bid documents.
 - 2) "Bidders to ensure that Third party/Customer issued certificates being submitted as proof of PQR qualification should have verifiable details of document/certificate issuing authority such as name & designation of Issuing Authority and its organization contact number and E-mail Id In case the same is found not available, BHEL has the right to reject such document from evaluation.
 - 3) This item /package/system falls under the list of items defined in para 3 of ministry of finance guideline date 20.09.16 (procurement of items related to public safety, health, critical security operations and Equipments etc.) & hence criteria of prior experience /turnover shall be same for all bidders including start up /MSME".
 - 4) Guarantee & Warranty: for keeping Guarantee & Warranty time period as 18 months from the date of last supply in the contract.
 - 5) Evaluation shall be on the basis of total all inclusive, landed price at consignee destination (Refer cl. No. 6 of GTC on GEM). However, bidder to note that unloading of items (at delivery point) shall be in Buyer's scope. Bidder to quote price accordingly.
 - 6) PQR criteria uploaded with specification shall prevail Value of Experience criteria and Past performance parameter mentioned in GeM bid.
 - 7) Due to COVID-19 pandemic condition prevailing in the country BHEL/PEM may go for Remote Inspection of Offered items if required. Vendors are requested to be equipped with the

- 8) In case of joint bidding, Bidders shall be required to furnish scope matrix which should be clearly defined between them.
- 9) The Bidder declares that they will not enter into any illegal or undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal with other Bidder(s). This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process. In case, the Bidder is found having indulged in above activities, suitable action shall be taken by BHEL as per extant policies/ guidelines.
- 10) Delay (If Any) in submission/re submission of Drawings/Documents shall not attract any penalty as the delivery period is from PO date. This clause to be read in conjunction with delivery term & conditions.
- 11) Delivery terms of Supervision of E&C: Vendor to depute its service engineer for Supervision of E&C within 15 days from BHEL's intimation (for deputing service engineer). For delay in deputing service engineer, LD on Supervision of E&C portion shall be applicable @ $\frac{1}{2}$ % of the total Supervision of E&C portion contract value (excluding element of taxes) per week or part thereof, with applicable GST. However, total LD (supply + Supervision of E&C) shall be limited to 10% of cumulative total contract value excluding taxes and freight (supply + Supervision of E&C).

However, delivery shall be completed within 1 year from PO date. Delivery may be extended beyond

year on mutual consent within Period of contract.

12) Payment Terms: Since, Supervision of Erection & commissioning is involved in this package. As such, as per Installation Commissioning and Testing (ICT), 90% payment shall be released within ten (10) days of issue of Consignee Receipt-cum-Acceptance Certificate (CRAC) and on-line submission of bills & 10% of total item price will be retained (as allocation of supervision of E & C) and shall be paid after completion on supervision of E&C as per scope. Further, regarding offline mode of payment to sellers i.e. while the CRAC is being updated on GeM, the payment to sellers is being made offline and the data on payment is being pushed to GeM through SSON.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specification and / or terms and conditions governing the bid.
