1. Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.
2. Buyer Organization specific Integrity Pact shall have to be complied by all bidders. Bidders shall have to upload scanned copy of signed integrity pact as per Buyer organizations policy along with bid. [Click here to view the file](#)
3. Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Only supply of Goods
4. Preference to Make In India products (For bids less than 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document 50%. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. 6. **OPTION CLAUSE:** The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.
7. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

Buyer specific bid related ATC shall be as below:

a) The variation on overall package value due to changes in the scope shall be +-25%.

b) Technical PQR is part of NIT.

`Bidder has to provide the details as per Technical PQR (part of Technical Specification ref. no. PE-TS-417-507-E012) in its offer and has to note that bids of

only those bidders shall be evaluated who meet the Technical Pre-Qualifying requirements'. Above terms for PQR shall prevail in conflict (if any).

c) Financial bid opening (Part-II) of a bidder shall be subjected to following:

- i) Approval of vendor by end customer i.e. (TSGENCO)
- ii) Qualification of items should mandatorily confirm to PP-MII order provisions.
- iii) Techno-Commercial recommendation by BHEL.
- iv) Qualification of Technical PQR.

d) Payment Terms: As per clause no. 12 (i) of GTC on GeM i.e. 100% payment shall be released within ten (10) days of issue of Consignee Receipt-cum-Acceptance Certificate (CRAC) and on-line submission of bills.

e) Terms of Delivery: shall be as per cl. No. 13 of GTC on GeM (i.e. Free Delivery at site basis including loading/unloading). However, term shall be added through bid specific ATC to keep unloading of items (at delivery point) in the scope of buyer, for subject bid.

f) Guarantee & Warrantee shall be as per Cl. No. 10 of GTC on GeM for the bid. However, Guarantee & Warrantee time period shall be 18 months from the date of last supply in the contract.

g) This package is of divisible nature.

h) **Delivery Period:** Final delivery schedule is as per the requirement of GeM and shall be within 180 days from PO date.

After award of contract - Successful Bidder shall have to get Detailed Design Drawings approved from buyer before starting manufacturing of items (As indicated in BOQ of Tech. Specs). Successful Bidder shall submit Detailed Design Drawings for Buyer's approval, within 15 days. Seller shall resubmit the commented drawing documents within 5 days of receipt of comments from buyer. Approval process of primary documents shall be completed within 60 days from Purchase Order. Seller shall be required to ensure supply as per approved Drawings with modifications as communicated by Buyer. If there is delay from buyer side in approval of drawing - the delivery period shall be refixed without LD for the period of delay in approval of Drawing.

The drg/doc submission/resubmission schedule mentioned above shall prevail over technical specification.

i) LD shall be as per cl. no. 15 of GTC on GeM.

j) Integrity Pact: Integrity pact is applicable for subject package. IP is a tool to ensure that activities and transactions between the Company and its Bidders/ Contractors are handled in a fair, transparent and corruption free manner. A panel of Independent External Monitors (IEMs) have been appointed by BHEL with the approval of CVC. The names of the IEMs in panel are as follows:

The IP as enclosed as per annexure-VIII is to be submitted (duly signed by authorized signatory) along with techno-commercial bid. Only those bidders who have entered into such an IP with BHEL would be competent to participate in the bidding. In other words, entering into this pact would be a preliminary qualification. Please refer Section-8 of IP for Role and Responsibilities of IEMs. In case of any complaint arising out of the tendering process, the matter may be referred to the any of the IEMs mentioned above. All correspondence with the IEMs shall be done through email only.

" No routine correspondence shall be addressed to the IEM (phone/ post/ email) regarding the clarifications, time extensions or any other administrative queries, etc. on the tender issued. All such clarification/ issues shall be addressed directly to the tender issuing (procurement) department officials."

All other terms & conditions shall be as per selected Additional Terms & Conditions for subject bid from GeM library and GTC on GeM.

8. Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specification and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid. Further any reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents / clauses shall also be null and void. If any seller has any objection / grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
